THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: GOOD AS GOLD (2022-New Zealand) 98m *** ½ D: Caroline Bell Booth, Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Jarod Rawiri, Cristina Serban Ionda, Kerry-Lee Dewing, Josh McKenzie, Roy Billing (*THE DISH*), Tami Nielson. Jane Ferguson (Dewing) is shot dead while panning for gold on a river, re-igniting a generations-old family feud between the Fergusons and the Hollands in this wildly entertaining episode that involves line dancing and the music of Tami Nielson. For ages 14 and older. *Fun Fact: Roy Billing, famous for acting in Australian films, was born in NZ. He plays Dan Holland, patriarch of the Hollands in this episode.*

JOAN BAEZ I AM A NOISE (2023-US) 113m *** ½ D: Miri Navasky, Maevé O'Boyle, Karen O'Connor. Folk music icon and activist Joan Baez reflects on her 60-year career in this frank and deeply moving documentary. Drawing from a lifetime of film footage and recent interviews, Baez reveals personal struggles she has kept private until now. Baez's own sketches from her journals and letters contribute to the eloquent visual style of this film, which adds impact to Baez's story and her music, which has changed over the years but remains powerful to this day. Winner of 1 award (so far). For ages 12 years and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: THE TERRACOTTA DOG *aka Il cane di terracotta* (2000-Italy) 103m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Katharina Böhm, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta, Giuseppe Lo Presti. Mafia kingpin Tano U Greco (Lo Presti) wants to turn himself in to the police, which serves as a very delicate problem for detective Montalbano (Zingaretti) and his team. How can they get this priceless informant into custody without getting him killed by fellow gangsters? Montalbano, himself targeted by the mob, discovers a stash of weapons and what might be evidence of a 50-year-old crime in a secret cavern. For ages 14 and older.

THE LAST SAMURAI *aka Ōkami yo rakujiutsu o kire* (1974-Japan) 158m *** ½ D: Kenji Misumi (*THE TALE OF ZATOICHI*). Hideki Takahashi, Ken Ogata, Takahiro Tamura, Teruhiko Saigo, Masaomi Kondō, Keiko Matsuzaka, Kiwako Taichi. In this samurai adventure set in the 1860s, accomplished young swordsman Toranosuke Sugi (Takahashi) arrives in Kyoto on the behest of his sensei Ikemoto (Tamura) to find the city in turmoil with skirmishes between the Shinsengumi (elite pro-Shogunate swordsmen) and the Satsuma rebels. Through happenstance he befriends Tokugawa samurai Hachiro Iba (Kondō), Shinsengumi hero Sōji Okita (Saigo) and Satsuma warrior Hanjirō Nakamura (Ogata). Sugi questions the need for these men of talent and virtue to fight each other when they could help build a new Japan. This epic is considered Kenji Misumi's masterpiece. For ages 12 and older.

THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: THREE COINS IN A FOUNTAIN (2022-New Zealand) 98m *** ½ D: David de Lautour. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Jarod Rawiri, Karl Willetts, Jordan Mooney, Te Kohe Tuhaka, Byron Coll. Sad sack Frodo (Willetts) gets a chance to move up in the world when a "spoofing" championship—played by moneyed gentlemen—comes to Brokenwood. Detective Kristin's (Sutherland) flirtation with Quentin (Mooney), one of the players, is derailed when the former world champion is found dead in a public park's fountain. For ages 14 and older.

THE HOLDOVERS (2023-US) 133m **** D: Alexander Payne (*NEBRASKA*). Paul Giamatti, Dominic Sessa, Da'Vine Joy Randolph, Carrie Preston, Brady Hepner, Michael Provost. The brilliant Paul Giamatti stars as grumpy, pedantic antiquities teacher Paul Hunham in this funny and touching comedy-drama set during the holiday season of 1970 New England. In trouble with the headmaster for failing the son of a senator, Paul is forced to stay on campus to babysit the "holdovers"—students who have nowhere to go for Christmas. He's left with one student, Angus (Sessa), who is disliked at school almost as much as Paul. Winner of 93 awards (so far). Rated R.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: A TRIP TO TINDARI *aka La gita a Tindari* (2001-Italy) 115m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Katharina Böhm, Cesare Bocci, Angelo Russo, Carmelinda Gentile, Francesco Sineri. A man is found dead in front of an apartment building. He is identified as Nené Sanfilippo, a serial womanizer. The same day, an elderly couple who live in the same building are reported as missing. The couple, the Griffos, were on their way back from a bus trip to Tindari. As the tangled clues unravel, Montalbano (Zingaretti) uncovers a sinister plot that implicates several members of the Sicilian elite in this twisty mystery. For ages 14 and older.

