**THE YOUNG MONTALBANO: THE THIRD SECRET** *aka Il terzo segreto* (2012-Italy) 98m \*\*\* ½ D: Gianluca Maria Tavarelli. Michele Riondino, Fabrizio Pizzuto, Alessio Vassallo, Nino D'Agata, Beniamino Marcone, Sarah Felberbaum. Detective Montalbano (Riondino) receives a letter warning that an Albanian construction worker is about to have a fatal accident. Due to a postal strike, the letter arrives too late—and the worker is found dead. Although it is officially a case for the Carabinieri, Montalbano investigates anyway, leading to a confrontation with Marschiallo Verruso (D'Agata) of the Carabinieri. For ages 14 and older.

**ENDEAVOUR: GIRL** (2013-UK) 94m \*\*\*\* D: Edward Bazalgette. Shaun Evans, Roger Allam, Anton Lesser, Jonathan Hyde, Sophie Stuckey. There's a new boss at the police station: Chief Superintendent Bright (Lesser) is a rigid stickler for rules and regs who immediately disapproves of unconventional constable Endeavour Morse (Evans). But Morse is stuck on solving what he thinks is a murder—everyone else thinks young Margaret Bell, who had a heart condition, died of natural causes in this intriguing episode. For ages 12 and older.

**PRISCILLA, QUEEN OF THE DESERT** (1994-Australia) 99m \*\*\*\*½ D: Stephan Elliott. Terence Stamp (7/22/1938 – 8/17/2025), Hugo Weaving, Guy Pearce, Bill Hunter. Sydney drag queens Mitzi (Weaving) and Felicia (Pearce) and elegant transgender artiste Bernadette (Stamp) are hired to perform a drag extravaganza in Alice Springs, a remote town way, way outback in the desert. This profane, funny and fabulous lavender bus ride won an Oscar for Best Costume (of course, dahling) and 10 other awards. Rated R.

**ABOUT DRY GRASSES** *aka Kuru Otlar Üstüne* (2023-Turkey/France/Germany/Sweden/Qatar) 198m \*\*\* ½ D: Nuri Bilge Ceylan (DISTANT). Deniz Celiloglu, Merve Dizdar, Musab Ekici, Ece Bagci. Intermediate school art teacher Samet (Celiloglu) has been posted in a snowy, remote Anatolian community for four years and blames all his problems on being stranded in the sticks. When his behavior around coquettish student Sevim (Bagci) comes under scrutiny, Samet worries he'll be stuck there forever. His only hope is fellow teacher Nuray (Dizdar), who tries to break through Samet's bitter cynicism in this brilliant winner of 15 awards. Merve Dizdar's bravura performance garnered Best Actress at Cannes. For ages 12 and older.

**THE BETRAYAL** *aka Daisatsujin orochi* (1966-Japan) 87m \*\*\* ½ D: Tokuzô Tanaka. Raizô Ichikawa, Kaoru Yachigusa, Shiho Fujimura, Ichirô Nakatani, Takuya Fujioka. In this rarely seen chamber classic, honorable samurai Takuma (Ichikawa) is about to wed the love of his life, Namie (Yachigusa). But before they tie the knot, her father, a clan elder, asks Takuma to go into exile for a year, so he may take the blame for a crime committed by the son of their clan's daimyo. Believing that the samurai's code of honor will be upheld, Takuma is horribly betrayed, leaving him hunted by two clans and the police. This film, culminating in a spectacular swordfight battle, is a must-see for lovers of Japanese cinema. For ages 12 and older.

**ALL WE IMAGINE AS LIGHT** (2024-France/India/Netherlands/Luxembourg/Italy/Switzerland/US/Belgium) 118m \*\*\* ½ D: Payal Kapadia. Kani Kusruti, Divya Prabha, Chhaya Kadam, Hridhu Haroon. Three Hindu women work at a hospital together in Mumbai. Head nurse Prabha (Kusruti) is often exasperated by her roommate and fellow nurse, starry-eyed Anu (Prabha), who is always trying to find time alone with her Muslim boyfriend Shiaz (Haroon). When their mutual friend Parvaty (Kadam) is forced out of her apartment by rapacious developers, Prabha and Anu help her move (and find solidarity) in this tale of friendship. Winner of 45 awards. For ages 15 and older.

**THREE BILLBOARDS OUTSIDE EBBING, MISSOURI** (2017-UK/US) 115m \*\*\*\* D: Martin McDonagh (IN BRUGES). Frances McDormand, Woody Harrelson, Sam Rockwell. Frustrated with the inaction of the local police one year after the murder of her daughter, Mildred Hayes (McDormand) rents three billboards and uses them to shame police chief Willoughby (Harrelson), who is suffering from cancer. In the process she makes an enemy of many in her community, including Willoughby's second-in-command Dixon (Rockwell). This fierce black comedy won 101 awards including Oscars for McDormand and Rockwell. Rated R.

