TOC TOC (2017-Spain) 92m * D:** Vicente Villanueva. Paco León, Alexandra Jiménez, Rossy de Palma (Almodóvar's JULIETA), Adrián Lastra, Oscar Martínez, Nuria Herrero. TOC stands for "Trastorno Obsesivo Compulsivo", Spanish for Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder. A computer error schedules six OCD sufferers for the same appointment at a psychologist's office in this uproariously funny comedy. A gentleman with Tourette's Syndrome (Martínez), a numeromaniac cabbie (León), an extreme morphophobe (Jiménez), a woman who can't stop crossing herself (de Palma) and two others gather in the waiting room with hilarious (and positive) results. For ages 12 and older.

THE LAST RECIPE aka Kirin no shita no kioku (2017-Japan) 126m * ½ D:** Yôjirô Takita (DEPARTURES). Kazunari Ninomiya, Hidetoshi Nishijima, Aoi Miyazaki. Failed chef Sasaki (Ninomiya) is eking out a living by cooking "last meals" for elderly people. He has a special talent: he's known to have a "Qilin tongue", the ability to perfectly re-create any dish he's tasted. His powers are put to the ultimate test when a client from Beijing challenges Sasaki to re-create a Japanese Imperial feast prepared in Manchuria in the late 1930s. For ages 12 and older.

THE WHITE CROW (2018-UK/France/Serbia) 127m * D:** Ralph Fiennes (THE INVISIBLE WOMAN). Oleg Ivenko, Ralph Fiennes, Louis Hofmann, Adèle Exarchopoulos, Sergei Polunin. Brilliant Soviet ballet dancer Rudolf Nureyev (Ivenko) is a *belaya vorona*, a white crow. He's destined to stand out among his colleagues, not just because of his stratospheric talent, but because he is ambitious, egotistical, and gay in a society that demands conformity. This gorgeous thriller-biopic illustrates Nureyev's life-changing trip to Paris in 1961. Ukrainian dancer Oleg Ivenko captures Nureyev's animal grace and sensuality in this winner of 1 award. Rated R.

BELLE ET SÉBASTIEN (2013-France) 99m * ½ D:** Nicolas Vanier (SCHOOL OF LIFE). Félix Bossuet, Tchêky Karyo, Margaux Chatelier, Dimitri Storage. In this stirring adaptation of Cécile Aubry's story set in the French Alps in 1943, 8-year-old orphan Sébastien (Bossuet) raises sheep with his grandfather César (Karyo). All through the village there is talk of the "beast" that is killing off the sheep—a fearsome dog that must be killed to protect their flocks. But when Sébastien comes face to face with the "beast", he instead finds a friend—and calls her Belle. Now how can he make the others understand? This delightful film won 4 awards. For ages 8 and older.

BOOKSMART (2019-US) 102m * ½ D:** Olivia Wilde (feature directorial debut). Kaitlyn Dever (SHORT TERM 12), Beanie Feldstein (LADY BIRD), Jason Sudeikis, Lisa Kudrow. High school Valetictorian Molly (Feldstein) has been accepted to Yale, and her best friend Amy plans to volunteer in Botswana for a year before attending Columbia in this riotously funny good-girls-gone-bad comedy. The two brainiacs are furious when they discover that three slacker classmates are *also* off to top schools. Molly and Amy decide to get their fair share of fun... all in one night. Winner of 2 awards so far. Rated R.

ROCKETMAN (2019-UK/US/Canada) 121m * ½ D:** Dexter Fletcher (SUNSHINE ON LEITH). Taron Egerton, Jamie Bell, Richard Madden, Bryce Dallas Howard, Gemma Jones. While in rehab in 1990, Elton Hercules John (Egerton) recalls his childhood as a shy prodigy named Reginald Dwight in this dazzling musical biopic. Bedecked in glitter from head to toe, Taron Egerton is both soulful and joyously preposterous as he re-animates Elton John's platinum songbook. This toe-tapping musical tribute was nominated for 3 awards so far. Rated R.

THE MAGNETIST'S FIFTH WINTER aka Magnetisören's femte vinter (1999-Denmark/Norway/ Sweden) 117m * D:** Morten Henriksen. Rolf Lassgård (AFTER THE WEDDING), Johanna Sällström, Ole Lemmeke, Gard B. Eidsvold. In this fascinating drama, a man named Meisner (Lemmeke), a "magnetist", arrives in a northern Swedish town in 1820, claiming to be able to cure diseases deemed untreatable by modern medicine. When he cures Maria (Sällström), the beautiful daughter of prominent physician Dr. Selander (Lassgård), of her blindness, he causes an uproar in the little town. Winner of 6 awards. For ages 15 and older.

