DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: THE SENSE OF TOUCH aka Il senso del tatto (2002-Italy) 104m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Katharina Böhm, Cesare Bocci, Lucia Sardo. An old blind man is found dead in bed. Strangely, his guide dog Orlando, who was always by his master's side, is found locked outdoors. Was there foul play? To gather information (and enjoy a few days of vacation), detective Montalbano (Zingaretti) visits the deceased's sister Ignazia (Sardo) on picturesque Levanza Island with his girlfriend Livia (Böhm) and the Newfoundland Orlando, who helps solve the case. For ages 14 and older.

THE SHOGUN'S VAULT *aka Gokinzo yaburi* (1964-Japan) 93m *** D: Teruo Ishii (BLACK LINE). Hashizô Ôkawa, Chiezô Kataoka, Tetsurô Tanba, Yukiji Asaoka. Young yakuza 'Red Peony' Hanji (Ôkawa) lands in jail, sharing a crowded cell with notorious thief 'Smoke' Tomizô (Kataoka), who manages to keep the scrappy youngster out of trouble. When out of prison, Tomizô masterminds a plan to rob, of all crazy things, the Shogun's vault in Edo Castle and invites Hanji to partner with him. It won't be easy with Edo's most zealous cop (Tanba) on their tail! This delightful samurai-era heist movie is great fun! For ages 15 and older.

GREYHOUND (2020-US/Canada/China) 91m ***¹/₂ D: Aaron Schneider (GET LOW). Tom Hanks, Elisabeth Shue, Stephen Graham, Rob Morgan. In this gripping adaptation of C.S. Forester's novel *The Good Shepherd*, Tom Hanks stars as Ernest Krause, first-time captain of a Fletcher-class destroyer assigned, with three other vessels, to protect a convoy carrying troops and supplies across the North Atlantic to England. During the treacherous three-day crossing the convoy comes under relentless attack by German submarines while out of range of surveillance aircraft. Winner of 1 award and nominated for an Oscar. Rated PG-13.

THE PASS: LAST DAYS OF THE SAMURAI *aka Tôge: Saigo no samurai* (2020-Japan) 115m *** D: Takashi Koizumi (AFTER THE RAIN). Kôji Yakusho (star of PERFECT DAYS, this year's Oscar nominee for Best Foreign Language Film), Takako Matsu, Tatsuya Nakadai. After 260 years of peaceful rule, the 15th Tokugawa shogun Yoshinobu cedes power to the Emperor in 1867. However, the pro-imperialist Choshu and Satsuma clans seek to deny the Tokugawa clan from any political power, triggering the Boshin War. With the subjects of the Nagaoka clan evenly divided between the factions, Nagaoka chief retainer Kawai (Yakusho) must find a means, diplomatic or otherwise, to protect his people. This thoughtful and moving tale of a progressive man upholding a medieval code of honor was nominated for 6 awards. For ages 12 years and older.

THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: TO DIE OR NOT TO DIE (2015-New Zealand) 88m *** ½ D: Murray Keane. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Pana Hema Taylor, Nic Sampson, Peter Hambleton. When an asthmatic cast member collapses and dies onstage at the end of a performance of Hamlet, detective Mike Shepherd (Rea), who is on the scene, catches a whiff of bitter almonds. While interviewing the cast, Mike's team takes note of the complex web of frustrated sexual desire, hurt ego and raw ambition that makes everyone a suspect in this murder mystery. For ages 14 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: RICE CROQUETTES aka Gli arancini di Montalbano (2002-Italy) 94m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Isabell Sollman, Katharina Böhm, Francesco Foti, Barbara Mautino. Two people are found dead in a car that has fallen off a cliff. Detective Montalbano's (Zingaretti) deputy Mimi (Bocci) rushes to the scene, as one of the victims is his old flame Stefania (Mautino). Montalbano has to solve the case quickly as he's promised Livia (Böhm) he'll join her in Paris to celebrate the New Year—though he'd much rather stay in Vigata to eat his housekeeper Adelina's arancini (rice croquettes). For ages 14 and older.