**FOYLE'S WAR: THE CAGE** (2013-UK/Ireland/US) 89m \*\*\*\* D: Stuart Orme. Michael Kitchen, Honeysuckle Weeks, Daniel Wayman, Ellie Hadington. While investigating the deaths of three Russian defectors, Christopher Foyle (Kitchen) discovers an army facility he suspects of hiding some very unsavory secrets. Meanwhile, Sam's (Weeks) husband Adam (Wayman) decides to help a constituent whose daughter, Evelyn Green, has mysteriously disappeared. Coincidentally, MI5 reports that an Evelyn Green has turned up in East Berlin. For ages 14 and older.

**EVIL DOES NOT EXIST** *aka Aku wa sonzai shinai* (2023-Japan) 107m \*\*\* ½ D: Ryûsuke Hamaguchi (DRIVE MY CAR). Hitoshi Omika, Ryô Nishikawa, Ryûji Kosaka, Ayaka Shibutani. In Mizubiki, a hamlet near Tokyo, wasabi, which only grows in the most pristine of environments, flourishes wild. Takumi (Omika) leads a modest life with his young daughter Hana (Nishikawa) gathering spring water and chopping wood. When a talent agency decides to build a glamping site on a deer trail in Mizubiki, Takumi is hired as a consultant, leading to dire consequences in this quiet, haunting, thriller. Winner of 17 awards. For ages 12 and older.

**BOWFINGER** (1999-US) 97m \*\*\* ½ D: Frank Oz (DEATH AT A FUNERAL). Steve Martin, Eddie Murphy, Heather Graham, Christine Baranski, Terence Stamp (7/22/1938 – 8/17/2025), Robert Downey Jr. Desperate, broke movie producer Bobby Bowfinger (Martin) gets a verbal agreement from hotshot studio exec Jerry Renfro (Downey) to distribute Bowfinger's shoestring budget sci-fi flick CHUBBY RAIN, so long as it stars Kit Ramsey (Murphy), Hollywood's top box office star. But when Kit refuses the role, Bobby finds a creative work-around in this hilarious comedy that features Terence Stamp as Terry Stricter, the L. Ron Hubbard-like guru of MindHead. Rated PG-13.

**KIDNAPPED** *aka Rapito* (2023-Italy/France/Germany) 134m \*\*\* ½ D: Marco Bellochio (MY MOTHER'S SMILE). Paolo Pierobon, Fausto Russo Alesi, Barbara Ronchi, Enea Sala. It is 1858 in Bologna, Italy. Edgardo (Sala), a young Jewish boy, is secretly baptized and forcibly taken from his family by the Catholic church to be raised as a Christian. Edgardo's parents Salomone (Alesi) and Marianna (Ronchi) embark on a heart-wrenching decade-long journey to bring their child home. This family's plight became part of a bigger battle that pitted the papacy against forces of democracy and Italian unification. Winner of 20 awards. For ages 12 and older.

**MISS FISHER'S MURDER MYSTERIES** Episodes 15 & 16 (2013-Australia) 109m \*\*\* ½ D: Ken Cameron. Essie Davis, Nathan Page, Ashleigh Cummings, Miriam Margolyes, Teague Rook. When private detective Phryne Fisher (Davis) hosts a séance for her Aunt Prudence (Margolyes), who's been swept up in the new spiritualist fad, mysterious and deadly things happen. Later, Phryne goes on an adventure involving pirate treasure and bootleg rum in the seaside town of Queenscliff. For ages 15 and older.

**WARFARE** (2025-US/UK) 95m \*\*\* ½ D: Alex Garland (CIVIL WAR), Ray Mendoza. Will Poulter, Joseph Quinn, D'Pharaoh Woon-A-Tai, Cosmo Jarvis, Aaron Mackenzie, Alex Brockdorff. In this powerful depiction of a real incident that took place in 2006 during the Iraq War, a platoon of Navy Seals on a surveillance mission occupies a house in insurgent territory. Things quickly go wrong, and the group of very different men gel as a unit. This visceral reenactment, written by the men who were there at the battle, was nominated for 3 awards. Rated R.

**THE LIMEY** (1999-US) 89m \*\*\* ½ D: Steven Soderbergh (BLACK BAG). Terence Stamp (7/22/1938 – 8/17/2025), Peter Fonda, Lesley Ann Warren, Luis Guzmán, Barry Newman. Just out of prison, cockney career criminal Wilson (Stamp) arrives in Los Angeles to punish whoever killed his actress daughter Jenny. He doesn't buy that she died in a car accident—and he has his fiery blue vengeful gaze on her onetime boyfriend, music industry exec Valentine (Fonda). Stamp is frightening, utterly cool and compulsively watchable in this winner of 1 award. Rated R.

**THE COMMANDER AND THE STORK** *aka Il comandante e la cicogna* (2012-Italy/Switzerland/France) 105m \*\*\* D: Silvio Soldini (BREAD AND TULIPS). Valerio Mastandrea, Alba Rohrwacher, Giuseppe Battiston, Claudia Gerini, Luca Zingaretti (DETECTIVE MONTALBANO). While the statue of Garibaldi, unifier of Italy, gazes into the crowds, wondering if Italians could actually govern themselves, a widowed plumber (Mastandrea) and a penniless artist (Rohrwacher) meet on a whimsical path to love... in the office of a slimy lawyer (Zingaretti). Nominated for 6 awards. For ages 15 and older.
