PEREZ. (2014-Italy) 91m *** D: Edoardo De Angelis. Luca Zingaretti (DETECTIVE MONTALBANO), Marco D'Amore, Simona Tabasco, Massimiliano Gallo. Lawyer Demetrio Perez (Zingaretti) is a desperate man. His life is being threatened by a band of thugs, his daughter Tea (Tabasco) is involved with a criminal (D'Amore) and he has the thankless job of defending a mob boss (Gallo). Backed up against a wall, Demetrio comes up with a crazy plan that will solve all his problems... if he can stay one step ahead of his enemies. This cracking Italian film noir shot in Naples won two awards. For ages 15 and older.

BOGOWIE aka Gods (2014-Poland) 116m *** ½ D: Lukasz Palkowski. Tomasz Kot, Piotr Glowacki, Szymon Piotr Warszawski, Magdalena Czerwinska, Rafal Zawierucha. In the 1980s, the Iron Curtain was a palpable divide. Medical innovation in Poland arrived solely from doctors fortunate enough to have studied or worked in western Europe or the US. Maverick surgeon Zbigniew Religa (Kot), a tall, shambling chain smoker decides, against all kinds of opposition, to open his own clinic and be the first Polish doctor to transplant a human heart. This thrilling feel-good biopic won 22 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE COUNT OF MONTE-CRISTO aka Le Comte de Monte-Cristo (2024-France/ Belgium) 178m *** ½ D: Alexandre de La Patellière, Matthieu Delaporte. Pierre Niney, Bastien Bouillon, Laurent Lafitte, Pierfrancesco Favino. This sumptuous adaptation of Alexandre Dumas' adventure novel begins in 1815 during Napoleon's exile in Elba. Young sailor Edmond Dantès (Niney) is arrested for a crime he didn't commit and is imprisoned on a remote island. During his sentence he meets Abbé Faria (Favino), who transforms Edmond's fate. After a daring escape, Edmond takes on a new identity and swears revenge in this stylish winner of 6 awards. For ages 12 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: LOVE aka Amore (2018-Italy) 107m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Angelo Russo, Sonia Bergamasco. Detective Montalbano (Zingaretti) is investigating the disappearance of a beautiful young woman when he and his team realize those who have wronged her are turning up dead. Montalbano suffers a pang of jealousy when his girlfriend Livia (Bergamasco) tells him that her old boyfriend has gotten in touch with her over social media. Unable to help himself, he has Catarella (Russo) hack Livia's social media account in this amusing episode. For ages 14 and older.

TAPED (2012-Netherlands) 81m *** D: Diederik Van Rooijen (BOLLYWOOD HERO). Susan Visser, Barry Atsma. On vacation in Argentina, young Dutch couple Saar (Visser) and Johan (Atsma) document their trip on video camera so they may share it with their little daughter. Just as they are about to depart, they stumble upon a murder and accidentally film it on their camera. To their horror, they are immediately spotted and are forced to flee. In a land where they don't speak the language, they have no one to turn to: the assailant is a cop. This heart-pounding thriller won 1 award. For ages 16 and older.

A REAL PAIN (2024-US/Poland) 90m *** ½ D: Jesse Eisenberg. Kieran Culkin (Succession), Jesse Eisenberg, Will Sharpe (The White Lotus), Jennifer Grey. American cousins David (Eisenberg) and Benji (Culkin) Kaplan go on a trip to Poland together to honor their beloved late grandmother, a Holocaust survivor. Uptight David meticulously follows the rules while playful Benji happily breaks them. Benji is the one to get all the love and attention while David cleans up the mess. Through their eyes their family's history unfolds in this funny, touching and thought-provoking film. Winner of 66 awards including an Oscar for Culkin's heartfelt performance. Rated R.

BUNNY DROP aka Usagi doroppu (2011-Japan) 114m *** D: Sabu (UNLUCKY MONKEY). Ken'ichi Matsuyama, Karina, Mana Ashida, Mirei Kiritani. In this movie adaptation of the hit manga Usagi Doroppu, 27-year-old salary man Daikichi (Matsuyama) attends his grandfather's funeral. There he meets his grandfather's 6-year-old illegitimate daughter(!) Rin (Ashida), who's rejected by Daikichi's conservative family. Without knowing anything about caring for a child, Daikichi adopts Rin and plunges into a new adventure. This charming comedy won an award. For ages 10 and older.

MISS FISHER'S MURDER MYSTERIES Episodes 5 & 6 (2012-Australia) 110m *** ½ D: David Caesar. Essie Davis, Nathan Page, Ashleigh Cummings, Kat Stewart, Philippe Sung. A young Zionist dies in a bookstore, and store employee Miss Leigh (Stewart) is arrested and charged with his murder. Private eye Phryne Fisher (Davis) believes Leigh is innocent, and that the real killer can be revealed through finding an obscure book. Later, Phryne treats Dot (Cummings) to a night at the theater that becomes shockingly dramatic when an actor drops dead on stage. Even worse, Phryne's dashing new love interest Lin Chung (Sung) is a suspect. For ages 15 and older.

ONE NIGHT aka Hitoyo (2019-Japan) 124m *** D: Kazuya Shiraishi. Yûko Tanaka, Takeru Satoh, Mayu Matsuoka, Ryôhei Suzuki, Kuranosuke Sasaki. One May evening, Koharu (Tanaka) comes home to her three badly bruised and battered children to announce that she has just killed their abusive tyrant of a father. "You can live however you want, you're totally free." Placing their dinner on the table, Koharu walks out into the night to turn herself in to the police. Fifteen years later, Koharu returns from prison to reunite with her children in this powerful social drama. Nominated for 4 awards. For ages 15 and older.