WALLANDER: PYRAMID aka Pyramiden (2007-Sweden/Germany) 88m * ½ D:** Daniel Lind Lagerlöf. Rolf Lassgård (A MAN CALLED OVE), Marie Richardson, Lia Boysen, Dag Elfgren. While investigating a skirmish between drug dealers, detective Wallander (Lassgård) of Ystad, Sweden, revisits a case from when he was a 25-year-old rookie. Faced with a decision to shoot or not to shoot, young Wallander's choice had to be made in a fraction of a second. The consequences, which were deeply personal, have haunted him for his entire career. Now he must face them again as a 51-year-old man in this riveting, supremely suspenseful police drama. For ages 15 and older.

THE LAST RONIN aka Saigo no Chûshingura (2010-Japan) 133m * ½ D:** Shigemichi Sugita. Kôji Yakusho, Kôichi Satô, Nanami Sakuraba. In the 18th century tale of Chûshingura, 47 loyal retainers avenge their lord's wrongful death. Their mission accomplished, all 47 were said to have committed seppuku. In this moving tale, 2 of the 47 survive that night. One of them, Kichieom Terasaka (Satô), travels for 16 years providing succor to the surviving family members. While in Kyoto awaiting the 17th anniversary to honor the dead, Terasaka spots the one man who ran away, Magozaemon Seno (Yakusho). This is his story. Winner of 2 awards. For ages 12 and older.

LET ME EAT YOUR PANCREAS aka Kimi no suizô o tabetai (2017-Japan) 115m * ½ D:** Shô Tsukikawa. Minami Hamabe, Takumi Kitamura, Shun Oguri, Keiko Kitagawa, Karen Ohtomo. A socially awkward boy (Kitamura) finds a diary owned by popular high school classmate Sakura (Hamabe) that reveals she is suffering from pancreatic cancer. Sakura decides to confide in him alone about her serious condition—she hasn't even told her best friend Kyôko (Ohtomo). Slowly drawing him out of his shell, she has him help her achieve her bucket list in this superior weepie. Winner of 2 awards. For ages 12 and older.

LOVE AND HONOR aka Bushi no ichibun (2006-Japan) 122m * ½ D:** Yôji Yamada (TWILIGHT SAMURAI). Takuya Kimura, Rei Dan, Mitsugorô Bandô, Takashi Sasano, Kaori Momoi. Low-ranking samurai Shinnojô (Kimura) feels that his talent is being wasted as a lord's food taster. He tells his beautiful and loving wife Kayo (Dan) that he'd rather open a fencing dojo, but before he could act upon his dream, he eats poisonous shellfish on the job and goes blind. With her husband no longer able to work, Kayo goes out to secure their income and puts their family's honor in peril. This touching samurai-era love story won 12 awards. Rated PG-13.

SAMURAI FROM NOWHERE aka Dôjô yaburi (1964-Japan) 92m * ½ D:** Seiichirô Uchikawa. Isamu Nagato, Tetsurô Tanba, Shima Iwashita, Chieko Baihshô, Seiji Miyaguchi. Master swordsman Ihei Misawa (Nagato) is on the run with a hefty price on his head. His only mistake was to fall in love, and be loved in return, by the lovely Tae (Iwashita). Their domain's lord, coveting Tae as his concubine, has sent a posse of bounty hunters to kill Ihei and capture Tae. Ihei must raise 10 ryo so he and Tae may cross the border to safety in a neighboring domain. How can he raise such a big sum? This exciting samurai adventure is for ages 12 and older.

WALLANDER: THE AFRICAN aka Afrikanen (2006-Sweden) 86m * D:** Stephan Apelgren. Krister Henriksson, Ola Rapace, Johanna Sällström, Shebly Niavarani, Göran Thorell. During local Swedish elections, a man is found dead in a railway car in Poland. The authorities pinpoint his death to have occurred in Ystad, Sweden. Members of the Ystad police try to retrace the man's steps aided by a CID official (Niavarani) from Stockholm. Yet, even with the additional help, the investigation is twisted and muddled (by the investigators themselves) by one fact: the deceased is black. For ages 15 and older.

WALLANDER: THE TRICKSTERS aka Den svaga punkten (2006-Sweden) 86m * D:** Jonas Grimås. Krister Henriksson, Ola Rapace, Johanna Sällström, Cecilia Nilsson. A horse breeder is found dead at his stables, with a horseshoe-shaped gash on his head and an agitated horse in the corral. The Ystad police are called in, and upon closer examination, it is revealed that the horse is innocent, and something much more sinister is afoot. This twisty mystery also introduces a lady (Nilsson) who makes dour detective Wallander (Henriksson) all giddy. For ages 15 and older.

WALLANDER: THE JOKER aka Jokern (2008-Sweden) 88m * D:** Stephan Apelgren, Anders Engström. Krister Henriksson, Ola Rapace, Johanna Sällström, Jakob Eklund, Mats Bergman. A woman who was a key witness at a trial in Malmö is shot dead outside her restaurant in Ystad, Sweden. Detective Stefan (Rapace) of the Ystad police is paired with Frank (Eklund), an unconventional cop from Malmö, to help solve the case. Stefan's boss Chief Detective Wallander (Henriksson), a stickler for procedure, immediately mistrusts Frank, but Stefan notices that Frank's methods are providing results in this faced-paced thriller. For ages 15 and older.