OPERATION MINCEMEAT (2021-UK/US) 128m *** D: John Madden (SHAKESPEARE IN LOVE). Colin Firth, Matthew Macfadyen, Kelly Macdonald, Penelope Wilton, Jason Isaacs. Desperate to break Hitler's grip on occupied Europe, MI6 officers Cholomondeley (Macfadyen) and Montagu (Firth) come up with a bizarre and highly improbable plan to deceive the Nazis using a corpse and some false papers. The pair work with office worker Jean (Macdonald) to fabricate a back story for the corpse, causing emotional complications in this suspenseful, romantic and unexpectedly funny WWI spy story based on true events. THE LAST REVENGE *aka Ikon ari* (2011-Japan) 119m *** ½ D: Takashi Minamoto. Tatsuya Fujiwara, Nao Matsushita, Kin'ya Kitaôji, Hidetaka Yoshioka, Yukiyoshi Ozawa, Renji Ishibashi. The end of the shogunate marked a dramatic change in the government of Japan: the centuries-old feudal hierarchy was dismantled to lay the groundwork for a country ruled by law. Many lives were destroyed by the social turmoil. In the domain of Akizuki, the progressive thinking daimyo and his wife are brutally murdered by members of their own clan. Their son, Rokuro Usui (Fujiwara) swears vengeance, not caring that in the new Meiji Era, it is a crime punishable by death. This engrossing, extremely well-crafted film is based on the last official case of "adauchi"—samurai vengeance—in 1868. For ages 15 and older.

WHAT RICHARD DID (2012-Ireland) 88m *** D: Lenny Abrahamson (ROOM). Jack Reynor, Roisin Murphy, Lars Mikkelsen, Sam Keeley, Gavin Drea, Patrick Gibson. Dublin teenager Richard (Reynor) has a bright future ahead of him. He's a star athlete at school, he has a wonderful girlfriend (Murphy) and he'll soon be off to university. But one evening, he throws away everything he has in one moment of passion. *The New York Times* says, "Every detail of WHAT RICHARD DID rings true". Winner of 10 awards. For ages 15 and older.

MAUDIE (2016-Canada/Ireland) 115m **** D: Aisling Walsh (ELIZA-BETH IS MISSING). Sally Hawkins, Ethan Hawke, Zachary Bennett, Gabrielle Rose, Kari Matchett. In this true story set in 1930s rural Nova Scotia, Maud (Hawkins) suffers from severe arthritis and is often mistaken for someone stupid and incapable. Her abilities are even dismissed by her Aunt Ida (Rose), who lives with her. Eager to get out from under her aunt's thumb, Maud applies for a job that changes her life in this beautifully acted, unusual love story based on the life of artist Maud Lewis. Winner of 25 awards. Rated PG-13.

THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: BROKENWOOD THE MUSI-CAL (2023-New Zealand) 98m *** ¹/₂ D: Katie Wolf. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Cristina Serban Ionda, Simon Leary, Peter Hambleton, Roimata Fox. In this screamingly funny whodunit featuring a musical theater performance celebrating Brokenwood's history, the playwright, Terrence Weaver (Leary) dies under *shocking* circumstances. Some of Brokenwood's amateur stage performers from TO DIE OR NOT TO DIE make a curtain call in this episode. For ages 14 and older.

SWIMMING WITH MEN (2018-UK) 96m *** D: Oliver Parker (AN IDE-AL HUSBAND). Rob Brydon, Rupert Graves, Adeel Akhtar, Jim Carter, Thomas Turgoose, Jane Horrocks, Daniel Mays. London accountant Eric (Brydon) escapes his boring routine each night at the local swimming pool. One day, he encounters a secret club of men, middle-aged like him, arguing as they try to construct patterns in the water. Soon, Eric joins them, a hopelessly inept team of male synchronized swimmers. This delightful comedy follows the plucky group as they train for the championship in Milan. For ages 12 and older.

WONKA (2023-US/UK/Canada) 116m *** ½ D: Paul King (PADDING-TON). Timothée Chalamet, Olivia Colman, Sally Hawkins (MAUDIE), Calah Lane, Hugh Grant, Paterson Joseph, Matt Lucas, Mathew Baynton, Jim Carter, Freya Parker. Set in the years before he has a chocolate factory, poor, young but talented Willy Wonka's (Chalamet) only dream is to open a candy shop in the swanky Galeries Gourmet. Unluckily for him, the city is run by a chocolate cartel of Slugworth (Joseph), Prodnose (Lucas) and Fickelgruber (Baynton). But thanks to his pals and a giraffe named Abigail, Willy fights back with treats of "Pure Imagination" in this winner of 1 award. Rated PG.

SUDDEN ATTACK OF THE CHRISTIAN LORD *aka Jan Arima no shûgeki* (1959-Japan) 114m *** D: Daisuke Itô. Raizô Ichikawa, Sô Yamamura, Masao Mishima, Junko Kanô, Keiko Yumi. Devout Christian Lord John Arima's (Ichikawa) loyal retainer Saburobyôue (Yamamura) is a witness to a terrible injustice. In Macau, a group of Japanese civilians is executed for a crime they didn't commit. A delegation of Portuguese arrives in Nagasaki, demanding an apology from the Japanese government. Outraged, Lord Arima swears vengeance. This exciting, well-staged but rarely seen swashbuckler is based on real history: Lord Arima of the Shimabara Domain was a Christian daimyo who, against the wishes of the shogunate, attacked a Portuguese trading ship in 1609. For ages 12 and older.
