CHILDHOOD DAYS *aka Shōnen jidai* (1990-Japan) 117m *** ½ D: Masahiro Shinoda (PALE FLOWER). Tetsuya Fujita, Yuji Horioka, Katsuhisa Yamazaki, Shima Iwashita. Eleven-year-old Shinji (Fujita) is evacuated to rural Toyama to escape the bombing of Tokyo during World War II. Though his parents believe Shinji will have an idyllic time in the countryside, he instead faces the harsh society of village kids who don't much like smart city boys. Shinji allies himself with class bully Takeshi (Horioka) to gain status in this coming-of-age story. Winner of 15 awards. For ages 12 and older.

300 MILES TO HEAVEN *aka 300 mil do nieba* (1989-Denmark/France/Poland) 90m *** ½ D: Maciej Dejczer. Wojciech Klata, Rafal Zimowski, Kama Kowalewska, Jadwiga Jankowska-Cieślak, Andrzej Mellin. Inspired by a true story, this gripping drama set in 1985 Poland concerns 12-year-old Grzesi (Klata) and 15-year-old brother Jędrrek (Zimowski), who stow themselves in the undercarriage of a truck to escape poverty and start a new life in the West. Winner of 4 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE THIRD SHADOW *aka Daisan no kagemusha* (1963-Japan) 104m *** ½ D: Umetsugu Inoue (KUROKAGE). Raizō Ichikawa, Hizuru Takachiho, Masayo Banri, Sadamitsu Miki. Young Kyūnosuke (Ichikawa) wants nothing more than to leave his father's farm and become a samurai. When a retainer for ambitious Lord Yasutaka offers to employ him, Kyūnosuke is delighted. Upon reaching the castle, Kyūnosuke learns that, due to his striking resemblance to Lord Yasutaka, he will be trained as a shadow warrior. He soon begins to realize what a terrible price he will pay... For ages 15 and older.

NOTHING IN RETURN *aka A cambio de nada* (2015-Spain) 94m *** D: Daniel Guzmán. Miguel Herrán, Luis Tosar, Antonio Bachiller, Antonia Guzmán, Felipe García Vélaz. Sixteen-year-old Darío (Herrán) escapes his dysfunctional family and lives a life of petty crime in a barrio of Madrid. He creates a new family with his best friend Luismi (Bachiller), an old lady (Guzmán) who collects furniture discarded on the street, and sad sack mechanic Justo (Vélaz). This slice-of-life comedy-drama won 12 awards. For ages 12 and older.

LOVE IN THE STRANGEST WAY *aka Elles n'oublient jamais* (1994-France) 102m *** D: Christopher Frank. Thierry Lhermitte, Maruschka Detmers, Nadia Farès. Slick, successful debt collector Julien (Lhermitte) is drawn into a risky flirtation with a beautiful woman (Farès) who habituates a café near his office. When his wife and children leave on holiday, he invites her to dinner, with unexpected consequences. This stylish film noir thriller is for ages 15 and older.

VERY ANNIE MARY (2001-UK/France) 100m *** D: Sara Sugarman. Rachel Griffiths, Jonathan Pryce, Ioan Gruffudd, Matthew Rhys, Joanna Page. Terminally awkward Annie Mary (Griffiths) was once a promising singer at age sixteen. She is now 33 and lives under the thumb of her overbearing father Jack (Pryce), who's "The Voice of the Valleys" and fancies himself a Welsh Pavarotti. This delightful comedy follows Annie Mary on her journey to independence. Winner of 3 awards, including one from Sundance. For ages 15 and older.

AGATHA RAISIN: THE WIZARD OF EVESHAM (2018-UK) 96m *** D: Roberto Bangura. Ashley Jensen, Caroline Loncq, Matthew Horne, James Lance, Asan N'Jie. Public relations whiz Agatha Raisin (Jensen) returns to the Cotswold from Cyprus nursing a broken heart. She and her single friends decide to swear off men, but when she goes to a salon to get a new look she's seriously tempted by Johnny (Lance), the charming stylist. But why do other women act so strangely around him? Agatha's sleuthing curiosity is aroused in this cozy murder mystery. For ages 12 and older.

ALL INCLUSIVE (2014-Denmark) 86m *** D: Hella Joof. Danica Curcic, Bødil Jørgensen, Maria Rossing, Diogo Infante. After discovering that her husband has been cheating on her, Lise (Jørgensen) goes on vacation to Malta with her two grown daughters, messy Ditte (Curcic) and uptight Sigrid (Rossing). When Ditte hires the resort hotel's bartender (Infante) to flirt with her mom, hilarity ensues in this charming comedy. Winner of 1 award. For ages 15 and older.

