THE WHISTLERS *aka La Gomera* (2019-Romania/France/Germany/Switzerland/Sweden) 97m *** D: Corneliu Porumboiu. Vlad Ivanov (SNOWPIERCER), Catrinel Marlon, Rodica Lazar. Romanian police officer Cristi (Ivanov) plays both sides of the law. He's assigned by the mob, along with femme fatale Gilda (Marlon), to retrieve a hidden stash of 30 million stolen Euros. To accomplish this mission, Cristi goes to La Gomera in the Canary Islands to learn a whistling language to communicate undetected with the mafia. This preposterous, creative and very funny thriller won 11 awards. For ages 15 and older.

ENDEAVOUR: GAME (2017-UK) 92m *** D: Ashley Pearce. Shaun Evans, Roger Allam, Sara Vickers, James Laurensen. While Endeavour Morse (Evans) awaits the results of his sergeant's exam, a body found in the river turns out to be the colleague of Prof. Amory (Laurensen), whose computer 'Jason' is challenging a Russian chess champion at Oxford. It appears the drowned man was a suicide, but as other drownings are discovered, Morse begins to suspect these incidents are connected. Meanwhile, both Morse and DI Thursday (Allam) grieve Joan's (Vickers) abrupt departure in this episode. For ages 14 and older.

500 DAYS OF SUMMER (2009-US) 95m *** ½ D: Marc Webb (GIFTED). Joseph Gordon-Levitt (INCEPTION), Zoëy Deschanel, Geoffrey Arend, Chloë Grace Moretz. Earnest greeting-card writer Tom (Gordon-Levitt) has been in love with Summer (Deschanel) almost since the moment he met her. But administrative assistant Summer doesn't believe in having boyfriends or getting married, even though she seems to genuinely care for Tom. Tom swears Summer is the one. Will his love prevail? This offbeat romantic comedy won 17 awards. Rated PG-13.

BORGEN Episode 1 (2011-Denmark) 61m **** D: Søren Kragh-Jacobsen. Sidse Babett Knudsen, Peter Mygind, Pilou Asbæk. Three days before an election, middle class mom Birgitte Nyborg (Knudsen), leader of the Moderate Party, denounces her closest ally, Labor leader Laugesen (Mygind), over his stance on immigration. Birgitte's spin doctor Kasper (Asbæk) is appalled and fears her candidacy is lost. Meanwhile, the Prime Minister's wife goes on a shopping spree, with government money. For ages 15 and older.

BORGEN Episodes 2 & 3 (2010-Denmark) 116m **** D: Søren Kragh-Jacobsen. Sidse Babett Knudsen, Birgitte Hjort Sørensen, Pilou Asbæk, Mikael Birkkjær, Lars Knutzon. After the election, Birgitte (Knudsen) is thrilled to be Denmark's first female prime minister. But her problems have now begun: she must build a coalition government, and her former allies are out for revenge. With sage advice from campaign manager Bent (Knutzon), Birgitte gets a tough lesson in realpolitik. Now the next challenge: passing the budget. For ages 15 and older.

PRESSURE (2026-UK/France/US) 100m *** ½ D: Anthony Maras (HOTEL MUMBAI). Andrew Scott, Brendan Fraser, Damian Lewis. It's 72 hours before D-Day and the largest seaborne invading force in history is poised to hit Normandy. There's just one piece of the puzzle that's not certain: the weather. An almighty storm is due, and Britain's chief meteorological officer James Stagg (Scott) has to advise Dwight D. Eisenhower (Fraser) on when to invade: a storm would devastate the invading force, a delay would alert German intelligence to their plan. This compelling thriller won 1 award so far. Rated PG-13.

THE PIANO (1993-New Zealand/Australia/France) 121m **** D: Jane Campion (BRIGHT STAR). Holly Hunter, Harvey Keitel, Sam Neill (9/14/1947 – 7/13/2026), Anna Paquin. In this mysterious love story set in the mid-19th century, Ada McGrath (Hunter) travels with her daughter Flora (Paquin) to New Zealand to an arranged marriage with Stewart (Neill), a local landowner. Ada, who chooses not to speak, brings her piano, which is her voice and identity. To her horror, Stewart sells her piano to neighbor Baines (Keitel), setting in motion surprising consequences. Winner of 65 awards, including 3 Oscars. Rated R.