FOYLE'S WAR: ALL CLEAR (2008-UK) 93m **** D: Tristram Powell. Michael Kitchen, Honeysuckle Weeks, Jay Benedict, Julian Ovenden, Anthony Howell. May 1945: DCS Foyle (Kitchen) joins a municipal committee to plan the imminent V-E Day celebration and is delighted to see his American friend, Maj. John Kiefer (Benedict), is also on the committee. But three years of war have changed John to a man twisted by rage and grief. When a member of the committee is found dead, Foyle finds a connection between the deceased and Kiefer. Foyle's son Andrew (Ovenden) comes home, wondering if Sam (Weeks) would talk to him again. For ages 14 and older.

ONE CHANCE (2013-UK/US) 103m *** D: David Frankel (THE DEVIL WEARS PRADA). James Corden, Alexandra Roach, Julie Walters, Colm Meaney, Mackenzie Crook. This heartwarming true story concerns Welsh car phone salesman Paul Potts (Corden), who dreams of a career singing opera. Though blessed with a clear, soaring tenor voice, Paul is belittled and bullied at school and at work. When he meets Julz (Roach) he is inspired to persevere through the toughest of obstacles. This charming romance won 3 awards. Rated PG-13. Note: Paul Pott's vocals are used in this film.

TOKYO FIANCÉE (2014-Belgium/France/Canada/Japan) 100m *** D: Stefan Liberski. Pauline Etienne, Taichi Inoue, Julie Le Breton, Alice de Lencquesaing. Perky 20-year-old Belgian gamine Amélie (Etienne) takes a one-way flight to Japan with the goal of becoming Japanese. She spent the first 5 years of her life there and has since fantasized of becoming a Japanese writer. To pay for her existence she offers French lessons, and soon she has a student who is the mirror image of her: Rinri (Inoue), a young man obsessed with all things French. The two embark on a romance in this tale of misdirected love. Nominated for 3 awards.

THE SPECTATOR aka La spettatrice (2004-Italy) 98m *** D: Paolo Franchi. Barbora Bobulova, Andrea Renzi, Brigitte Catillon. Simultaneous interpreter Valeria (Bobulova) lives a quiet, solitary life in Turin, Italy. She has no romantic attachments, but she has one fixation: the man (Renzi) who lives in an apartment across the street. One day, Valeria is called upon to translate for him at a conference, and her life begins to open up to bigger possibilities in this thoughtful and well-crafted romantic mystery. Winner of 7 awards. For ages 12 and older.

ATTILA MARCEL (2013-France) 106m ***1/2 D: Sylvain Chomet (THE TRIPLETS OF BELLEVILLE). Guillaume Gouix, Anne Le Ny, Bernadette Lafont, Hélène Vincent. Paul (Gouix) is a 33-year-old piano virtuoso who lives with two doting maiden aunts Anna (Vincent) and Annie (Lafont) in Paris. Paul suffered from a childhood trauma (that he can't quite remember) at the age of two which left him an orphan. He hasn't spoken a word since. In a chance encounter, Paul meets his neighbor Mme. Proust (Le Ny), who prods his memory with tea and madeleines (of course). This delightfully eccentric live action comedy won 2 awards. For ages 10 and older. Happy Birthday, Edan!

SIGHT (2023-US) 103m *** D: Andrew Hyatt. Terry Chen, Greg Kinnear, Natasha Mumba, Fionnula Flanagan, Ben Wang, Mia Swaminathan. Pioneering eye surgeon Ming Wang (Chen) has a crisis of faith when he is given the challenge of restoring the sight of Kajal (Swaminathan), an Indian orphan who was blinded by her stepmother so she would earn more as a beggar. Dr. Wang tries to reconcile with his past as a young man (Wang) who lost loved ones during the Cultural Revolution and reaches an epiphany in this inspiring true story. Winner of 5 awards. PG-13.

HEART OF OAK aka Le Chêne (2022-France) 81m *** ½ D: Laurent Charbonnier, Michel Seydoux. This enthralling film without dialogue chronicles 18 months in the life of a 210-year-old oak tree in Sologne, France. The tree supports a community of animals, from tiny acorn weevils to cheeky red squirrels to majestic deer. Their stories play out through remarkable nature photography that captures the daily drama of survival, the beauty of the forest, and the joys of new life. If you loved MICROCOSMOS, you will love this film. Nominated for Best Documentary at the César Awards. For all ages.

HARRY PRICE: GHOST HUNTER (2015-UK) 89m *** D: Alex Pillai. Rafe Spall, Cara Theobold, Richie Campbell, Zoe Boyle, Tom Ward, Lewis Reeves. Grace (Boyle), the wife of ambitious politician Edward Goodwin (Ward), distractedly wanders naked through the streets of 1920s London in this genuinely spooky mystery. Concerned that Grace is under the malign influence of supernatural forces, Edward hires Harry Price (Spall), notorious medium, to flush out whatever is haunting their home. Price, who thinks Grace's problems are psychological, is shaken when the unexplainable happens in this tale based on real ghost hunter Harry Price. For ages 12 and older.
