**DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: THE SPIDER'S PATIENCE** *aka La pazienza del ragno* (2006-Italy) 106m \*\*\* ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Peppino Mazzotta, Angelo Russo, Cesare Bocci, Clelia Rondinella. A young woman disappears, leaving no trace except an abandoned moped. Among the puzzles Montalbano (Zingaretti) must solve is what on earth the kidnapper(s) hope to gain. The girl's father, Mr. Mistretta, is broke, and her mother is gravely ill. Soon, all of Vigàta is in an uproar when the culprit(s) leak the ransom demand to the press. For ages 14 and older.

**FOYLE'S WAR: THE GERMAN WOMAN** (2002-UK) 99m \*\*\*\* D: Jeremy Silberston. Michael Kitchen, Edward Fox, Robert Hardy, Joanna Kanska, Rosamund Pike, James McAvooy, Julian Ovenden. Early May, 1940: DCS Christopher Foyle (Kitchen) has been repeatedly denied the opportunity to serve in the war effort by his boss, Police Commissioner Summers (Fox). Foyle instead battles crime on the home front in this masterful detective series. In Foyle's Sussex community, the German wife (Kanska) of wealthy aristocrat Henry Beaumont (Hardy) has been exempted from wartime internment, though her brother is a member of the Nazi party. When she is found dead, Foyle not only investigates her murder but the underlying injustice in this first episode. For ages 15 and older.

**CHROMOPHOBIA** (2005-UK/France/US) 134m \*\*\* D: Martha Fiennes. Damian Lewis, Penélope Cruz, Ralph Fiennes, Ben Chaplin, Ian Holm, Rhys Ifans, Kristin Scott Thomas. In this ensemble drama set in London, attorney Marcus (Lewis) is excited about becoming a partner at his law firm, though he can't help but feel he's being fattened for a kill by his scheming boss. Meanwhile, his bank account is being rapidly drained by his arty wife Iona (Thomas), and his old friend, journalist Trent (Chaplin) knows maybe too much about his secrets. To top things off, Marcus's father Edward (Holm), a retired judge, has a scandal of his own in this stylish yarn. For ages 15 and older.

**COUSINS** (2021-New Zealand) 95m \*\*\* ½ D: Ainsley Gardiner, Briar Grace Smith. Rachel House, Tanea Heke, Briar Grace Smith, Cian Elyse White, Mihi Te Rauhi Daniels, Keyahne Patrick Williams, Te Raukura Gray. In this powerful story that spans the 1950s to the 1980s, orphan Mata (Gray and Heke), is forcibly sent to a school that seeks to wipe away every trace of her Maori heritage. Mata's aunt Gloria (White) and cousins Makareta (Daniels and Smith) and Missy (Williams and House) make a lifetime goal of returning Mata to her whanau. As the years pass and the family struggles to hold on to their land, finding Mata seems like a distant possibility until a chance encounter changes everything. Nominated for 3 awards. For ages 12 and older.

**LE GRAND JEU** (1934-France) 110m \*\*\* ½ D: Jacques Feyder (CARNIVAL IN FLANDERS). Marie Bell, Pierre Richard-Willm, Charles Vanel, Françoise Rosay. Young lawyer Pierre's (Richard-Willm) obsession with his spendthrift girlfriend Florence (Bell) plunges his father's company into debt. Forced to leave his country, Pierre joins the Foreign Legion in Morocco, where he stays at a sleazy bar-brothel run by couple Clément (Vanel) and Blanche (Rosay). Still heartbroken from being separated from his lover, Pierre is astonished to meet prostitute Irma (Bell), who looks just like Florence in this beautifully filmed and acted early Film Noir. A rarely seen gem. For ages 12 and older.

**MY SAILOR, MY LOVE** (2022-Ireland/Belgium/Finland) 103m \*\*\* ½ D: Klaus Härö (LETTERS TO FATHER JACOB). James Cosmo (*Shetland*), Brid Brennan, Catherine Walker, Nora-Jane Noone, Aidan O'Hare. Cranky retired sea captain Howard (Cosmo) has a strained relationship with his daughter Grace (Walker): she wants to help him and he refuses. But when Grace hires Annie (Brennan) as a housekeeper to take care of Howard's seaside cottage, Howard and Annie fall in love to Grace's dismay in this nuanced and thoughtful family drama. Winner of 4 awards. For ages 12 and older.

**THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: SHOT OF LOVE** (2023-New Zealand) 98m \*\*\* ½ D: Jacqueline Nairn. Neill Rea, Jess Loudon, Fern Sutherland, Jarod Rawiri, Rebecca Gibney. Wanting to get married and fed up with his ex-wife Tabatha's (Gibney) delay tactics, detective Mike Shepherd (Rea) and his girlfriend Beth (Loudon) take an 8-hour drive on the weekend to get her to sign divorce papers. Meanwhile, detectives Kristin (Sutherland) and Daniel (Rawiri) try to solve a bizarre murder of a man found dead in a hotel room. Security camera footage shows no visitors to the room. For ages 14 and older.

