THE MASTERAND HIS PUPIL (2003-Netherlands) 88m ****
D: Sonia Herman Dolz. This stylish documentary chronicles the transformations of three aspiring young conductors, Jason Lai, Alexis Soriano and Otto Tausk as they attend a week-long master class with maestro Valery Gergiev in 2002. Lai, Soriano and Tausk conduct the Rotterdam Youth Philharmonic Orchestra performing "Prometheus" and "Poem of Ecstasy" by Alexander Scriabin. Deft camerawork and thrilling music combine with Gergiev's charisma and brilliant musicality to create a deeply inspiring cinematic experience. Winner of 2 awards. For all ages. Movie Museum does not promote the political views of the artists represented in its screenings.

A CAT WITH A DOG aka Jak pies z kotem (2018-Poland) 98m *** D: Janusz Kondratiuk. Olgierd Lukaszewicz, Robert Wieckiewicz, Bozena Stachura, Aleksandra Konieczna. Estranged brothers Andrzej (Lukaszewicz) and Janusz (Wieckiewicz) are both successful film directors. When older brother Andrzej becomes paralyzed after a stroke, Janusz and his wife Beata (Stachura) take on the daunting task of caring for selfish and impulsive Andrzej, with no help from his wife Iga (Konieczna), an incorrigible lush. This stylish, touching comedy-drama with flashes of imaginative fantasy won 4 awards. For ages 15 and older.

BEFORE SNOWFALL aka For snoon faller (2013-Norway/ Germany/Iraq) 101m *** ½ D: Hisham Zaman. Abdullah Taher, Suzan Ilir, Bahar Ozen. Sixteen-year-old Siyar (Taher) has become the head of the household upon the death of his father. When his sister Nermin (Ozen) flees her arranged wedding, Siyar is obligated to leave his home in Iraqi Kurdistan to find her—not to bring her back—but to kill her to restore the family honor. This powerful, beautifully shot film follows Siyar's illegal migration to Istanbul, Greece, Germany and Oslo, Norway in search of his sister. Winner of 6 awards. For ages 15 and older.

SINCERELY YOURS aka Amitiés sincères (2012-France) 105m *** D: Stéphan Archinard, François Prévot-Leygonie. Gérard Lanvin, Jean-Hugues Anglade, Wladimir Yordanoff, Ana Girardot. Restaurateur Walter (Lanvin), a loving and fiercely loyal father and friend, can't stand lies. He believes his daughter Clémence (Girardot) and his lifelong friends Paul (Anglade) and Jacques (Yordanoff) tell him everything, but Walter can be so pig-headed there are things you just can't tell him. One day, a series of little events threatens to reveal the secrets his loved ones have hidden from him for years in this charming comedy. For ages 15 and older.

ANOTHER ROUND aka Druk (2020-Denmark/Sweden/Netherlands) 117m **** ½ D: Thomas Vinterberg (THE HUNT). Mads Mikkelsen, Thomas Bo Larsen, Magnus Millang, Lars Ranthe, Maria Bonnevie. Four middle-aged high school teachers test psychiatrist Finn Skårderud's theory that man at birth has a 0.05% blood alcohol deficit. Maintaining a slight buzz at school gives each of the friends a boost in teaching performance: Martin's (Mikkelsen) formerly bored history students are now enthusiastic about their studies. However, the friends' experiment soon begins to collide with reality in this comedy-drama. Winner of the Best International Feature Oscar. For ages 15 and older.

THE MOHICAN COMES HOME aka Mohican kokyô ni kaeru (2016-Japan) 125m D: Shûichi Okita. Ryûhei Matsuda, Akira Emoto, Atsuko Maeda, Masako Motai. This heartwarming comedy is an updated homage to the 1951 Japanese classic CARMEN COMES HOME, with Mohawk-sporting punk rocker Eikichi (Matsuda) in place of the showgirl heroine. After his fellow band members leave to get real jobs, Eikichi ditches Tokyo to go home to his Hiroshima island village with his pregnant girlfriend Yuka (Maeda) and visit his grouchy high school band leader dad (Emoto). Winner of 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

THE NEPHEW (1998-Ireland) 100m *** D: Eugene Brady. Hill Harper, Donal McCann, Pierce Brosnan, Sinéad Cusack, Aislin McGuckin, Phelim Drew, Luke Griffin, Niall Toibin. Friendly Chad (Harper), a 17-year-old New Yorker, arrives in a small Irish island town to visit his estranged uncle Tony (McCann), a grumpy and narrow-minded farmer. The little town is abuzz about the handsome dreadlocked stranger, unlocking closets full of skeletons in this breezy romantic comedydrama. A delightful Celtic soundtrack and gorgeous scenery make this film a treat for eyes and ears. PG-13. Screened with English subtitles.

