THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: OLD BLOOD MONEY (2023-New Zealand) 97m *** ½ D: David de Lautour. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Jarod Rawiri, Ingrid Park, Sam Bunkall, Irene Wood. Serial gold-digger Jools Fahey (Park) is found on an isolated country road, unconscious, with a dead body in her car's trunk. It turns out she was on her way home from the 90th birthday party of wealthy matron Dolly Wadsworth (Wood), whose son Charles (Bunkall) is Jools's fiancé. To unravel this mystery, Mike (Rea) and his team must wade into the Wadsworth family's colorful history. For ages 14 and older.

LOUIS: THE CHILD KING *aka Louis, enfant roi* (1993-France) 156m *** D: Roger Planchon. Carmen Maura, Maxime Mansion, Paolo Graziosi, Jocelyn Quivrin, Hervé Briaux, Serge Dupire. This lavish costume drama depicts the turbulent period in French history (1648-1653) known as The Fronde, a series of civil wars that tore young Louis XIV's (Mansion) family apart into opposing factions. Asked at the age of 10 to decide matters of state, the future Sun King is forced to quickly learn to navigate treacherous political waters in this fascinating film. Winner of 1 award. For ages 15 and older.

STORIES NOT TO BE TOLD *aka Historias para no contar* (2022-Spain) 100m *** D: Cesc Gay (TRUMAN). Anna Castillo, Chino Darín, Antonio de la Torre, Alex Brendemühl, Maribel Verdú, Javier Cámara, Quim Gutiérrez. Five comedic tales set in Barcelona illustrate the insecurities and little lies people try to hide. (1) Friends Laura (Castillo) and Alex (Darín) reveal their true feelings on a suspenseful day at Laura's apartment. (2) Luis (Brendemühl) is encouraged to pick up a woman by his well-meaning friend Carlos (de la Torre). (3) Three women friends run into each other at an audition. (4) An older man takes his young lover to lunch. (5) A cheating husband's (Gutiérrez) confession doesn't go quite as planned. Winner of 1 award. For ages 15 and older.

PHOTOGRAPH (2019-Germany/India/US) 104m *** D: Ritesh Batra (THE LUNCHBOX). Nawazuddin Siddiqui, Sanya Malhotra, Sachin Khedekar, Farrukh Jaffar. Struggling street photographer Rafi (Siddiqui) snaps a photo of shy middle class girl Miloni (Malhotra) at Mumbai's Gateway of India, only to have her wander away without paying. Intrigued by her beauty, Rafi sends Miloni's picture to his grandmother (Jaffar), writing that she's his fiancée. When Rafi tracks Miloni down to ask her if she'd pose as his fiancée she agrees, taking her away from her bland bourgeois existence to dream of a different life. Winner of 3 awards. For ages 12 and older.

LOVE'S TWISTING PATH *aka Tajūrō jun'ai-ki* (2018-Japan) 93m *** D: Sadao Nakajima. Kengo Kōra, Mikako Tabe, Ryō Kimura, Masatoshi Nagase. In the last days of the Tokugawa shogunate, Kyoto's streets are bloody from skirmishes between imperialist Choshu and Satsuma rebels against the shogun's police. In dire need of skilled fighters, the Choshu seek out master swordsman Tajūrō (Kōra) to recruit him to their cause. Tajūrō refuses, stating that he has given up the sword. But when his beloved Otoyō (Tabe) and his younger brother Kazuma (Kimura) are caught up in the violence, Tajūrō enters the fray in this tragic love story. For ages 15 and older.

BUDDHA *aka Shaka* (1961-Japan/Philippines) 155m *** D: Kenji Misumi (THE LAST SAMURAI). Kōjirō Hongō, Charito Solis, Shintarō Katsu, Raizō Ichikawa, Machiko Kyō, Isuzu Yamada. Inspired by the grand sword and sandal epics from Italy and Hollywood, director Misumi created this big budget spectacular on the life of Buddha. Prince Siddhartha (Hongō) gives up a pampered existence and the attentions of beautiful Princess Yashodara (Solis) to seek a solution for humanity's suffering. The dastardly Devadatta (Katsu) stands in Siddhartha's way in this unique spectacle of miraculous visions and noble maidens. Winner of 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

TWO HANDS (1999-Australia) 94m *** ½ D: Gregor Jordan. Heath Ledger (THE DARK KNIGHT), Bryan Brown, Rose Byrne (SPY), David Field, Tom Long. Nineteen-year-old gangster wannabe Jimmy (Ledger) is hired by Sydney drug dealer Pando (Brown) to deliver the gang's loot in this entertaining black comedy. When Jimmy loses the stash at Bondi Beach, he has to figure out a way to pay back Pando—or die. Winner of 15 awards, 3 of them for Heath Ledger's breakout performance. For ages 15 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: THE SCENT OF NIGHT *aka L'odore della notte* (2002-Italy) 109m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Daniella Marazzita, Angelo Russo. Respected financial planner Gargano skips town, taking with him the fortunes of many Vigata residents. Despite being peppered with questions from Detective Montalbano (Zingaretti), the con man's secretary Maria Stella (Marazzita) is unshakably loyal to her boss. Meanwhile, Montalbano's deputy Augello (Bocci) is panicking over his upcoming wedding. For ages 14 and older.

