HAPPY VALLEY (2014-UK) 352m (in 3 parts) \*\*\*\* D: Euros Lyn, Sally Wainwright, Tim Fywell. Sarah Lancashire, Steve Pemberton, James Norton, George Costigan, Siobhan Finneran (A CONFES-SION), Sophie Rundle, Derek Riddell. "Happy Valley" is the ironic nickname of the drug afflicted Calder Valley in West Yorkshire. Catherine Cawood (Lancashire) works there as a policewoman. Her own private life has been shaped by the crime and violence of her neighborhood: This compelling tale starts when the rapist of her dead daughter Becky is released from prison. Winner of 24 awards, including 4 BAFTA awards. For ages 15 and older. Note: This month we are screening the entire 1st series of this title. A total of six episodes will be divided into 3 2-hour programs.

A CONFESSION (2019-UK) 228m (2 parts) \*\*\* ½ D: Paul Andrew Williams. Martin Freeman, Siobhan Finneran, Imelda Staunton, Joe Absolom, Kate Ashfield, Derek Riddell, Charlie Cooper. Twenty-two-year-old Sian O'Callaghan goes missing after a Friday night out with friends in Swindon. As the hours and days tick by, detective Stephen Fulcher (Freeman), determined to find Sian still alive, breaks police procedure to find her. The community is shocked with the results. For ages 12 and older. This thoughtful and gripping true story is presented in its entirety this month. All six episodes will be shown in two parts, with each part running 2 hours and 15 minutes.

WALLANDER: THE LOSS aka Saknaden (2014-Sweden) 88m \*\*\*\* D: Agneta Fagerström-Olsson. Krister Henriksson, Charlotta Jonsson, Douglas Johansson, Johan Hedenberg, Mitcho Batalov, Danica Curcic. When the dismembered body of a teenage girl is discovered, Inspector Wallander (Henriksson) and his team believe she may have been an Eastern European prostitute. As Wallander's memory problems worsen, he has to allow Martinsson (Johansson) to lead the case, and the two do not agree on the culprit. For ages 15 and older.

THE TALE OF ZATOICHI CONTINUES ala Zoku Zatôichi monogatari (1962-Japan) 73m \*\*\* ½ D: Kazuo Mori (A KILLER'S KEY). Shintarô Katsu, Tomisaburô Wakayama, Masayo Banri, Yaeko Mizutani, Sônosuke Sawamura. After trying to earn some honest money as a masseur, yakuza Zatoichi (Katsu) is pursued by the retainers of a politically powerful client when he stumbles upon a secret. If that isn't enough of a challenge for the blind swordsman, Zatoichi also has to deal with his vengeful estranged brother Yoshiro (Wakayama, Katsu's real life brother) in this second film in the Zatoichi series. For ages 12 and older.

OSS 117: CAIRO, NEST OF SPIES aka Le Caire, nid d'espions (2006-France) 95m \*\*\* ½ D: Michel Hazanavicius (THE ART-IST). Jean Dujardin, Bérénice Bejo, Aure Atika, Claude Brosset, Philippe Lefebvre. In this outrageously funny spy spoof set in 1955, French agent OSS 117 (Dujardin) travels to Egypt when his close friend and fellow operative Jack (Lefebvre) disappears. Working as the manager of a poultry farm as a cover, the smoothly arrogant but profoundly dumb 117 hunts for Nazis when he's not bedding local beauties. This very un-PC comedy won 4 awards. For ages 12 and older.

ALL FIRED UP aka Tout feu tout flamme (1982-France) 108m \*\*\* D: Jean-Paul Rappeneau (CYRANO DE BERGERAC). Isabelle Adjani, Yves Montand, Lauren Hutton, Alain Souchon, Jean-Luc Bideau. As an assistant to the Minister of the Economy, hardworking Pauline (Adjani) is indispensable. Forced for years to singlehandedly support her two sisters and grandmother, Pauline flies into a rage when her charming ne'er-do-well of a father Victor (Montand) comes home for a visit in this screwball comedy. Rated PG-13.

THE RETURN aka Kikyo (2019-Japan) 119m \*\*\* ½ D: Shigemichi Sugita (A DUEL TALE). Tatsuya Nakadai, Takako Tokiwa, Kazuki Kitamura, Naoto Ogawa, Jirô Satô, Atsuo Nakamura. A once notorious wandering swordsman called "Funeral Uno" (Nakadai) returns home after an absence of thirty years to the bustling post town of Kiso Fukushima in this adaptation of Shûhei Fujisawa's novel. Uno decides to protect the local pub's waitress Okumi (Tokiwa) from the evil attentions of Uno's old rival Kyûzo (Nakamura) in an intense showdown. For ages 12 and older.