TORREMOLINOS 73 (2003-Spain/Denmark) 88m *** D: Pablo Berger (BLANCANIEVES). Javier Cámara, Candela Peña, Juan Diego, Mads Mikkelsen, Ramón Barea, Fernando Tejero. In this comedy set in 1970s Spain, cash-strapped encyclopedia salesman Alfredo (Cámara) and his demure wife Carmen (Peña) are enlisted by Alfredo's scheming boss to create a series of sex films for an "encyclopedia of reproduction". Soon, shy Carmen is the hottest adult film star in Scandinavia and Alfredo aspires to become the next Ingmar Bergman! Winner of 15 awards. For ages 15 and older.

GIBRALTAR aka The Informant (2013-France/Canada) 111m *** D: Julien Leclercq. Gilles Lellouche, Tahar Rahim (A PROPHET), Riccardo Scamarcio, Mélanie Bernier. In this intense thriller set in 1987, Marc (Lellouche) and his wife run a popular pub in Gibraltar, a nearly lawless zone where only 10% of illegal drugs shipped through its port is recovered. Marc struggles to pay his bills and is too broke to hold onto his prized sailboat. When he is approached by hotshot French customs agent Belimane (Rahim) to become an informant to catch the traffickers who frequent his bar, Marc gets deeper and deeper into danger to clear his debts. For ages 15 and older.

THE CHESSPLAYER aka El jugador de ajedrez (2017-Spain) 98m *** D: Luis Oliveros. Marc Clotet, Melina Matthews, Lionel Auguste, Alejo Sauras, Stefan Weinert, Andrés Gertrúdix. In this well-crafted tale of survival set in 1934, Diego (Clotet) wins the Spanish Championship of Chess and catches the eye of lovely French journalist Marianne (Matthews). Diego's future looks bright: he marries Marianne and is in demand as a chessmaster. But in the teeth of the Spanish Civil War, Marianne and Diego move to Paris in 1939, soon to be occupied by the Nazis. Winner of 16 awards.

BOYCHOIR (2014-US/Canada) 103m *** D: François Girard (THE RED VIOLIN). Dustin Hoffman, Garrett Wareing, Kathy Bates, Eddie Izzard, Debra Winger. Grieving the loss of his single mother, 11-year-old Stet (Wareing) leaves his small Texas town to enroll in an exclusive East coast boy choir academy. Stet is extremely talented, but also angry and mistrustful of authority. He will need every bit of discipline and hard work to showcase his gift for music in this coming-of-age tale. Exquisite choral singing is the highlight of this Valladolid Film Festival award nominee. PG

KARBALA (2015-Poland/Bulgaria) 111m *** ½ D: Krzysztof Lukaszewicz. Bartlomiej Topa, Antoni Królikowski, Hristo Shopov, Atheer Adel, Leszek Lichota, Michal Zurawski. In this gripping war drama inspired by the events of 2004 during the Iraqi holiday of Ashura, rebels loyal to Shiite leader Muqtada Al-Sadr attack Karbala City Hall, cutting it off from the rest of the city. The men left under siege in City Hall include 32 poorly equipped Polish soldiers and a dozen men of the Bulgarian special forces. As the siege wears on and supplies of food and ammo run low, the men hatch a desperate plan. This suspenseful thriller won 2 awards. For ages 15 and older.

PIANO, SOLO (2007-Italy) 100m *** D: Riccardo Milani (DO YOU SEE ME?). Kim Rossi Stuart, Jasmine Trinca, Paola Cortellesi, Michele Placido. Kim Rossi Stuart delivers a bravura performance as jazz pianist Luca Flores in this immersive biopic. Young Luca is introduced to jazz while learning classical piano at the Luigi Cherubini conservatory of music in Florence. Despite the misgivings of his father Giovanni (Placido), Luca goes on to become a successful jazz musician, playing with the likes of Chet Baker. Struggling with mental illness, Luca begins to withdraw from his loved ones in this tragic tale. Winner of 2 awards. For ages 15 and older.