MAIXABEL (2021-Spain) 112m *** ½ D: Iciar Bollain (TAKE MY EYES). Blanca Portillo (VOLVER), Luis Tosar, Maria Cerezuela, Urko Olazabal. In this powerfully moving drama inspired by real events, the Civil Governor of the Basque region of Guipúzcoa is killed by three ETA terrorists, devastating his widow Maixabel (Portillo) and his daughter María (Cerezuela). Eleven years later, Maixabel agrees to a request to meet one of the assassins in an attempt to find understanding and peace. Winner of 17 awards. For ages 12 and older.

SINGLE-HANDED: NATURAL JUSTICE (2007-Ireland) 93m *** ½ D: Colm McCarthy. Owen McDonnell, Ian McElhinney, Liam Carney, Laura Murphy. Irish police (Garda) officer Jack Driscoll (McDonnell) returns home from Dublin to rural Connemara to replace his retiring dad Gerry (McElhinney). When he investigates the death of a young Balkan barmaid, the investigation begins to expose dirty secrets kept by prominent local men, but pressure to drop the case only increases Driscoll's resolve to crack it. For ages 15 and older.

SAMURAI VENDETTA *aka Hakuōki* (1959-Japan) 109m *** D: Kazuo Mori. Raizō Ichikawa, Shintarō Katsu, Tokiko Mita. Two of Japan's greatest *jidai-geki* stars, Raizō Ichikawa and Shintarō Katsu play legendary swordsmen whose friendship with each other is tested when they find themselves both in love with Chiharu (Mita) and in opposing clans. This thrilling tale combines the legends of Tange Sazen and Chūshingura (The 47 Ronin) and is the first *chambara* to show blood. For ages 12 and older.

LITTLE NIGHTS, LITTLE LOVE *aka Eine Kleine Nachtmusik* (2019-Japan) 120m *** D: Rikiya Imaizumi. Haruma Miura, Mikako Tabe, Yuma Yamato, Shihori Kanjiya. Lovesick Sendai businessman Sato (Miura) is told by his happily married buddy Kazuma (Yamato) that he needs to get out of his routine or risk ending up alone. Meanwhile, chronically single hairdresser Minako (Kanjiya) has been introduced by phone to a guy who seems reluctant to meet in person. In this charming romantic comedy, their romantic quandaries are answered the night of the world championship heavyweight boxing match. Nominated for 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

WALLANDER: THE WITNESS *aka Vittnet* (2011-Sweden) 92m *** ½ D: Kathrine Windfeld. Krister Henriksson, Lena Endre, Thomas Hanzon, Lisa Werlinder, Jeanett Zelba, Håkan Paaske. As prosecutor Katarina (Endre) prepares for the trial of powerful crime kingpin Filip Passilic (Paaske) accused of human trafficking, Chief Detective Kurt Wallander (Henriksson) is injured by a car bomb intended for her. Meanwhile, in a camp of illegal Lithuanian workers, 10-year-old Natalia (Zelba) goes missing in this intensely suspenseful episode. For ages 15 and older.

THE HAPPIEST DAY IN THE LIFE OF OLLI MAKI *aka Hymyilevä mies* (2016-Finland/Sweden/Germany) 93m *** ½ D: Juho Kuosmanen. Jarkko Lahti, Oona Airola, Eero Milonoff. In this true story, talented boxer Olli Mäki's (Lahti) small Finnish town is in an uproar over his 1962 World Featherweight title match to be held in Helsinki. A modest man, Olli would rather spend time alone with his sweetheart Raija (Airola) than be hailed as a national hero. This sensitive and thoughtful portrait of a boxer won 13 awards, including one from Cannes. For ages 12 and older.

SPIDER-MAN NO WAY HOME (2021-US) 148m **** D: Jon Watts. Tom Holland, Zendaya, Benedict Cumberbatch, Jon Favreau, Alfred Molina, Marisa Tomei. When high school senior Peter Parker's (Holland) secret identity as Spider-Man is exposed, he asks Dr. Strange (Cumberbatch) for help. However, when Strange's spell goes wrong, every bad guy from every universe connected to poor Peter (such as Alfred Molina's very entertaining Dr. Otto) arrives to make trouble. This explosive superhero romp is also unexpectedly heartfelt. A fine tribute to creators Steve Ditko and Stan Lee. Winner of 27 awards. PG-13.