STYRIAN BLOOD *aka Steirerblut* (2014-Austria) 90m *** D: Wolfgang Murnberger (*ACHTERBAHN*). Miriam Stein, Hary Prinz, Thomas Stipsits, August Schmörlzer. Young detective Sandra (Stein) is called on her day off by her boss Inspector Bergmann (Prinz) to investigate a suspicious car accident near her home village in Styria, Austria, a place she was very happy to leave. The deceased was a journalist writing an exposé on the mayor (Schmörlzer), who happens to be the uncle of Max (Stipsits), who is both the local cop in charge of the investigation and Sandra's ex-boyfriend. This amusing crime tale won 2 awards. For ages 14 and older.

SHETLAND SERIES 7 (2022-Scotland) Parts 1 & 2: 115m, Parts 3 & 4: 115m, Parts 5 & 6: 112m **** D: Fiona Walton, Louis Paxton. Douglas Henshall, Alison O'Donnell, Angus Miller, Nicholas Nunn, Shauna Macdonald, Andrew Whipp, Ladi Emeruwa, Patrick Robinson. Graphic novelist/artist Connor Cairns (Nunn), a vulnerable young man who has just celebrated a book launch, suddenly disappears. Though Connor recently arrived from Glasgow, he has been embraced by the community. As DI Jimmy Perez (Henshall) and DS 'Tosh' McIntosh investigate, and dead bodies turn up, Connor may not be at all what he seems in this engrossing mystery. For ages 15 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: THE ARTIST'S TOUCH *aka Tocco d'artista* (2001-Italy) 95m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Katharina Böhm, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta, Biancamaria D'Amato, Luigi Maria Burruano. One hectic morning, Montalbano (Zingaretti) is called to the scene of what looks like a very elaborate suicide: a wealthy amateur goldsmith has been electrocuted in his wheelchair. Montalbano's deputy Mimi (Bocci) has his hands full with the shooting murder of an electrician with a spotless record. Are these cases related? For ages 14 and older.

SNOW ON THE BLADES *aka Zakurozaka no adauchi* (2014-Japan/Cyprus) 119m *** D: Setsurō Wakamatsu. Kiichi Nakai, Hiroshi Abe, Ryōko Hirose, Kichiemon Nakamura. When retainer Kingo Shimura (Nakai) is unable to protect prime minister Naosuke Ii (Nakamura) from assassination at Sakurada Gate, his Tokugawa overlords order him to track down and kill all of the assassins. This film, with its strong humanist bent, spans the Bakumatsu period to the first five years of the Meiji Era. In contrast to the film *SAKURADA GATE INCIDENT* (2010-Japan), this poignant drama portrays Ii with greater sympathy. Hiroshi Abe plays the last fugitive assassin. Nominated for 4 awards. For ages 15 and older.

KUKURANTUMI ROAD TO ACCRA (1983-Ghana/West Germany) 83m *** ½ D: King Ampaw. Evans Oma Hunter, Amy Appiah, David Dontoh, Dorothy Ankomah, George Wilson. Hardworking Ghanaian citizen Addey (Hunter) drives a beat-up lorry to transport passengers between his home village of Kukurantumi and the bustling city of Accra each day. When he loses his job for reasons beyond his control, he tries to arrange for his pretty daughter Abena (Appiah) to marry wealthy businessman Mensah (Wilson), but she has ideas of her own in this humorous yet gritty tale of modernization. For ages 12 and older. *English is the official language of Ghana. This film has no subtitles.*

PRISCILLA (2023-Italy/US) 113m *** ½ D: Sofia Coppola (*LOST IN TRANSLATION*). Caillee Spaeny, Jacob Elordi, Ari Cohen, Dagmara Dominczyk, Tim Post, Lynne Griffin. Priscilla Beaulieu (Spaeny) has all of her teenage crush dreams come true when she meets rock star Elvis Presley (Elordi) at a party in 1959. Priscilla's father, Capt. Beaulieu (Cohen) is stationed in Germany where Elvis is also serving. Elvis is not at all like Priscilla expects: he is shy, homesick, and devoted to his grandmother. This intimate biopic co-written by Priscilla Presley reveals the unseen side of their highly publicized lives together. Winner of 3 awards (so far). Rated R.