A DOG'S PURPOSE (2017-US/India) 100m * D:** Lasse Hallström (HACHI: A DOG'S TALE). Josh Gad, Dennis Quaid, Peggy Lipton, Britt Robertson. Over the course of several lifetimes, the meaning of life is lovingly explained by a dog named Bailey (voiced by Josh Gad, who was also the voice of the delightful snowman in FROZEN). With each reincarnation, Bailey has new owners and new experiences in this heartwarming tale of love and loyalty. Nominated for 3 awards. Rated PG.

KALINKA aka Au nom de ma fille (2016-France/Germany) 87m * ½ D:** Vincent Garenq. Daniel Auteuil (36TH PRECINCT), Sébastien Koch (BRIDGE OF SPIES), Marie-Josée Croze, Christelle Cornil, Emma Besson. This intense story, based on real events, concerns French citizen André Bamberski's (Auteuil) 27-year battle for justice in the name of his daughter Kalinka (Besson). Her death in 1982 takes place under suspicious circumstances at the residence of her stepfather (Koch), a prominent German physician. André battles the legal bureaucracies of two countries and risks alienating all who love him while carrying out his crusade. Nominated for 1 award. For ages 15 and older.

SCHOOL OF LIFE aka L'école buissonnière (2017-France) 116m * D:** Nicolas Vanier (BELLE ET SÉBASTIEN). Jean Scandel, François Cluzet (THE INTOUCHABLES), Valérie Karsenti, Eric Elmosnino, François Berléand. In this Dickensian tale set in 1930, young orphan Paul (Scandel) is rescued from a Paris orphanage by Célestine (Karsenti), his new foster mother. She takes him to a sprawling country estate in Sologne, where her husband, Borel (Elmosnino), is the gamekeeper. But rather than bonding with his rigid foster dad, Paul befriends Borel's archnemesis Totoche (Cluzet), a poacher. Breathing-taking forest scenery and wildlife photography enrich this enchanting tale. Rated PG. *Note: LHKMD is one!*

WILD ROSE (2018-UK) 101m * ½ D:** Tom Harper. Jessie Buckley, Julie Walters, Sophie Okonedo. Working class Glaswegian Rose-Lynn (Buckley), 23 years old and just out of prison, returns home to her two young children and her mother Marion (Walters) to pick up where she left off. Marion tries to put Rose-Lynn on the straight-and-narrow, but her daughter's dreams are in Nashville, Tennessee, on the stage at the Grand Ole Opry. Singer-songwriter Jessie Buckley's soaring, passionate voice can make any listener believe in country music fairy tales. Winner of 2 awards. Rated R.

A DOG'S JOURNEY (2019-China/India/Hong Kong/US) 109m * D:** Gail Mancuso (feature debut). Josh Gad, Dennis Quaid, Kathryn Prescott, Henry Lau. This heartwarmer takes up where A DOG'S PURPOSE ends, with Bailey (voiced by Josh Gad) now a wise old St. Bernard. Bailey's human friend Ethan (Quaid) implores Bailey, who's at the end of his life, to use his next lives looking after his granddaughter CJ (Prescott). Director Gail Mancuso deepens and broadens this drama to demonstrate how a dog could help repair the damage to a human soul. Nominated for 2 awards so far. Rated PG.

THE CAKEMAKER (2017-Israel/Germany) 113m * ½ D:** Ofir Raul Graizer (feature debut). Tim Kalkhof, Sarah Adler, Roy Miller, Zohar Shtrauss. Heartbroken from the death of his married lover Oren (Miller), Berlin baker Thomas (Kalkhof) travels to Jerusalem to be near Oren's family in this remarkable story of love. Thomas, keeping his involvement with Oren secret, takes a job at Oren's widow Anat's (Adler) café, where his pastries become a big hit. Both grieving for the same man, Anat and Thomas form a tender bond in this winner of 17 awards. For ages 15 and older.

BELLE ET SÉBASTIEN, L'AVENTURE CONTINUE (France-2015) 97m * D:** Christian Duguay. Félix Bossuet, Tchêky Karyo, Margaux Chatelier, Thierry Neuvic, Thylane Blondeau. It is September 1945. In 10-year-old Sébastien's (Bossuet) French Alpine village, everyone is celebrating the end of the war. Sébastien is anxiously awaiting his Aunt Angelina's (Chatelier) return when terrible news arrives: Angelina's plane has crashed on the Italian border. Though the rest of the village mourns, Sébastien and his grandfather César (Karyo) are convinced she's still alive. With his faithful dog Belle, Sébastien embarks on a mission to find Angelina. Winner of 1 award. For ages 8 and older.