GAMBLER'S FAREWELL *aka Bakuto kaisan-shiki* (1968-Japan) 90m *** D: Kijiri Fukasaku (JAKOMAN & TETSU). Kôji Tsuruta, Seizaburô Kawazu, Masayo Banri, Eiji Okada, Tetsurô Tanba, Akikane Sawa. It is 1966, and Shinjima City has an ambitious new police chief, Riichi Maeda (Okada). Under pressure, yakuza kingpin Iwasaki (Kawazu) puts Toru Kuroki (Tsuruta) in charge of the crime family's legitimate transport business, hoping the young hotheads in his employ will go straight. But Kuroki has just come out of prison, and relentless Maeda will use any excuse to disband the Iwasaki family in this thriller. For ages 12 and older.

DETECTIVE HANSHICHI *aka Shin Hanshichi torimono chô* (1997-Japan) 89m *** ½ D: Yoshito Fukumoto, Masami Kadawaki. Hiroyuki Sanada, Riho Makise, Takehiko Ono, Mitsunori Isaki, Yôko Moriguchi. Martial arts star Hiroyuki Sanada stars as "Okappiki" (detective) Hanshichi in this highly entertaining pair of stories adapted from Kido Okamoto's novels. In "The Gold Candles", beautiful Omitsu (Moriguchi) hides a terrible secret. "Upstairs of the Bathhouse" is a comical tale involving an eloping couple. For ages 10 and older.

IN THE GREY (2026-UK/US) 98m *** D: Guy Ritchie (SNATCH). Henry Cavill, Jake Gyllenhaal, Eiza González, Carlos Bardem, Rosamund Pike. Commandos for hire Sid (Cavill) and Bronco (Gyllenhaal) are given an impossible task: claw back 1 billion dollars from ruthless despot Manny Salazar (Carlos Bardem, Javier's older brother). This tasty tale of car and motorcycle chases, stylish combat in even more stylish clothes, and Guy Ritchie's signature breezy dialogue is just what you need this summer. Rated R.

A LONG GOODBYE *aka Nagai owakare* (2019-Japan) 128m *** D: Ryôta Nakano (HER LOVE BOILS BATH-WATER). Tsutomu Yamazaki, Yû Aoi, Chieko Matsubara, Yûko Takeuchi. Shohei (Yamazaki) was a middle school principal, a voracious reader, and a stern but loving father. His wife Yoko (Matsubara) calls home their two adult daughters Mari (Takeuchi) and Fumi (Aoi) to tell them in person what she can't announce over the phone: their dad has Alzheimer's. Reunited with their parents, the daughters regain something precious: memories of their family. Nominated for 2 awards. For ages 10 and older.

THE CHRISTOPHERS (2025-UK/US) 100m *** D: Steven Soderbergh (TRAFFIC). Michaela Coel, Ian McKellen, Jessica Gunning, James Corden. Julian Sklar (McKellen) used to be a giant in the London art scene in the 1960s, but now he never touches a paintbrush. His estranged children, Sallie (Gunning) and Barnaby (Corden) hire art restorer Lori (Coel) to complete a series of unfinished canvases that Julian had abandoned years ago—so they could sell them and have an inheritance when he dies. This witty and literate movie won 1 award. Rated R.

THE BRIDGE Episodes 9 & 10 *aka Bron/Broen* (2011-Denmark/Sweden) 117m **** D: Henrik Georgsson. Sofia Helin, Kim Bodnia, Dag Malmberg, Puk Scharbau, Lars Simonsen. When the identity of the 'Truth Terrorist' is revealed, Danish detective Martin's (Bodnia) personal risk in the case reaches a crisis level. Despite his differences with his Swedish counterpart Saga (Helin), Martin needs her skills to help catch the master criminal in this spectacular season finale. For ages 16 and older.

