ENDEAVOUR: ARCADIA (2016-UK) 89m *** D: Bryn Higgins, Shaun Evans, Roger Allam, Richard Dillane, Gala Gordon, Dakota Blue Richards. The death of an artist in a house fire and the kidnapping of Verity (Gordon), the daughter of Leo Richardson, (Dillane) the owner of a supermarket chain, end up linked in this intricate mystery. New constable Shirley Trewlove (Richards) joins the Oxford City Police and causes quite a stir—but she does not suffer fools kindly. For ages 12 and older.

MISS FISHER'S MURDER MYSTERIES Episodes 29 & 30 (2015-Australia) 110m *** ½ D: Peter Andrikidis. Essie Davis, Nathan Page, Hugo Johnstone-Burt, Ashleigh Cummings. When the feisty matriarch of an Italian restaurant dies, the tensions of a generations-long blood feud explode in Episode 29. Next, private sleuth Phryne Fisher (Davis) is hired by a Melbourne street urchin to find his missing brother. Meanwhile, constable Hugh (Johnstone-Burt) struggles with his engagement with Dot (Cummings). For ages 15 and older.

WANTED aka *Crime Spree* (2003-UK/Canada) 95m *** D: Brad Mirman. Gérard Depardieu, Harvey Keitel, Johnny Hallyday, Renaud, Saïd Taghmaoui, Abe Vigoda. A bumbling team of French thieves end up accidentally robbing Chicago mob boss Frankie Zammeti's (Keitel) house in this fun-filled caper. The Gallic team has some tough guy standouts: no one would want to mess with Marcel (Hallyday) or Zero (Renaud), who's so cool he speaks of himself in the third person. But they have their hands full—it's not just the Mafia after them, it's the FBI and a bloodthirsty Latin gang too! Stay till the end—the fun continues with the end credits. Rated R.

THE SHOGUN'S VAULT aka *Gokinzo yaburi* (1964-Japan) 93m *** D: Teruo Ishii (BLACK LINE). Hashizô Ôkawa, Chiezô Kataoka, Tetsurô Tanba, Yukiji Asaka. Young yakuza 'Red Peony' Hanji (Ôkawa) lands in jail, sharing a crowded cell with notorious thief 'Smoke' Tomizô (Kataoka), who manages to keep the scrappy youngster out of trouble. When out of prison, Tomizô masterminds a plan to rob, of all crazy things, the Shogun's vault in Edo Castle, and invites Hanji to partner with him. It won't be easy with Edo's most zealous cop (Tanba) on their tail! For ages 15 and older.

SHAMBHALA (2024-Nepal/France/Norway/Hong Kong/Turkey/Taiwan/US/Qatar) 144m *** ½ D: Min Bahadur Bham. Thinley Lhamo, Sonam Topden, Tenzing Dalha, Karma Wangyal Gurung. Strong, capable Pema (Lhamo) marries into a family of three brothers in a Nepalese village where polyandry is the custom. Oldest brother Tashi (Dalha), a trader, leaves on a trip to Lhasa, middle brother Karma (Topden) leaves for the monastery. Left to care for youngest brother, ill-behaved 11-year-old Dawa (Gurung), Pema's reputation comes under fire when she hires a tutor for him. Pregnant Pema goes on an odyssey to clear her name in this stunningly beautiful winner of 3 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE BRIDGE Episodes 3 & 4 aka *Bron/Broen* (2011-Denmark/Sweden) 114m **** D: Charlotte Sieling. Sofia Helin, Kim Bodnia, Morten Suurballe, Fanny Ketter. To draw attention to the number of homeless people falling through the cracks of society, the killer, now known as T.T. (Truth Terrorist), kidnaps homeless man Bjørn (Suurballe) and demands a ransom from four wealthy landlords for his survival. Meanwhile, vulnerable runaway teen Anja (Ketter) hides at the home of a troubled man. For ages 16 and older.

IS THIS THING ON? (2025-US) 121m *** D: Bradley Cooper (A STAR IS BORN). Will Arnett, Laura Dern, Andra Day, Bradley Cooper, Ciarán Hinds, Peyton Manning. Bewildered by his divorce to his partner of 20 years, Tess (Dern), Alex (Arnett) finds himself at an open mic night at a comedy club in New York City. In front of a friendly crowd, Alex finally gives a humorous account of the hurt he's never been able to express in this engaging comedy-drama. Winner of 1 award. Rated R.