DRIVE MY CAR (2021-Japan) 179m **** D: Ryūsuke Hamaguchi (HAPPY HOUR). Hidetoshi Nishijima, Tōko Miura, Reika Kirishima, Masaki Okada, Park Yu-rim, Jin Dae-yeon. Stage actor and director Kafuku (Nishijima) uses time in his beloved car, a red Saab 900, practicing his lines with a cassette that his wife Oto (Kirishima) recorded for him. Still grieving two years after Oto's unexpected death, he's asked to direct a production of Chekhov's Uncle Vanya in Hiroshima—on the condition that he use a chauffeur. This road movie unlike no other delves deeply into its characters—Kafuku the passenger and Misaki (Miura) the driver—to explore the meaning of existence. Winner of the Best International Film Oscar and 95 more awards. For ages 15 and older.

FERRARI (2023-US/UK/Italy/China) 130m *** D: Michael Mann (HEAT). Adam Driver, Penélope Cruz, Shailene Woodley. Ex-racecar driver Enzo Ferrari (Driver) faces difficult decisions. The car company he and his wife Laura (Cruz) built from nothing is going bankrupt. He and Laura grieve over their lost son, and struggle over the acknowledgement of another—Laura knows about Enzo's many affairs but doesn't know he has a secret family with Lina Lardi (Woodley). Backed up against a wall, Enzo gambles everything on the 1957 Mille Miglia, the treacherous 1000-mile race across Italy. Winner of 4 awards. Rated R.

THE GREAT SPIRIT *aka Il grande spirito* (2019-Italy) 114m *** D: Sergio Rubini (THE CÉZANNE AFFAIR). Sergio Rubini, Rocco Papaleo, Bianca Guaccero, Ivana Lotito. In a grubby industrial neighborhood on the outskirts of Taranto, Puglia, Tonino (Rubini) double crosses his accomplices and runs off with the loot in this funny and highly original thriller. Tonino is stranded on a rooftop when an oddball named Renato (Papaleo) helps Tonino hide from his pursuers. Renato, who says he's a member of the Sioux tribe, proclaims Tonino as the Man of Destiny that the Great Spirit had foretold. Nominated for 2 awards. For ages 12 and older. *Note: Edan is 7 on 4/19!*

THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: NUN OF THE ABOVE (2023-New Zealand) 97m ***½ D: Sima Urale. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Jarod Rawiri, Laurel Devenie, Carolyn Dando. Sister Angelica (Dando), one of the singing sisters of St. Monica, is found strangled by the cincture (belt) belonging to one of her fellow sisters. Detective Mike Shepherd (Rea) and his team have a tough time gathering information from the nuns, who have taken an oath of silence in this entertaining episode. For ages 14 and older.

FALLEN LEAVES *aka Kuolleet lehdet* (2023-Finland/Germany) 78m *** ½ D: Aki Kaurismäki (LE HAVRE). Alma Pöysti, Jussi Vatanen, Janne Hyytiäinen, Nappu Koivu. In this charmingly deadpan romantic comedy, two lonely souls Ansa (Pöysti) and Holappa (Vatanen) seek each other in a bleak and unkempt Helsinki neighborhood. Ansa struggles to find a steady enough job to keep ahead of her electric bills. Holappa's job is so dehumanizing he keeps vodka in his locker. Finland is famous for being the world's happiest country—this movie hints at the wisdom behind this success. Winner of 9 awards, including one from Cannes. For ages 12 and older.

THE COLOR PURPLE (2023-US) 141m *** ½ D: Blitz Bazawule. Fantasia Barrino, Taraji P. Henson, Danielle Brooks, Colman Domingo, Corey Hawkins. Alice Walker's Pulitzer-winning novel comes to vibrant life in this uplifting adaptation of the Tony-winning musical. Two sisters, Celie and Nettie, who live on the Georgia coast in the early 20th century are separated when Celie is sold into marriage to a violent man (Domingo). After many years of abuse, Celie (Barrino) is inspired by two very different women, her daughter-in-law Sofia (Brooks) and singer Shug (Henson), to stand up for herself and find happiness. Winner of 26 awards and nominated for 1 Oscar. Rated PG-13.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: THE CAT AND THE GOLDFINCH *aka Gatto e cardellino* (2002-Italy) 95m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Cristina Marocco, Peppino Mazzotta, Erika Ferrara. Someone is mugging old ladies on their way to church. Thankfully, the mugger is a terrible shot, and the victims are unharmed (so far). Detective Mimi (Bocci), who is on leave to get married, is temporarily replaced by gorgeous Barbara (Marocco), who causes quite a stir at the police station. Meanwhile, a married gynecologist goes missing, leaving a pregnant girl (Ferrara) and her enraged father for Montalbano (Zingaretti) to handle. For ages 14 and older.

THE MAN FROM MAJORCA *aka Mannen från Mallorca* (1984-Sweden/Denmark) 112m *** ½ D: Bo Widerberg (MAN ON THE ROOF). Sven Wolter, Tomas von Brömssen, Ernst Günther, Rico Rönnbäck. On St. Lucia Day, when little girls parade through the streets of Stockholm, a thief robs a crowded post office. Two cops from vice (aka "the ape house"), Jarnebring (Wolter) and Johansson (von Brömssen), scrupulously follow up on leads and close in on a suspect—a member of an elite police squad. Just as they build a case, alibis crop up, witnesses lose their certainty and they themselves begin to doubt their own eyes. Who is protecting the suspect? This fast and funny actioner won 1 award. For ages 15 and older.