ADAM'S APPLES aka Adams æbler (2005-Denmark/Germany) 91m \*\*\* ½ D: Anders Thomas Jensen. Ulrich Thomsen (THE CELEBRATION), Mads Mikkelsen (ANOTHER ROUND), Nicolas Bro, Paprika Steen, Nikolaj Lie Kaas. In this hilariously subversive black comedy, angry neo-Nazi ex-con Adam (Thomsen) gets all of his evil expunged by the most maniacally positive vicar in Denmark, Ivan (Mikkelsen). When Adam arrives in Ivan's rural parish, they agree that Adam would work on a project: baking an apple pie. Through either fate or God's sense of humor, this task takes on biblical proportions. Winner of 28 awards. For ages 15 and older.

LES VIOLENTS (1957-France) 88m \*\*\* D: Henri Calef. Paul Meurisse, Françoise Fabian, Fernand Ledoux, Jean Brochard, Paul Guers. This atmospheric film noir set in Honfleur, Normandy concerns three cousins whose dispute will take them to the murky depths of suspicion and violence. Pierre (Ledoux) and Bernard (Brochard) are receiving threats from their cousin Edgar, and when Bernard dies from poisoning, the chief inspector Malouvier (Meurisse) who arrives on the case looks just like... Edgar. A mesmerizing mystery. For ages 12 and older.

NIGHT BEFORE THE EXAMS aka Notte prima degli esami (2006-Italy) 100m \*\*\* D: Fausto Brizzi (EX). Nicolas Vaporidis, Cristiana Capotondi, Giorgio Faletti, Sarah Maestri, Andrea De Rosa. On the last day of classes, high school senior Luca (Vaporidis) tells his literature teacher Mr. Martinelli (aka "The Prick") exactly what he thinks of him. After calmly taking in Luca's insults, Martinelli informs Luca he'll be the one in charge of final exams in this delightful comedy set in 1980s Rome. Winner of 12 awards. For ages 12 and older.

OSS 117: LOST IN RIO aka Rio ne répond plus (2009-France) 97m \*\*\* D: Michel Hazanavicius (OSS 117: CAIRO, NEST OF SPIES). Jean Dujardin, Louise Monot, Rüdiger Vogler, Reem Kherici. In this second film of the OSS 117 series, it is 1967 and agent OSS 117 Hubert (Dujardin) is in sultry Rio de Janeiro to track down a former Nazi. Hubert, a clueless chauvinist and bigot, is paired with no-nonsense Israeli agent Dolorès (Monot) to humorous effect in this funny 007 spoof. For ages 12 and older.

NEW TALE OF ZATOICHI aka Shin Zatôichi monogatari (1963-Japan) 92m \*\*\* ½ D: Tokuzô Tanaka. Shintarô Katsu, Mikiko Tsubouchi, Seizaburô Kawazu, Fujio Suga. In this third film of the ZATOICHI series, blind master swordsman Ichi (Katsu) is sick of killing and wants to live an honest life. He returns to his old village and the home of his sensei Banno (Kawazu), whose sweet sister Yayoi (Tsubouchi) Ichi hopes to wed. But Shimakichi (Suga), the brother of one of Ichi's victims, is also in town itching for revenge in this satisfying tale. For ages 12 and older.

ACHING HEARTS aka Kærestesorger (2009-Denmark) 117m \*\*\* D: Nils Malmros. Thomas Ernst, Simone Tang, Jacob Grosen, Jesper Svane, Søren Pilmark, Sofie Amalie Klougart. In this coming-of-age drama set in 1960s Viborg, 15-year-old Jonas (Ernst) stumbles into his first experiences with love with fellow high school freshman Agnete (Tang). Filmed over a period of three years, the natural maturation of the performers adds depth to this tale of the fear of and desire for intimacy. Winner of 4 awards. For ages 12 and older.

FLOWER IN THE POCKET (2007-Malaysia) 98m \*\*\* D: Seng Tat Liew. Zi Jiang Wong, Ming Wei Lim, James Lee, Amira Nasuha. Two young motherless brothers Ma Li Ohm (Wong) and Ma Li Ahn (Lim) raise themselves as their father Ah Sui (Lee) toils in a mannequin factory. Li Ohm and Li Ahn have a tough time at school as they don't speak Malay well, but they find plenty to do. They make friends with a mischievous girl (Nasuha), adopt a puppy and go fishing in this lovely meditation on childhood. Winner of 6 international awards. Note: Liam turns 4 Sept. 23

OSS 117: FROM AFRICA WITH LOVE aka Alerte rouge en Afrique noire (2021-France/Belgium) 111m \*\*\* D: Nicolas Bedos. Jean Dujardin, Pierre Niney, Fatou N'Diaye, Natacha Lindinger, Wladimir Yordanoff, Melodie Casta. In this third film of the OSS 117 trilogy, it is 1981 and veteran agent Hubert (Dujardin) is sent to Africa to rescue rookie agent OSS 1001 (Niney) who has gone missing. Humorous spy shenanigans ensue in this 007 spoof. For ages 12 and older.