YUCATÁN (2018-Spain) 130m *** D: Daniel Monzón. Luis Tosar, Rodrigo de la Serna, Joan Pera, Stephanie Cayo, Gloria Muñoz. This fun and sassy comedy concerns rival grifters Lucas (Tosar) and Clayderman (de la Serna) who hope to relieve lotto winner Antonio (Pera) of his €160 million prize while aboard a luxury cruise ship. But that's not the only prize Lucas is after—he's also hoping to steal back his old flame Verónica (Cayo) from Clayderman. Nominated for 2 awards. For ages 12 and older.

TOUR DE FORCE *aka Hin und weg* (2014-Germany) 92m *** ½ D: Christian Zübert. Florian David Fitz, Julia Koschitz, Jürgen Vogel, Volker Bruch, Victoria Mayer. Frankfurt resident Hannes (Fitz) knows that everyone in his group of six friends is excited about their annual bike trip. They're just wondering why Hannes and his wife Kiki (Koschitz) chose Belgium as their destination. What does Belgium have other than chocolate and fries? What they don't know is that Hannes is about to reveal a huge secret. This touching comedy-drama won 1 award. For ages 15 and older.

WEST BEIRUT (1998-France/Norway/Lebanon/Belgium) 106m *** ½ D: Ziad Doueiri (THE INSULT). Rami Doueiri, Mohamad Chamas, Rola Al Amin, Leila Karam, Carmen Lebbos, Joseph Bou Nassar. In this funny, poignant and highly personal account of Beirut's 1975 civil war, high school student Tarek (Doueiri) makes Super 8 films with his friend Omar (Chamas). At first, the conflict is fascinating and exciting. School is closed and there are spectacular fighter jet battles in the air. Despite the anxiety of his parents, Tarek and his friends make a game of traversing the divided city, until war gradually destroys all vestiges of Tarek's prewar life. Winner of 8 awards, including one from Cannes. PG-13.

STILL LIFE (2013-UK/Italy) 92m *** ½ D: Uberto Pasolini. Eddie Marsan, Joanne Froggatt, Karen Drury, Andrew Buchan, Neil D'Souza. John May (Marsan) is a London council worker whose job involves finding the next of kin to those who have died alone. A meticulous man who takes his work seriously, he feels cast adrift when his insensitive boss (Buchan) downsizes his department and tells John to wrap up his final case: Billy Stokes. Though John has the barest of clues of the deceased's life, he makes important connections not just to Stokes's story, but to his own. This meditative drama won 19 awards. For ages 12 and older.

EVERY BLESSED DAY *aka Tutti i santi giorni* (2012-Italy) 99m *** D: Paolo Virzi (LIKE CRAZY). Luca Marinelli, Thony. Gentle ecclesiastical Latin scholar Guido (Marinelli) likes his undemanding hotel clerk job because it allows him time to think. Flighty singer/songwriter Antonia (Thony) loves Guido and the peace she finds in her life with him. They want to start a family, but up against fertility challenges their relationship begins to crumble in this thoughtful love story set in Rome. Winner of 8 awards. For ages 12 and older.

FRANCESCA AND NUNZIATA (2001-Italy) 121m *** D: Lina Wertmüller (SWEPT AWAY). Sophia Loren, Giancarlo Giannini, Claudia Gerini, Raoul Bova, Moira Grassi, Domenico Orsini. At the turn of the 20th century, in Naples, wealthy and powerful Francesca Montorsi (Loren) adopts a little girl. The little girl Nunziata grows up to become a beautiful young woman (Gerini) who masters all the skills Francesca teaches her to run the family pasta company. But when Nunziata falls in love, complications ensue in this sumptuous epic tale of love and business. For ages 12 and older. *BSD, who would've turned 100 on May 23rd, would've loved this movie.*

UNCHARTED (2022-US/Spain) 116m *** D: Ruben Fleischer (GANGSTER SQUAD). Tom Holland, Mark Wahlberg, Antonio Banderas, Sophia Ali, Steven Waddington. Bartender/petty thief Nathan (Holland) is recruited by seasoned treasure hunter Sully (Wahlberg) to plunder Magellan's lost five billion dollar fortune in this thrilling adventure. Holland and Wahlberg set off sparks as frenemies battling their rival, suave and ruthless Santiago Moncada (Banderas). Winner of 1 award. PG-13.