TCHAO PANTIN (1983-France) 91m *** ½ D: Claude Berri (JEAN DE FLORETTE). Coluche, Richard Anconina, Agnès Soral, Mahmoud Zemmouri. Trying to elude the police, small-time criminal Youssef (Anconina) escapes into the gas station run by Lambert (Coluche), an alcoholic ex-cop. The two strike up an unlikely friendship in this superior policier set in the working class district of Pantin in Paris. Winner of 5 Césars including Best Actor for Coluche, Best Supporting Actor for Anconina and Best Cinematography for Bruno Nuytten. For ages 15 and older.

DEAD IN A WEEK OR YOUR MONEY BACK (2018-UK) 90m *** D: Tom Edmunds (feature debut). Tom Wilkinson, Aneurin Barnard, Christopher Eccleston. After his ninth failed attempt at suicide, 20-something William (Barnard) hires hitman Leslie (Wilkinson) to do the job. Leslie, who's under pressure from his boss (Eccleston) to retire, hasn't met his quota of kills to keep his membership in the assassin's guild. But almost as soon as William hires Leslie, William meets the girl his dreams! This hilarious black comedy was nominated for an award. For ages 12 and older.

PROMISING YOUNG WOMAN (2020-UK/US) 114m *** ½ D: Emerald Fennell (feature debut). Carey Mulligan, Bo Burnham, Laverne Cox, Alison Brie, Adam Brody, Jennifer Coolidge. Cassie (Mulligan) was once a promising young medical student. Now pushing 30, she works as a barista and lives at home with her worried parents. At night, wearing slinky dresses and high heels, she hangs out at bars and nightclubs to set right the things that derailed her career. This darkly funny and deeply unsettling thriller won the Best Original Screenplay Oscar for director Emerald Fennell. Rated R.

CLARA CAMPOAMOR: LA MUJER OLVIDA-DA (2011-Spain) 93m *** D: Laura Mañá. Elvira Minguez, Antonio de la Torre, Mónica López, Joan Carreras, Pep Cruz, Fermí Reixach. This year, 2021, marks the 90th anniversary of woman's sufrage in Spain. Clara Campoamor (Minguez), only one of two women in the legislative body for the newly established Second Spanish Republic, was instrumental to securing equal rights for women in the new constitution. This engrossing biopic chronicles her battle. Nominated for 2 awards. For ages 12 and older.

MY BACK PAGE (2011-Japan) 141m *** D: Nobuhiro Yamashita (LINDA LINDA LINDA). Satoshi Tsumabuki, Ken'ichi Matsuyama, Shiori Kutsuna, Tomokazu Miura. It's 1969 and Tokyo is roiling with student protests. Idealistic young journalist Sawada (Tsumabuki) wants more than anything to write a scoop at the Touto newspaper, where gonzo journalism is the norm. In 1971, Sawada meets young radical Umeyama (Matsuyama), who tells Sawada he is planning an armed insurrection. Wrestling with his own conscience, Sawada follows Umeyama down a dangerous political rabbit hole in this winner of 2 awards. For ages 15 and older.

UNDER THE STARRY SKY aka Des étoiles (2013-France/Belgium/Senegal) 82m *** ½ D: Dyana Gaye. Ralph Amoussou, Marème Demba Ly, Souleymane Seye Ndiaye. Young bride Sophie (Ly) travels from Dakar, Senegal to Turin, Italy to search for her husband Abdoulaye (Ndiaye) in this intriguing drama about the migrations of an African family. Sophie is too late—Abdoulaye has left for New York desperately searching for work, as he must pay back a hefty debt. Meanwhile, Sophie's New York-born cousin Thierno (Amoussou) travels to Dakar for the first time to bury his father. Each discovers a new path. Winner of 2 awards. For ages 12 and older.

VOYAGE SURPRISE (1947-France) 105m **** D: Pierre Prévert. Sinoël, Etienne Decroux, Maurice Baquet, René Bourbon, Martine Carol, Jacques-Henry Duval, Piéral, Annette Poivre. Everyone is saying old man Piuff (Sinoël) has gone mad. His fleabag travel company has no money left, and his rival M. Grosbois's company looks bigger and flashier by the day. Undeterred, Piuff is advertising a "Voyage Surprise" that has no itinerary! Meanwhile, revolutionary Mikhail (Decroux) is at large, having stolen a fortune from the Grand Duchess of Strombolia (Piéral). This hilarious romp written by Pierre Prévert's famous brother Jacques is perfectly Lubitschious! It's the acknowledged inspiration for the Beatles' Magical Mystery Tour. For ages 10 and up.