INSPECTOR GEORGE GENTLY: BLUE FOR BLUE-BIRD (2014-UK) 92m \*\*\*\* D: Bill Anderson. Martin Shaw, Lee Ingleby, Lisa McGrillis, Lee Boardman, Andrea Lowe, Pixie Lott. When the body of a young woman wearing a Bluebird holiday camp uniform washes up on shore nearby, Inspector George Gently (Shaw) and Sgt Bacchus (Ingleby) investigate the staff and visitors to reveal the rather family-unfriendly activities that take place at the camp in this mystery. Meanwhile, Bacchus fights with his ex for more time with his daughter. For ages 15 and older.

SWORD DEVIL aka Ken ki (1965-Japan) 83m \*\*\* ½ D: Kenji Misumi (DESTINY'S SON). Raizō Ichikawa, Michiko Sugata, Kei Satō. Orphaned at birth, fatherless Hanpei (Ichikawa) is adopted into a low-ranking samurai's home. Advised by his loving adoptive father to learn a skill, Hanpei becomes an expert gardener, and is invited to the castle to grow flowers. But when a wandering master swordsman offers to teach Hanpei swordsmanship, Hanpei's life is changed forever in this dark fable. For ages 12 and older.

WHERE THE CRAWDADS SING (2022-US) 125m \*\*\* D: Olivia Newman. Daisy Edgar-Jones, Taylor John Smith, Harris Dickinson, David Strathairn, Michael Hyatt, Sterling Macer Jr., Garret Dillahunt. In this atmospheric mystery set in 1969 North Carolina, Kya (Edgar-Jones) is a young woman who lives alone in the marshlands after escaping her abusive father (Dillahunt). When the local golden boy (Dickinson) is found dead in the marshes, Kya becomes the prime suspect in this adaptation of Delia Owens's novel. Rated PG-13.

MINAMATA (2020-UK/US/UAE/Japan) 116m \*\*\* ½ D: Andrew Levitas. Johnny Depp, Minami, Bill Nighy, Hiroyuki Sanada, Tadanobu Asano, Ryô Kase, Jun Kunimura. Celebrated photojournalist of World War II W. Eugene Smith (Depp) is just scraping by in 1971, in debt and often drunk. But when he learns of the industrial disaster at Minamata, Japan, he secures a secret commission from Life Magazine editor Robert Hayes (Nighy) to travel and photograph the poisoned village. The results are lifechanging, not just to the people of Minamata, but worldwide. Rated R.

DESTINY'S SON aka Kiru (1962-Japan) 71m \*\*\*\* ½ D: Kenji Misumi (THE TALE OF ZATOICHI). Raizō Ichikawa, Shiho Fujimura, Mayumi Nagisa, Masayo Banri, Eijirō Yanagi, Shigeru Amachi. Adopted as a baby by a kindhearted retainer of a prosperous clan, Shingo (Ichikawa) lives the privileged life of a young samurai. But everything changes when a jealous neighbor reveals the sad history of Shingo's real parentage. Believing himself cursed, Shingo resolves to have no wife and be a wanderer for the rest of his life in this stylish bakumatsu period tale. For ages 12 and older.

MELANCHOLIC (2018-Japan) 113m \*\*\* ½
D: Seiji Tanaka (debut). Yôji Minagawa, Yoshitomo Isozaki, Mebuki Yoshida. Though he's graduated from Japan's most prestigious university, Kazuhiko (Minagawa) has never held a full-time job. He lives at home with his slightly exasperated parents. When he bumps into his cute high school classmate Yuri (Yoshida) at the local bathhouse, he takes a part-time job there hoping to see her again. As their romance begins to bloom, Kazuhiko finds opportunities to advance his career in the bathhouse's very, very late night shift in this funny, violent and surprisingly moving black comedy. Winner of 2 awards. For ages 15 and older.

THE INUGAMI FAMILY aka Inugami-ke no ichizoku (1976-Japan) 146m \*\*\* D: Kon Ichikawa. Kôji Ishizaka, Yôko Shimada, Teruhiko Aoi, Mieko Takamine, Mitsuko Kusabue, Rentarô Mikuni. At the ancestral Inugami estate in Nagano, a lawyer reveals the contents of the dead patriarch's will: a vast fortune will go to whoever marries innocent outsider Tamayo Nonomiya (Shimada). In the resulting struggle for property and wealth, gruesome murders are committed. Detective Kindaichi Kôsuke (Ishizaka) reveals dark family secrets while trying to stop the carnage. This Agatha Christie-like mystery set in the early 1950s in the chaos after World War II won 7 awards. For ages 12 and older.
