Club Activity: Vision and Hearing Screening at Wilson School

The Koko Head Lions coordinated a vision and hearing screening of 307 students in grades 1, 3, and 5. The effort brought together 48 Lions, two prospective Lions, one Rotarian, and 9 parent volunteers from the school. The Lions represented 15 different clubs from nearly all of the regions of this island, including one from Waiakea on the big island. The effort was a major undertaking, coordinating and getting the responses from the clubs and individual Lions but it was well worth it. Many Safe Sidewalk co-workers were there and I appreciate your support.

The vision screening was billed as an OJT training experience for Lion Dr. Roger Ede's new screening tools. The effort is part of our on-going attempt to train as many Lions as possible in the correct use of the new standardized vision screening tools. Many thanks for him and Vision Screening Chair, R2Z1 Chair Sam Fisk. They took care of the





testing tools, the on-site training, and screening. Seven screening stations were set up. 307 students were tested before we had to stop for the students' lunch.



PDG Dr Shannon Ching did his normal bang up job with hearing screening. He had also had seven workstations and one retesting station set up to handle his portion of the day. They were located in two different classrooms. His main body of Lions was our ever faithful Hawaii Kai Lions. PDG Shannon did have other Lions going through some on the job training using his equipment.



310 Halemaumau Street

Coming East on H1:

- 1. Continue on Kalanianaole Hwy (72) to the signal light at Halemaumau St.
- 2. This is four signal lights after the Aina Haina Shopping Center (McDonald's on the left)
- 3. Move to the far LEFT of the three lanes.
- 4. You will pass Kawaikui Park on your left and the BEFORE Halemaumau is Puuikena Drive.
- 5. Get into the left turn lane at Halemaumau and wait for the green arrow.
- 6. You will pass through five intersections before you see the school on the LEFT.
- 7. Park in any space available.
- 8. The cafeteria is the large building with the screen doors in front of you.

Coming West on Kalanianaole Hwy:

- 1. Stay in the right lane on Kalanianaole Hwy (72) past the Niu Valley Shopping Center.
- 2. A 7-Eleven is visible in the center.
- 3. Although this intersection is Halemaumau, it is EAST Halemaumau and not the one you want.
- 4. Continue through two sets of signal lights past Kentucky Fried Chicken on the right.
- 5. The next intersection is Halemaumau.
- 6. Turn RIGHT on Halemaumau.
- 7. Follow numbers 6 through 8 above.
