**CORRESPONDENCE (2016-Italy)** 122m \*\*\* D: Giuseppe Tornatore (CINEMA PARADISO). Jeremy Irons, Olga Kurylenko, Simon Johns, James Warren, Shauna Macdonald. In this English-language romance, married astrophysicist Ed Phoerum (Irons) attempts to defy time and space for the sake of his much younger lover, Amy (Kurylenko). For six years, Amy has settled for stealing moments of Ed's time, relying on texts and emails to maintain their relationship. One day, Amy receives shocking news that makes her question her sanity in this intriguing and gorgeously designed winner of 2 awards. For ages 12 and older.

**JOY (2015-US)** 124m \*\*\* D: David O. Russell (SILVER LININGS PLAYBOOK). Jennifer Lawrence, Robert De Niro, Bradley Cooper, Diane Ladd, Isabella Rossellini, Virginia Madsen. This very American fairy tale is about a beautiful young woman (Lawrence), poor but pure of heart, who despite her horrible family, becomes rich beyond her wildest dreams. The magic wand in this case is a mop. Loosely based on the life of real inventor Joy Mangano, this self-empowerment comedy-drama won 4 awards, including a Golden Globe for Lawrence. Rated PG-13.

**MY BIG GAY ITALIAN WEDDING aka *Puoi baciare lo sposo* (2018-Italy)** 87m \*\*\* D: Alessandro Genovesi. Cristiano Accanto, Salvatore Esposito, Monica Guerritore, Diego Abatantuono, Dino Abbrescia, Diana Del Bufalo. When Berlin resident Antonio (Caccamo) proposes to his beloved Paolo (Esposito), Paolo insists they announce their wedding plans to Antonio's parents in the conservative Italian hilltop village where Antonio grew up. This puts Antonio in a bind—he still hasn't told his parents he's gay! The two make the journey to picturesque Civita di Bagnoregio and the village will never be the same. This joyous comedy won 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

**SCOTT & BAILEY Episodes 9 & 10 (2012-UK)** 90m \*\*\* ½ D: China Moo-Young, Paul Walker. Suranne Jones, Amelia Bullmore, Lesley Sharp, Nicholas Gleaves, Vincent Regan, Liam Boyle. Chief Inspector Gill Murray (Bullmore) skillfully mentors Rachel (Jones) on a copycat murder case in Bristol. Both women, however, have difficult home situations, especially Rachel, who discovers that her brother Dominic (Boyle) is using her flat to turn tricks. Meanwhile, Janet (Sharp), who has split with her husband, has misgivings about her affair with Andy (Gleaves). For ages 15 and older.

**TAKE HOME PAY (2019-New Zealand/Samoa)** 105m \*\*\* D: Stallone Vaiagoa-Ioasa (THREE WISE COUSINS). Vito Vito, Ronnie Taulafo, Tofiga Fepulea'i. Taro farmers and brothers Alama (Vito Vito) and Popo (Taulafo) travel to Auckland, New Zealand as seasonal workers. After earning lots of cash picking kiwi fruit, the brothers are due to return to Samoa the next day when Popo disappears, taking all of Alama's money. Determined not to return empty handed, Alama has his relative Bob Titilo (Fepulea'i), a wannabe private eye, hunt Popo down. This guffaw-inducing comedy has wacky characters, martial arts action, and even a sing-off! Rated PG.

**THE MOLE AGENT aka *El agente topo* (2020-Chile/US/Germany/Netherlands/Spain)** 90m \*\*\* ½ D: Maite Alberdi. Concerned that her mother Sonia Pérez isn't receiving proper care, her daughter hires private investigator Romulo Aitken to embed a mole within her mother's Chilean retirement home in this unique documentary. Romulo hires 83-year-old Sergio Chamy, a kind-hearted charmer who is an instant hit with the ladies. Sergio is dutiful in carrying out his assignment but cannot help getting involved in the lives of the residents in this insightful and heartwarming spy story. Winner of 13 awards and nominated for a Best Documentary Oscar. For ages 12 and older.