**MAN AND A BABY** *aka Yösyöttö* (2017-Finland) 86m \*\*\* D: Marja Pyykkö. Petteri Summanen, Marja Salo, Ria Kataja, Juha Muje, Santeri Helinheimo Mäntylä, Marjaana Maijala. Middle-aged journalist Antti thinks he's done alright. He has a steady job, a home, and now his wife Pia (Kataja) has borne him a child. But as he exits the maternity hospital, he can't believe his eyes as Pia hops in a cab and leaves Antti with the newborn baby. Though stunned that he's been abandoned, Antti becomes a good dad with the help of his family and friends in this charming comedy. Winner of 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

**LONE WOLF AND CUB: SWORD OF VENGEANCE** *aka Kozure Okami: Ko wo kashi ude kashi tsukamatsuru* (1972-Japan) 84m \*\*\* ½ D: Kenji Misumi (THE TALE OF ZATOICHI). Tomisaburō Wakayama, Fumio Watanabe, Gō Katō, Akihiro Tomikawa. This first film of Kenji Misumi's LONE WOLF AND CUB film series tells the origin story of Ogami Itto (Wakayama), a ronin who wanders the Japanese countryside with his son Daigorō (Tomikawa) in a baby carriage. Despite having to care for a baby boy, Ogami is a master swordsman out for revenge against the Yagyū clan in this samurai/exploitation masterpiece. For ages 15 and older.

**ANATOMY OF A FALL** *aka Anatomie d'une chute* (2023-France) 151m \*\*\*\* D: Justine Triet. Sandra Hüller, Swann Arlaud, Milo Machado-Graner, Samuel Theis. German writer Sandra (Hüller), her husband Samuel (Theis) and their partially sighted son Daniel (Machado-Graner) live in an isolated chalet in France. When Samuel is found dead at the base of the chalet, Sandra is accused and put on trial for his death in this riveting, suspenseful courtroom/family drama. Winner of 109 awards, including the Best Original Screenplay Oscar and the Palme D'Or (both Justine Triet) and also at Cannes, the Palm Dog for Messi, who plays Snoop. Rated R.

**DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: FIND THE LADY** *aka Il gioco delle tre carte* (2006-Italy) 99m \*\*\* ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Simona Cavallari, Gilberto Idonea, Barbara Tabita, Stefano Dionisi. One rainy morning, Montalbano (Zingaretti) witnesses an odd sight: a funeral with a procession of just one. Montalbano talks to the sole mourner (Idonea) and learns the deceased, elderly builder Cascio, perished under highly suspicious circumstances. Just a week before Cascio's death, his former employer Pennisi (Dionisi), who had been convicted of a crime of passion, was released from prison. Is there a link? For ages 14 and older.

**LONE WOLF AND CUB: BABY CART AT THE RIVER STYX** *aka Kozure Okami: Sanzu no kawa no ubaguruma* (1972-Japan) 82m \*\*\* D: Kenji Misumi. Tomisaburō Wakayama, Kayo Matsuo, Minoru Ōki, Shin Kishida, Shōgen Nitta. In this second film of the series, Ogami is becoming well-known as a sword for hire, but being constantly attacked by the Yagyū clan is taking its toll. A skillful band of female ninja led by the majestic Sayaka (Matsuo) lays Ogami low. Thankfully, three-year-old Daigorō (Tomikawa) finds a way to help his dad in this samurai action classic. For ages 15 and older.

**FOYLE'S WAR: THE WHITE FEATHER** (2002-UK) 97m \*\*\*\* D: Jeremy Silberston. Michael Kitchen, Anthony Howell, Charles Dance, Maggie Steed, Honeysuckle Weeks, Lisa Ellis. Late May, 1940: The Germans continue to roll across western Europe, and with Dunkirk's evacuation, fears are raised that England will soon be invaded. When Edith (Ellis), the young maid at the White Feather hotel is caught cutting telephone wires, Superintendent Foyle comes across a group of English Nazi sympathizers led by a charismatic fascist named Guy Spencer (Dance) in this darkly fascinating episode. For ages 15 and older.

**THE KILLING** *aka Forbrydelsen* Episodes 1 & 2 (2007-Denmark) 110m \*\*\*\* D: Birger Larsen. Sofie Gråbøl, Bjarne Henriksen, Lars Mikkelsen, Søren Malling. Copenhagen police detective Lund (Gråbøl) is looking forward to moving to Sweden with her boyfriend. She is packing up her office when her replacement, detective Meyer (Malling), asks her to join him in investigating a missing teenage girl. The girl, Nanna, an excellent student and the child of a loving family, is found brutally murdered in a car rented by the campaign of mayoral candidate Troels Hartmann (Mikkelsen). A pinnacle of Nordic noir, this brilliant series, both a crime and political thriller, won 12 awards. For adults 15 and older.

**THE KILLING** *aka Forbrydelsen* Episodes 3 & 4 (2007-Denmark) 116m \*\*\*\* D: Birger Larsen, Henrik Ruben Genz. Sofie Gråbøl, Bjarne Henriksen, Lars Mikkelsen, Ann Eleonora Jørgensen, Søren Malling. Politician Hartmann (Mikkelsen) finds himself in a media firestorm when the story of Nanna's murder and its possible connection to his campaign hits the news. He wants to clear his name with a press release but detective Lund (Gråbøl) begs him to hold off. After Lund and Meyer make a gruesome discovery at Nanna's school, the investigation focuses on Nanna's classmates. Meanwhile, Nanna's parents Theis (Henriksen) and Pernille (Jørgensen) try to overcome their shock and grief while planning the funeral. For adults 15 and older.

**ANYONE BUT YOU** (2023-US/Australia) 103m \*\*\* D: Will Gluck (EASY A). Sydney Sweeney, Glen Powell, Gata, Dermot Mulroney, Rachel Griffiths, Alexandra Shipp, Hadley Robinson. Sparks fly when finance bro Ben (Powell) meets law student Bea (Sweeney). After an evening of deep conversation and homemade grilled cheese, the lovestruck couple end up hurt and angry over a misunderstanding. Some time later they both end up invited to a destination wedding in Australia. Will they find their way together again? This gorgeous, playfully raunchy (but not sexually explicit) romantic comedy won 1 award. Rated R.
