SAKURA *aka Kuchinai sakura* (2024-Japan) 120m *** D: Hiroto Hara. Hana Sugisaki, Riku Hagiwara, Kokoro Morita, Kôsukey Toyohara, Ken Yasuda. One drunken evening, Izumi (Sugisaki), a low-level clerical worker for the Aichi police PR department, accidentally lets slip some insider info to her best friend Chika (Morita), a journalist. When a scoop in the local newspaper unleashes a PR firestorm at the police station, Izumi suspects Chika of publishing the leak. But when Chika turns up dead a few days later, Izumi resolves to find her killer, whatever the cost, in this superior thriller. For ages 15 and older.

WELCOME TO THE SOUTH *aka Benvenuti al sud* (2010-Italy/Germany) 102m *** D: Luca Miniero. Claudio Bisio, Alessandro Siani, Valentina Lodovini, Angela Finocchiaro. This Italian remake of the French **WELCOME TO THE STICKS** has postal supervisor Alberto (Bisio), a northerner, banished to work in Naples by his boss. Alberto and his family are up in arms (The poverty! The crime! The trash!) but go he must. Once he's there, he finds it's not bad—but worried for her man, Alberto's wife Silvia (Finocchiaro) decides to come too! Winner of 7 awards. For ages 12 and older.

IN BLOOM *aka Grzeli nateli dgeebi* (2013-Georgia/Germany/France) 98m *** ½ D: Nana Ekvitishvili, Simon Groß. Lika Babluani, Mariam Bokeria. This unusual coming-of-age tale is set in 1992 Tbilisi. As civil war rages in their newly independent country, best friends Eka (Babluani) and Natia (Bokeria), both fourteen years old, are facing the end of their childhood. Natia's father is an abusive drunk, and Eka's is in prison for murder. Pestered by switchblade-wielding boys on the street, the girls explore their own power when one acquires a gun. Winner of 29 awards. For ages 15 and older.

THE YOUNG MONTALBANO: MORTALLY WOUNDED *aka Ferito a morte* (2012-Italy) 110m *** ½ D: Gianluca Maria Tavarrelli. Michele Riondino, Alessio Vassallo, Andrea Tidona, Tea Falco, Marilyn Gallo. All around the town of Vigàta there are posters promising a referendum on whether the wife of a local politician is a w____. Everyone Montalbano (Riondino) talks to seems to think yes—much to the distress of the politician! Meanwhile, a widowed loan shark is found shot dead in his bed. The closer Montalbano gets to solving the case, the more puzzled he becomes in this episode. For ages 14 and older.

ONCE (2006-Ireland) 85m *** ½ D: John Carney. Glen Hansard, Markéta Irglová, Alastair Foley. This modern-day musical concerns a busker (Hansard) and a Czech immigrant (Irglová) who meet by chance on a street in Dublin. They compose, rehearse and record songs that tell their love story in this naturalistic, whimsical and utterly disarming romance. Winner of 25 awards, including an Oscar for the song “Falling Slowly”. Rated R.

CEFALONIA (2005-Italy) 136m *** D: Riccardo Milani. Luca Zingaretti (DETECTIVE MONTALBANO), Luisa Ranieri, Jasmine Trinca. It is September 8, 1944 on the Greek island of Cefalonia. The troops of the Aquia division rejoice: an armistice is declared between the Italy and the Allies. Longing to return home, the Italians are horrified when the Nazis declare the armistice to be a hostile act and attack the Italians to try to force them to surrender. Despite the many men imprisoned and executed, the Italians heroically fight the Germans in this stirring true story. Winner of 3 awards. For ages 12 and older.

MISS FISHER'S MURDER MYSTERIES Episodes 13 & 14 (2013-Australia) 110m *** ½ D: Daina Reid, Tony Tilse. Essie Davis, Nathan Page, Ashleigh Cummings, Nicholas Bell, Neil Melville. In Episode 13, Phryne Fisher (Davis) is finally close to revealing Murdoch Foyle's (Bell) horrific objective—but at the steep cost of putting her loved ones in danger. In Episode 14, Phryne goes undercover as an exotic dancer to solve a crime involving detective Jack Robinson's (Page) ex-father-in-law. For ages 15 and older.

FOYLE'S WAR: THE ETERNITY RING (2013-UK/Ireland/US) 87m **** D: Stuart Orme. Michael Kitchen, Ellie Haddington, Nicholas Jones, Honeysuckle Weeks, Daniel Weyman. 1946: Christopher Foyle (Kitchen) is brought in by Hilda Pierce (Haddington) to talk to MI5 chief Sir William Chambers (Jones) about flushing out a group of Soviet sympathizers called the Eternity Ring who seek to leak atomic secrets to the USSR. One of the suspects: a certain Sam Wainwright, née Stewart (Weeks). For ages 14 and older.

ENDEAVOUR: Pilot Episode (2012-UK) 102m **** D: Colm McCarthy. Shaun Evans, Roger Allam, Danny Webb, Charlie Creed-Miles. In the pilot episode of this prequel mystery series set in 1960s Oxford, young classical music-loving constable Endeavour Morse (Evans) is taken under the wing of Detective Inspector Thursday (Allam) to investigate the disappearance of student Mary Tremlett. When Morse uncovers an important clue by cracking a code, he gets in trouble with his higher-ups. Based on Colin Dexter's beloved character Inspector Morse. For ages 12 and older.

BRIDGET JONES: MAD ABOUT THE BOY (2025-UK/France/US) 125m *** D: Michael Morris. Renée Zellweger, Hugh Grant, Colin Firth, Chiwetel Ejiofor, Leo Woodall, Emma Thompson. Scatterbrained single mom Bridget Jones (Zellweger) jumps back into the dating pool with the help of her friends in this sweet romantic comedy, the fourth in the series. Trying her luck with dating apps, she finds herself in a steamy flirtation with a much younger man (Woodall) while navigating some awkward moments with her son's science teacher (Ejiofor). Nominated for 8 awards. Rated R.

EL SUR *aka The South* (1983-Spain/France) 95m *** ½ D: Víctor Erice (THE SPIRIT OF THE BEEHIVE). Omero Antonutti, Sonsoles Aranguren, Icíar Bollaín (TAKE MY EYES), Rafaela Aparicio. In this painterly drama set in the aftermath of the Spanish Civil War, eight-year-old Estrella (Aranguren) lives in a northern Spanish town. She was told that her family fled the south after her father Agustín (Antonutti) had a terrible fight with Estrella's grandfather many years ago. To Estrella, her father (who locks himself in the attic each night) is as mysterious as the south, a land of enchantment. As a teenager, Estrella (Bollaín) learns the truth in this winner of 7 awards. Rated PG.

THE PENGUIN LESSONS (2024-Spain/US/UK) 111m *** D: Peter Cattaneo (THE FULL MONTY). Steve Coogan, Jonathan Pryce, Vivian El Jaber, Björn Gustafsson, Alfonsina Carrocio, David Herrero. Disillusioned English teacher Tom Michell (Coogan), after working his way through South America, lands a job at a fancy private school in a politically divided Argentina in 1976. Soon upon arrival there's a military coup, which Tom escapes by taking a week-long vacation in Uruguay. While there, Tom rescues a penguin from an oil slick, changing his life forever. This feel-good charmer is adapted from the real Tom Michell's memoir. For ages 12 and older.