IT WAS JUST AN ACCIDENT *aka Yek tasadof-e sadeh* (2025-Iran/France/Luxembourg) 104m ***½ D: Jafar Panahi (OFFSIDE). Vahid Mobasseri, Mariam Afshari, Ebrahim Azizi, Hadis Pakbaten. Unassuming car mechanic Vahid (Mobasseri) encounters a man (Azizi) who he believes is Egbal, one of the torturers from his time in an Iranian prison. Thirsty for revenge, Vahid kidnaps the man, then is plagued with guilt. What if he isn't Egbal? Vahid rounds up a group of ex-prisoners to confirm the man's identity in this funny and thought-provoking tragicomedy. Winner of 41 awards. Rated PG-13.

RIDERS OF JUSTICE *aka Retfærdighedens ryttere* (2020-Denmark/Sweden/Finland) 116m *** ½ D: Anders Thomas Jensen (FLICKERING LIGHTS). Mads Mikkelsen, Nikolaj Lie Kaas, Andrea Heick Gadeberg, Lars Brygmann, Nicolas Bro. Career soldier Markus (Mikkelsen) rushes home when his wife is killed in a subway accident to care for his teenage daughter Mathilde (Gadeberg). While Markus and Mathilde are grieving, they are visited by statistician Otto (Kaas) who offers proof that the crash was no accident. Fired up for revenge, Markus, Otto and his misfit nerd friends take action in this wildly funny, original winner of 9 awards. For ages 15 and older.

MICHAEL (2026-US/Canada) 127m *** ½ D: Antoine Fuqua (LIGHTNING IN A BOTTLE). Jaafar Jackson, Julian Valdi, Colman Domingo, Nia Long, Miles Teller. From the striking visual impact of his dance moves, the infectious rhythms, that perfectly pitched voice—Michael Jackson (Jaafar Jackson, his nephew) could single-handedly captivate an audience of millions. This is the story of his early career and a celebration of his artistry. This biopic captures what made Michael Jackson a superstar. Winner of 7 awards. PG-13.

I SWEAR (2025-UK) 121m **** D: Kirk Jones (WAKING NED DEVINE). Robert Aramayo, Maxine Peake, Shirley Henderson, Peter Mullan, Scott Ellis Watson. When 14-year-old John Davidson (Watson) comes down with Tourette syndrome, his life is turned upside down. In 1980s Scotland the condition isn't well-known, and John's tics and sudden outbursts alienate him from friends and family. At age 25, John (Aramayo) is on heavy medication and living with his mother (Henderson) when he meets Dottie (Peake), who turns his life around in this funny and touching biopic. Winner of 6 awards. Rated R.

THERMAE ROMAE II (2014-Japan) 112m *** D: Hideki Takeuchi. Hiroshi Abe, Aya Ueto, Kazuki Kitamura, Masachika Ichimura, Kai Shishido. Thanks to his Japan-inspired designs, time-traveling Roman architect Lucius (Abe) has become a valued advisor to Emperor Hadrianus (Ichimura). But the peace-loving emperor is now at odds with expansionist members of the Senate, who wish to wage war to gain territory. Could peace be maintained with a relaxing bath? This humorous sequel to THERMAE ROMAE won 1 award. For all ages.

HUNT FOR THE WILDERPEOPLE (2016-New Zealand) 101m **** D: Taika Waititi. Julian Dennison, Sam Neill (9/14/1947 – 7/13/2026), Rima Te Wiata, Rachel House. Rebellious, chubby and unloved, 13-year-old Ricky Baker (Dennison) is sent to the wild New Zealand bush to live with his new foster parents Bella (Te Wiata) and Hector (Neill). When Ricky and Hector get lost in the forest, Ricky's nemesis, Paula (House) of child welfare services, sends out an army to "rescue" them, turning Ricky and Hector into notorious outlaws. This delightfully funny and touching comedy-drama won 24 awards. Rated PG-13.