**THE DAY THE SUN FELL aka *Als die Sonne vom Himmel fiel* (2015-Switzerland/Finland)** 78m \*\*\*\* D: Aya Domenig (feature debut). Documentarist Aya Domenig's grandfather was a physician in Hiroshima during the atomic bombing. He never talked about his experiences. In this searing documentary, Domenig travels to Hiroshima to visit her grandmother and interview the medical colleagues of her grandfather. The results are astonishing: those who treated A-bomb radiation victims make a connection with those who were affected by the Fukushima 2011 disaster. Winner of 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

**THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: DEAD AND BURIED (2019-New Zealand)** 92m \*\*\* ½ D: Katie Wolfe. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Nic Sampson, Elizabeth McRae, Tracy Lee Gray, Yvette Parsons. Detective Mike Shepherd (Rea) and his team are reacquainted with some of Brokenwood's colorful murderesses while investigating a suspicious suicide at the women's prison. Inmates Trudy Nielson (Gray) and Rayleen Hogg (Parsons) know a thing or two but will only give up their information for a price. For ages 14 and older.

**MAY GOD SAVE US aka *Que Dios nos perdone* (2016-Spain)** 121m \*\*\* ½ D: Rodrigo Sorogoyen. Antonio de la Torre, Roberto Álamo. In Madrid in 2011, thousands of pilgrims travel to the city in anticipation of a papal visit. Amidst the frenzied activity, a serial rapist/killer is targeting elderly women. The two cops assigned to the case, Alfaro (Álamo) and Velarde (de la Torre), are under severe pressure to keep the investigation secret. Meanwhile, emboldened by the lack of press coverage, the killer's body count rises. This crime thriller won 4 awards. For ages 15 and older.

**IN HEAVEN UNDERGROUND aka *Im Himmel, unter der Erde* (2011-Germany)** 92m \*\*\* ½ D: Britta Wauer. The Weissensee Jewish Cemetery in Berlin is the largest active Jewish cemetery in Europe. Founded in 1880, it was one of the few to escape being destroyed by the Nazis. Though this documentary touches on the cemetery's role of mourning and remembrance, most of the fascinating content is how the vast, green and leafy place serves as a refuge/nature reserve/playground. Among the visitors featured are: art students, guys in climbing gear(!), mausoleum restorers and German military reservists. This uplifting, inspiring film won 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

**OMA & BELLA (2012-Germany/US)** 77m \*\*\* ½ D: Alexa Karolinski. Holocaust survivors and best friends Regina Karolinski (director Alexa Karolinski's grandmother or "Oma") and Bella Katz live in Berlin and prepare elaborate dishes they recall from their childhoods, before the Holocaust. In this documentary, we observe the active daily lives of this dynamic pair as they shop, cook and entertain friends and family. Though Oma and Bella clearly recall the horrors of the past, they are joyously positive in the present. Tzimmes, calf's foot jelly, stuffed cabbage and blintzes are among the dishes prepared in this life-affirming documentary. For ages 12 and older.

**THE JAGUAR aka *Le jaguar* (1996-France)** 100m \*\*\* D: Francis Veber (THE VALET). Jean Reno, Patrick Bruel, Harrison Lowe, Danny Trejo, Patricia Velasquez. In this fabulously politically incorrect farce, Wanù (Lowe), a shaman from the Brazilian rainforest, visits France for a PR campaign with his assistant Campana (Reno). Wanù meets French good-for-nothing Perrin (Bruel) in an elevator and feels an intense spiritual bond. When Wanù suddenly suffers a heart attack, he relies on his new acquaintance to travel to the Amazon forest with Campana to retrieve his lost soul. Perrin, who is 100,000 Euros in debt to dangerous loan sharks, agrees. For ages 10 and older.

**ASTEROID CITY (2023-US/Germany)** 105m \*\*\* ½ D: Wes Anderson (THE GRAND BUDAPEST HOTEL). Jason Schwartzman, Scarlett Johansson, Jake Ryan, Grace Edwards, Tom Hanks, Jeffrey Wright, Tilda Swinton. In this play within a play within a TV program, a grieving war photographer (Schwartzman) has yet to tell his children that their mother died. His teenage son (Ryan) has been invited to the 1955 Junior Stargazer Convention in the tiny Southwestern town of Asteroid City, a place that features an enormous crater in the desert landscape. The nerdy teen invitees, their parents and their hosts have a cosmic surprise in this whimsical yet profound tale. Nominated for 4 awards. Rated PG-13.