WHEN HITLER STOLE PINK RABBIT *aka Als Hitler das rosa Kaninchen stahl* (2019-Germany/Switzerland/Italy) 119m *** ½ D: Caroline Link (*NOWHERE IN AFRICA*). Riva Krymalowski, Carla Juri, Oliver Masucci, Justus von Dohnányi. Judith Kerr's novel comes to vibrant life in this drama set in 1933 Berlin. Nine-year-old Anna (Krymalowski) wakes to find her writer father (Masucci), a harsh critic of the Nazi party, gone. Told to pack only essentials for her journey to Zurich to join her father, she leaves behind her beloved pink bunny. Anna learns to become a citizen of the world in this winner of 5 awards. For ages 10 and older.

VOYAGE SURPRISE (1947-France) 105m **** D: Pierre Prévost. Sinoël, Étienne Decroux, Maurice Baquet, René Bourbon, Martine Carol, Jacques-Henry Duval, Piéral, Annette Poivre, Roger Caccia. Everyone is saying old man Piuff (Sinoël) has gone mad. His fleabag travel company has no money left, and his rival M. Grosbois's company looks bigger and flashier by the day. Undeterred, Piuff is advertising a "Voyage Surprise" that has no itinerary! Meanwhile, revolutionary Mikhail (Decroux) is at large, having stolen a fortune from the Grand Duchess of Strombolia (Piéral). This hilarious romp written by Pierre Prévost's famous brother Jacques is perfectly Lubitschious! It's the acknowledged inspiration for the Beatles' Magical Mystery Tour. For ages 10 and up

THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: FOUR FIRES AND A FUNERAL (2022-New Zealand) 95m *** ½ D: Mike Smith. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Jarod Rawiri, Cristina Serban Ionda, Paul Gittins, Cameron Rhodes. The remains of a body are found in a burnt rural shed. The incident is the third involving the Brokenwood volunteer fire department that resulted in a fatality. Mike (Rea) and Kristin (Ferguson) also uncover a disturbing pattern of robberies linked to the fire department. But the volunteers are well-known and loved residents of Brokenwood! For ages 14 and older.

THE EIGHT MOUNTAINS *aka Le otto montagne* (2022-Italy/Belgium/France/UK) 147m *** ½ D: Felix van Groeningen (*THE BROKEN CIRCLE BREAKDOWN*). Charlotte Vandermeersch, Luca Marinelli, Alessandro Borghi, Filippo Timi, Elena Lietti. In this gorgeous drama about one's place in the world, 11-year-old city boy Pietro meets Bruno, a mountain boy his own age in a tiny village in the Aosta Valley in 1984. Bruno calls Pietro "Berio" which means rock, but it is Bruno who is Pietro's rock. Pietro (Marinelli) drifts from one job to another while "montanaro" Bruno (Borghi) milks cows and makes cheese in this meditation on a lifelong friendship. Winner of 16 awards, including one from Cannes. For ages 12 and older.

ACCUSED *aka Anklaget* (2005-Denmark) 101m *** ½ D: Jacob Thuesen. Troels Lyby, Sofie Gråbøl, Paw Henriksen, Louise Mieritz, Kirstine Rosenkrands Mikkelsen, Kirsten Olesen. Henrik (Lyby) and Nina (Gråbøl) are a happily married couple trying to understand their troubled 14-year-old daughter Stine (Mikkelsen), who is becoming increasingly withdrawn at school and at home. When Stine accuses her father of sexual abuse, the family is thrust into a legal and social nightmare in this brilliantly acted drama. Winner of 7 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: EXPOSED TO THE LIGHT (2021-New Zealand) 92m *** ½ D: Aidee Walker. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Jarod Rawiri, Cristina Serban Ionda, Roy Ward, John Glass. During a gala fundraiser for the historic Brokenwood Cinema, a fire breaks out. When the smoke clears, the body of the property's owner, Lyall Densem (Glass), is found strangled to death. Among the suspects are the drunken projectionist and, of all people, Rev. Lucas Greene (Ward), who is found unconscious with a clip of naughty film footage in his hand. For ages 14 and older. *Note: This is a re-screening of one of our favorite Brokenwood episodes.*