TOKIJIRO, LONE YAKUZA aka *Kutsukake Tokijirô: Yûkyô ippiki* (1966-Japan) 90m *** ½ D: Tai Katô (BLOOD OF REVENGE). Kinnosuke Nakamura, Junko Ikeuchi, Kiyoshi Atsumi. Obligated under the strict code of the underworld, yakuza Tokijiro (Nakamura) is forced to kill Sanzo, an honorable man. Sanzo, with his last dying breath, begs Tokijiro to take his wife Okinu (Ikeuchi) and son Taro to safety in a faraway province. Eager to atone for this crime, Tokijiro looks after the widow and her child, but as time passes his feelings for her grow in this 19th century tragic romance. For ages 12 and older.

THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: THE END OF THE LINE (2025-New Zealand) 93m *** ½ D: Awanui Simich-Pene. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Karl Willetts, Lauren Porteous. While assisting at a high school leadership camp in the woods, unpopular science teacher Hannah (Porteous) is found dead hanging from a zip line. Detectives Mike (Rea) and Kristin (Sutherland) find themselves navigating a tangled web of thwarted love and family secrets to solve the case. For ages 14 and older.

RADICAL (2023-US/Mexico) 121m *** ½ D: Christopher Zalla. Eugenio Derbez, Daniel Haddad, Jennifer Trejo, Danilo Guardiola. Based on a true story, this movie concerns schoolteacher Sergio (Derbez) who arrives at a derelict school in Matamoros, Mexico, known as a "place of punishment", without a clue as to how he will educate the desperately impoverished students. With no money or resources, Sergio develops a radical plan to ignite his students' innate genius in this crowd pleaser. Winner of 18 awards. Rated PG-13.

I'M STARTING FROM THREE aka *Ricomincio da tre* (1981-Italy) 106m *** ½ D: Massimo Troisi. Massimo Troisi (IL POSTINO), Lello Arena, Fiorenza Marchegiani, Lino Troisi. Young provincial Neapolitan Gaetano (Massimo Troisi) decides he wants to go to Florence and start again from three (not from zero because that means he's failed at *everything*). For a naïve yet highly original thinker, Gaetano faces his greatest challenge when he goes north: falling in love with a modern Florentine woman (Marchegiani). This hilarious and endearing comedy won 10 awards, including 2 David di Donatellos. For ages 12 and older.

CHACHA: THE PRINCESS OF HEAVEN aka *Chacha tengai no onna* (2007-Japan) 129m *** D: Hajime Hashimoto. Yôka Wao, Shinobu Terajima, Kôen Kondô, Shidô Nakamura, Hiroki Matsukata. This historical drama depicts the turbulent life of Lady Yodo (Wao), known as Chacha in her youth. The niece of Oda Nobunaga (Matsukata), Chacha is orphaned at a young age when her parents are killed for their political allegiances. Determined to avenge her parents, she becomes embroiled in Toyotomi Hideyoshi's (Kondô) power struggle with Tokugawa Ieyasu (Nakamura) to rule Japan. This Sengoku Era tale is a lavish visual treat. For ages 12 and older.

LUNANA: AYAK IN THE CLASSROOM (2019-Bhutan/China) 110m *** ½ D: Pawo Choyning Dorji. Sherab Dorji, Ugyen Norbu Lhendup, Kelden Lhamo Gurung, Pem Zam. Young teacher Ugyen (Sherab Dorji) is assigned to the most remote school in Bhutan, in a Himalayan village called Lunana. Ugyen, who was planning to go to Australia to be a singer, finds himself cut off from all of his usual Western comforts after an arduous 8-day trek there. Ugyen uses his musical talent and creativity to teach (and learn from) his adorable new students in this heartwarming and thought-provoking Oscar-nominated film. Winner of 20 awards. For ages 10 and older.