**BIG TIME GAMBLING BOSS aka *Bakuchiuchi: Sôchô Tobaku* (1968-Japan)** 95m \*\*\* ½ D: Kôzaku Yamashita (RED PEONY GAMBLER). Kôji Tsuruta, Tomisaburo Wakayama (LONE WOLF AND CUB), Hiroshi Nawa, Sumiko Fuji. The leader of the Tenryû clan suffers a stroke, setting off a succession battle in this unique yakuza story of loyalty and betrayal set in 1934 Tokyo. The clan members unanimously vote for Nakai (Tsuruta), a man whose adherence to the yakuza code of honor is widely admired. Nakai refuses the post in favor of his senior, Matsuda (Wakayama), who is in prison. Sworn brothers are forced to battle each other in this yakuza classic. For ages 12 and older.

**SCOTT & BAILEY Episodes 11 & 12 (2012-UK)** 90m \*\*\* ½ D: Paul Walker. Lesley Sharp, Suranne Jones, Amelia Bullmore, Kevin Doyle, Sean Maguire, Vincent Regan, Nicholas Gleaves. Killer Geoff Hastings (Doyle) offers to reveal the identities of his other victims if and *only* if Janet (Sharp)—the woman he tried to kill—is the interviewing officer. Later, the team investigates the death of a middle-aged divorcee wearing a sexy police costume and a bizarre green mold on her face. DCI Murray's (Bullmore) domestic problems worsen, and Sean (Maguire), Rachel's boyfriend, gives Rachel (Jones) a big surprise. For ages 15 and older.

**ABOUT MY FATHER (2023-US)** 90m \*\*\* D: Laura Terruso. Sebastian Maniscalco, Robert De Niro, Leslie Bibb, Kim Cattrall, David Rasche, Anders Holm. Popular comedian Sebastian Maniscalco stars in this delightful Chicago Italian send up of GET OUT. Hoping to make a good impression on his girlfriend Ellie's (Bibb) posh parents, Sebastian is delighted when he's invited for Fourth of July weekend at their summer home in Virginia. When Sebastian's irascible Sicilian immigrant dad Salvo (De Niro) decides to join them, a hilarious culture clash ensues. Rated PG-13. *Note: Liam turns 5 on 9/23/23!*

**SHOCK TREATMENT aka *Traitement de choc* (1973-France/Italy)** 84m \*\*\* D: Alain Jessua. Alain Delon, Annie Girardot, Michel Duchaussoy, Robert Hirsch. Dumped for a younger woman, fashion executive Hélène (Girardot) arrives at an exclusive spa resort to rejuvenate her looks in this suspenseful thriller. Though she feels energized and youthful from the treatment, she begins to suspect that something's not quite right about the spa and its founder, the sinister and sexy Dr. Devils (Delon). For ages 15 and older.

**THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: THE GAROTTE AND THE VINKELBRAUN (2021-New Zealand)** 92m \*\*\* ½ D: Katie Wolfe. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Cristina Serban Ionda, Mark Hadlow, Ingrid Park, James Richard Marshall. All of Brokenwood is abuzz with excitement when the TV crew of a popular antiques show arrives in town. Shortly after filming, the show's host, Brian Bottoms (Hadlow) is found dead in his motel room strapped to a 16th century torture device. The last person known to have seen him alive is Jools Fahey's (Park) posh new beau Lord Ashbury (Marshall). For ages 14 and older.

**SCOTT & BAILEY Episodes 13 & 14 (2012-UK)** 91m \*\*\* ½ D: Morag Fullarton. Suranne Jones, Lesley Sharp, Nicholas Gleaves, Sean Maguire, Sally Lindsay, Tony Pitts. Janet (Sharp) is relegated to desk duty by her bitter ex-lover Andy (Gleaves) when she's asked to help investigate the death of an 18-year-old boy. Janet and Rachel (Jones) interview two very different teenage girls involved in the case. Later, Rachel is invited to a bachelorette party where she drinks way too much. The next morning, she is under suspicion of killing her ex-lover, Nick Savage. For ages 15 and older.

**PAST LIVES (2023-US/South Korea)** 105m \*\*\*\* D: Celine Song (feature debut). Greta Lee, Teo Yoo, John Magaro, Moon Seung-ah, Leem Seung-min. Talented pre-teen girl student Na Young (Moon) is about to emigrate from South Korea to Canada. Her mother sets her up on a date with the boy she likes, Hae Sung (Leem), who returns her feelings. Twenty four years later, Na Young is now called Nora (Lee) and she lives in New York with her writer husband Arthur (Magaro). When Hae Sung (Yoo) visits Nora in New York, their revived friendship sparks feelings the three can't control in this brilliant drama. Winner of 4 awards. Rated PG-13.
