HANA aka Hana yori mo naho (2006-Japan) 128m *** D: Hirokazu Koreeda (SHOPLIFTERS). Jun'ichi Okada, Rie Miyazawa, Arata Furuta, Jun Kunimura, Tadanobu Asano, Teruyuki Kagawa, Tomoko Tabata. In 1702, young samurai Sôzaemon (Okada) leaves his home in Matsumoto to look for his father's murderer in a filthy run-down Edo slum. A reward of 100 gold coins awaits him if he avenges his father, but scholarly Sôza is no killer. He would much rather spend his days with lovely widow Osae (Miyazawa), but what would they live on? His money is rapidly disappearing... This delightfully different samurai tale won 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

JUST BELIEVE aka Io c'è (2018-Italy) 96m *** D: Alessandro Aronadio. Edoardo Leo, Margherita Buy, Giuseppe Battiston, Giulia Michelini. In this delightfully irreverent comedy set in Rome, spoiled rich kid Massimo (Leo) struggles to keep his B & B afloat. He can't help but notice that the nuns next door are living large, so he turns his B & B into a place of worship and creates a new religion, with hilarious results. Winner of 2 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: THE BLACK WIDOWER (2016-New Zealand) 90m *** D: Mark Beesley. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Emmett Skilton, Jason Hoyte. Tourists get a fright they didn't pay for on the "giant spider" part of the cut-rate "Lord of the Ringz" tour when a real dead body is found wrapped in fake spiderwebs. The deceased is tour operator/local pub owner Ray's (Hoyte) diabetic wife, so most think her death is medically related. However, the shocking real cause of death is revealed to be spider venom in this clever New Zealand mystery. For ages 12 and older.

SHETLAND SEASON 3 (2016-Scotland) 344m ****
D: Thaddeus O'Sullivan. Douglas Henshall, Alison O'Donnell, Ciarán Hinds (BELFAST), Sara Vickers, Andrew Rothney, James Cosmo (MY SAILOR, MY LOVE). Twenty-something Leanne (Vickers) meets Robbie (Rothney), a nice young man, on the ferry to Lerwick, Shetland. Romance blooms, but the next morning, as she disembarks, she finds no trace of Robbie. Thus begins this engrossing, complex mystery whose solution will take detective Jimmy Perez (Henshall) and his sergeant Tosh (O'Donnell) to their limits. The entirety of this story is screened in three parts, of two episodes per part. For ages 15 and older.

ENDLESS NIGHT aka Nadie quiere la noche (2015-Spain/France/Bulgaria) 99m *** D: Isabel Coixet (THE SECRET LIFE OF WORDS). Juliette Binoche, Rinko Kikuchi, Gabriel Byrne, Orto Ignatiussen, Matt Salinger. It is 1908 in the northernmost reaches of Greenland. Wealthy and cultured Josephine Peary (Binoche) waits for her husband Lt. Robert Peary to return from his expedition to the North Pole. As a treacherous polar winter approaches, Josephine encounters an Inuit woman named Allaka (Kikuchi) with whom she strikes up an uneasy friendship in this tale of survival. Winner of 6 awards. For ages 15 and older.

IF YOU ONLY KNEW HOW BEAUTIFUL IT IS HERE aka Wenn du wüsstest, wie schön es hier ist (2015-Austria) 92m *** ½ D: Andreas Prochaska. Gerhard Liebmann, Simon Hatzl, Ines Honsel, Fritz Egger, Susanne Kubelka. When a local schoolgirl is found dead at the bottom of a closed mine in the Austrian mountains, Hannes Muck (Liebmann), a naïve village detective, tries to solve the murder before the big city police arrive. All the villagers are up in arms as Muck probes into their secret lives in this quirky whodunit. Nominated for 7 awards. For ages 15 and older.

THE PEMBROKESHIRE MURDERS (2021-UK) 144m **** ½ D: Marc Evans. Luke Evans, Keith Allen, Caroline Berry, Oliver Ryan, Alexandria Riley, Steffan Cennydd. In this fascinating true crime story set in 2006, newly promoted detective superintendent Steve Wilkins (Luke Evans) reopens three unsolved cases that have plagued the Dyfed-Powys police in Wales for decades. John Cooper (Allen), the man Wilkins suspects of being a serial killer, is about to come out of prison after serving a sentence for burglary. Can Wilkins and his team gather enough evidence before Cooper is released? Nominated for 6 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE GODDESS OF FORTUNE aka La dea fortuna (2019-Italy) 113m *** D: Ferzan Özpetek (FACING WINDOWS). Stefano Accorsi, Jasmine Trinca, Edoardo Leo, Sara Ciocca, Edoardo Brandi. Long-time couple Alessandro (Leo) and Arturo (Accorsi) face a new challenge when their dear friend Annamaria (Trinca) asks them to care for her two children while she gets a series of tests at the hospital. After 15 years together, Arturo and Alessandro's relationship is less than stable. This thoughtful and beautifully acted drama won 9 awards. For ages 12 and older.

125 RUE MONTMARTRE (1959-France) 87m *** D: Gilles Grangier (THE NIGHT AFFAIR). Lino Ventura, Andréa Parisy, Robert Hirsch, Dora Doll. Pascal (Ventura) is a gruff newspaper seller in Paris. One day, Pascal is taking a break next to the Seine River when he spots a drowning man. Pascal dives in to rescue Didier (Hirsch) and ends up involved in a murder scandal for all his trouble. This atmospheric film noir is a rich evocation of Parisian street life in the late 1950s. For ages 12 and older.

THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: OVER HER DEAD BODY (2016-New Zealand) 89m *** D: Murray Keane. Neill Rea, Mark Mitchinson, Pana Hema Taylor, Kip Chapman. During the funeral of beloved local poet Declan O'Grady (Mitchinson), the coffin falls out of the hearse to reveal not Declan's body but an unidentified dead woman! Who is this young woman, how did she die, and where on earth is Declan's body? Meanwhile, Jared (Taylor) becomes jittery awaiting the results of his DNA test. For ages 12 and older.

THE BANSHEES OF INISHERIN (2022-Ireland/UK/US) 114m **** D: Martin McDonagh (IN BRUGES). Colin Farrell, Brendan Gleeson, Kerry Condon. In this hilarious comedy set on a remote island off Ireland's western coast, sweetly naïve Padraic (Farrell) is shocked when his lifelong friend Colm (Gleeson) abruptly ends their friendship. Deeply upset, Padraic and his sister Siobhan (Condon) try to repair the rift, but instead of getting better, events escalate out of control. Winner of 108 awards and nominated for 9 Oscars. Rated R.

INN OF EVIL aka Inochi bô ni furô (1971-Japan) 121m *** ½ D: Masaki Kobayashi (HARAKIRI). Tatsuya Nakadai, Komaki Kurihara, Kan'emon Nakamura, Kei Yamamoto, Shintarô Katsu. On a little island amid a web of canals in Edo, the Easy Inn serves as a hangout for smugglers, thieves and other undesirables. One day, young Tomijirô (Yamamoto), wounded while fleeing the police, stumbles into the inn. When the gang hears Tomijirô's pitiful story, the hardened criminals try to help him in this unique feudal-era film noir. Nominated for 7 awards. For ages 12 and older.

I GUAPPI (1974-Italy) 126m *** D: Pasquale Squitieri. Claudia Cardinale, Franco Nero, Fabio Testi, Raymond Pellegrin. In this fascinating, lavish crime epic set in early 20th century Naples, Nicola Bellizzi (Nero) returns to his hometown after six years in prison. Life is dangerous in Naples; the streets are ruled by the Camorra, and its kingpin is handsome, preening Don Gaetano (Testi), who takes a liking to Nicola. Nicola is determined to stay out of prison and become a lawyer—will his friendship with Don Gaetano become his salvation or his downfall? An extremely rare screening, well-dubbed in English. For ages 12 and older.

TILL (2022-US) 130m *** ½ D: Chinonye Chukwu (CLEMENCY). Danielle Deadwyler, Jalyn Hall, Whoopi Goldberg, Sean Patrick Thomas, Haley Bennett. In 1955 Chicago, widowed mom Mamie Till-Mobley (Deadwyler) lovingly tells her happy-go-lucky 14-year-old son Emmitt (Hall) to be extra careful when he visits his cousins in her native Mississippi. But Emmitt is too full of cheeky good humor and pays a terrible price for stepping out of line in the racist South. This powerful, uplifting true story of a mother's pursuit of justice won 15 awards and is nominated for a Best Leading Actress BAFTA for Deadwyler's brilliant performance. Rated PG-13.

ILLUSTRIOUS CORPSES aka Cadaveri eccellenti (1976-Italy/France) 116m *** ½ D: Francesco Rosi (CHRIST STOPPED AT EBOLI). Lino Ventura, Max von Sydow, Tino Carraro, Fernando Rey, Tina Aumont. Detective Rogas (Ventura) is assigned to investigate the assasinations of Supreme Court judges in southern Italy. They are happening one after the other, all done in a similar fashion. Is the killer someone who was wrongly imprisoned? As he delves into the cases and uncovers evidence of government corruption, he finds himself being watched... Winner of 5 awards. For ages 15 and older.

THE FABELMANS (2022-US/India) 151m *** ½ D: Steven Spielberg (SCHINDLER'S LIST). Michelle Williams, Paul Dano, Seth Rogen, Gabriel LaBelle, Judd Hirsch. In this heartfelt semi-autobiographical memoir, director Spielberg re-creates his youth in post-WWII Arizona where he first learns the art of filmmaking. A loving portrait of his family and full of insights on the power of cinema, this film won 24 awards and is nominated for 7 Oscars, including Best Film, Best Director and Best Actress (Michelle Williams). Rated PG-13.

SLEEPY EYES OF DEATH: THE CHI-NESE JADE aka Nemuri Kyôshirô: Sappôchô (1963-Japan) 81m *** D: Tokuzô Tanaka. Raizô Ichikawa, Tomisaburô Wakayama, Tamao Nakamura, Saburô Date, Sônosuke Sawamura. Master swordsman Kyôshirô (Ichikawa) is in great demand. Lord Maeda (Sawamura) of the wealthy Kaga fiefdom wants to hire him to steal a jade statuette and dispatches his adopted daughter Chisa (Nakamura) to seduce him into taking the job. Meanwhile, merchant Zeniya (Date), the owner of the statuette, sends Shaolin warrior Chen Sun (Wakayama) to hire Kyôshirô to battle Lord Maeda's clan. Disgusted with the greed of both employers, Kyôshirô hatches a plan in this first of the great 14 film series. For

SLEEPY EYES OF DEATH 2: SWORD OF ADVENTURE aka Nemuri Kyôshirô: Shôbu (1964-Japan) 82m *** ½ D: Kenji Misumi (THE TALE OF ZATOICHI). Raizô Ichikawa, Yoshi Katô, Fujio Suga, Shiho Fujimura. Wandering swordsman Kyôshirô (Ichikawa) meets elderly finance minister Asahina (Katô), who's blowing the whistle on corruption in the Ienari shogunate. Kyôshirô, normally uninterested in politics, appoints himself Asahina's bodyguard as Asahina is a rare bird: an honest official. This makes for an odd friendship: Asahina is alarmed at Kyôshirô's violent life, and Kyôshirô's eyes glaze over when Asahina talks about policy. For ages 12 and older.