EVERSMILE NEW JERSEY (1989-Argentina/UK) 87m *** D: Carlos Sorin (INTIMATE STORIES). Daniel Day-Lewis, Mirjana Joković, Gabriela Acher. Virtuoso actor Daniel Day-Lewis lends his laser-focused skills to portray a singular character: Irish dentist Fergus O'Connell, who roams Patagonia, Argentina on motorcycle evangelizing on oral hygiene and delivering free dental care. On his mad crusade, Fergus gains a dental assistant in the form of runaway bride Estela (Joković) in this ironically humorous character study. Winner of 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

BROKEN TRAIL (2006-US/Canada) Part 1: 93m, Part 2: 91m *** ½ D: Walter Hill (Deadwood). Robert Duvall, Thomas Haden Church, Gwendoline Yeo, Greta Scacchi. Old cowhand Prentice "Prent" Ritter (Duvall) asks his estranged nephew Tom Harte (Church) to help him deliver a herd of mustangs from Oregon to Wyoming in this Western set in 1898. The two, while busy with the fractious herd, encounter five young Chinese girls about to be sold into sexual slavery. Thinking nothing of the hardships ahead, the cowboys save the girls' lives and take them on their journey in this atmospheric Western. For ages 14 and older.

WHO WILL SING TO YOU? aka *Quién te cantará* (2018-Spain/France) 119m *** D: Carlos Vermut. Najwa Nimri, Eva Llorach, Carme Elias, Natalia de Molina. Superstar singer Lila Cassen (Nimri) is found unconscious on the beach by her agent and long-time friend Blanca (Elias), who manages to save her life. But Lila suffers from amnesia—and has forgotten her songs. To save Lila and her career, Blanca hatches a mad plan: she employs karaoke bar hostess and Lila Cassen superfan Violeta (Llorach) to coach Lila back to being a star in this unique drama. Winner of 15 awards. For ages 15 and older.

FIREFLIES IN THE NORTH aka *Kita no hotaru* (1984-Japan) 123m *** D: Hideo Gosha (HITO-KIRI). Tatsuya Nakadai, Shima Iwashita, Tetsurô Tanba, Isao Natsuyagi. In 1880s Japan, the new Meiji government's attempts at developing the icy, remote island of Hokkaido have failed. Prime minister Itô approves the use of prison labor to build Hokkaido's infrastructure, leading to the construction of Kabato Prison. This tale of lust, power and greed concerns Kabato Prison warden Tsukigata (Nakadai) and his brutal reign. Winner of a Japanese Academy Award for Art Direction. For adults only.

THE CHORAL (2025-UK/US) 113m *** D: Nicholas Hytner (THE MADNESS OF KING GEORGE). Ralph Fiennes, Roger Allam, Mark Addy, Amara Okereke, Simon Russell Beale. In the little town of Ramsden in 1916 Yorkshire, the choral society is in a crisis due to the war: they need new members as even their choirmaster has enlisted. When the new choirmaster Dr. Henry Guthrie (Fiennes) arrives, the town buzzes with rumors. He lived in Germany for many years (by choice!) and is suspiciously close with a German naval officer. Will he, can he rescue Ramsden's choir? Nominated for 1 award. Rated R.

SONG SUNG BLUE (2025-US) 132m *** ½ D: Craig Brewer (HUSTLE & FLOW). Hugh Jackman, Kate Hudson, Ella Anderson, Michael Imperioli, Jim Belushi. In this true story, two middle-aged divorced parents Mike (Jackman) and Claire (Hudson), yearning for life in the spotlight, form a successful Neil Diamond cover band in Milwaukee. Their surprising journey features jaw-dropping ups and downs and a huge amount of heart. Winner of 5 awards and an Oscar nomination for Kate Hudson's heartfelt performance. Rated PG-13.

I WAS A STRANGER (2024-Jordan/Occupied Palestinian Territory/US) 104m *** ½ D: Brandt Andersen. Yasmine Al Massri, Yahya Mahayni, Omar Sy, Ziad Bakri, Constantine Markoulakis. US immigrant Amira Homsî (Al Massri) recalls the time in 2015 when she is forced to leave her home in Aleppo, Syria for an uncertain future. This gripping account of the enormous risks displaced people face follows the shared story of Dr. Homsî, a Syrian soldier (Mahayni), a smuggler (Sy), a fellow refugee (Bakri) and a Greek coast guard captain (Markoulakis). Winner of 43 awards. Rated PG-13.
