THE WEASEL'S TALE aka *El Cuento de las Comadres* (2019-Argentina/Spain) 129m *** ½ D: Juan José Campanella (THE SECRET IN THEIR EYES). Graciela Borges, Oscar Martínez, Luis Brandoni, Marcos Mundstock, Clara Lago, Nicolás Francella. Aging movie diva Mara (Borges) shares a crumbling country estate with her husband Pedro (Brandoni), director Norberto (Martínez) and writer Martín (Mundstock). Fickle and vain, Mara falls prey to slick developers (Lago and Francella) scheming after her property. Pedro, Norberto and Martín must come up with a performance of a lifetime to save their home! This wickedly funny black comedy was nominated for 4 awards. For ages 12 and older.

CREST OF BETRAYAL aka *Chūshingura gaiden: Yotsuya kaidan* (1994-Japan) 104m *** D: Kinji Fukasaku (BATTLE ROYALE). Kōichi Satō, Saki Takaoka, Keiko Oginome, Renji Ishibashi. The 18th century samurai tale of loyalty and revenge, Chūshingura, and the famous Yotsuya Kaidan ghost story are entertainingly mashed together to create a unique thriller-romance. Ronin Tamiya (Satō), hired by the Asano clan to help avenge their disgraced lord, is distracted from his work by the beautiful courtesan Oiwa (Takaoka). Winner of 18 awards. For ages 12 and older.

A CROOKED SOMEBODY (2017-US) 102m *** D: Trevor White. Rich Sommer, Ed Harris, Joanne Froggatt, Clifton Collins Jr., Amy Madigan. Baby-faced conman Michael (Sommer) makes his money in cheap hotel banquet halls convincing gullible folk into thinking he can communicate with the dead. When audience member Nathan (Collins Jr.) begins to believe that Michael has the power to see the crime he committed, Michael starts a dangerous new con game. *The New York Times* calls this indie a "highly enjoyable thriller". Rated R.

MASQUERADE HOTEL (2019-Japan) 124m *** D: Masayuki Suzuki. Takuya Kimura, Masami Nagasawa, Gaku Hamada, Fumiyo Kohinata, Takako Matsu. The police pinpoint the next place a serial killer will strike: the posh Cortesia Hotel in Tokyo. Scruffy detective Nitta (Kimura) is assigned to work undercover at the hotel front desk with ace hospitality pro Yamagishi (Nagasawa). While Yamagishi fiercely protects the privacy of her guests, Nitta must work around her to investigate them in this nifty thriller. Nominated for 4 awards. For ages 12 and older.

JACK THE RIPPER (1959-UK) 85m *** D: Robert S. Baker, Monty Berman. Lee Patterson, Eddie Byrne, Betty McDowall, John Le Mesurier. It's 1888 and Jack the Ripper is terrorizing the streets of London. Scotland Yard Inspector O'Neill (Byrne) welcomes his friend, New York City detective Sam Lowry (Patterson), who is visiting on vacation. Sam is soon involved in the grisly case as he romances Anne Ford (McDowall), whose uncle is never around when the Ripper strikes. Shocking and scandalous in its time, this critically acclaimed whodunit scripted by Jimmy Sangster is still quite the thriller. Unrated. *Movie Museum presents the full-length US version*

GATES OF THE NIGHT aka *Les portes de la nuit* (1946-France) 112m *** ½ D: Marcel Carné (CHILDREN OF PARADISE). Yves Montand, Nathalie Nattier, Serge Reggiani, Saturnin Fabre, Raymond Bussières. It is the winter of 1945; the war hasn't ended yet, but life is returning to Paris. Resistance hero Jean (Montand) is told by a man in tattered clothes (who may or may not be Destiny) that he will fall in love with a beautiful woman. That night, Jean meets Malou (Nattier). Jacques Prévert scripts this magically atmospheric noir/romance. For ages 12 and older.

AN AUTUMN'S TALE aka *Chau tin dik tung wa* (1987-Hong Kong) 98m *** ½ D: Mabel Cheung (THE SOONG SISTERS). Yun-Fat Chow, Cherie Chung, Danny Bak-Keung Chan. Hong Kong college student Jennifer (Chung) arrives in New York to join her boyfriend Vincent (Chan) to study at NYU. To her dismay, she discovers that Vincent has found a new girlfriend and is moving to Boston! Concerned for the heartbroken Jennifer, distant cousin Samuel (Chow) helps pick up the pieces. Somehow, the spoiled co-ed and the scruffy, street-wise cabbie form a special bond in this comedy-drama authentically filmed in the Big Apple. Winner of 4 awards. For ages 12 and older.

CLOCLO aka *My Way* (2012-France/Belgium) 149m *** D: Florent-Emilio Scifi. Jérémie Renier (POTICHE), Benoît Magimel, Monica Scattini, Joséphine Japy. Jérémie Renier brilliantly portrays the French pop icon of the '60s and '70s, Claude "Cloclo" François, in this dazzling biopic. A talented composer, he is best known for the international hit "My Way", originally written as "Comme d'habitude". Cloclo's childhood in Egypt and his meteoric rise to fame in Paris via Monaco are replicated with nostalgic verve. Winner of 3 awards, 2 of them for Renier's astounding performance. For ages 12 and older.

JOJO RABBIT (2019-Czech Republic/New Zealand/US) 108m *** ½ D: Taika Waititi (WHAT WE DO IN THE SHADOWS). Roman Griffin Davis, Thomasin McKenzie, Scarlett Johansson, Taika Waititi, Archie Yates. This surprisingly touching satire concerns Jojo (Davis), a frightened little boy who's trying to be a good Nazi as World War II engulfs his German town. Jojo relies on his imaginary friend Hitler (Waititi) to help him fit in. Meanwhile, Jojo discovers that a mysterious stranger (McKenzie) is living in his house, and his Mom (Johansson) might have put her there! Winner of 32 awards including the Best Adapted Screenplay Oscar (Waititi). Rated PG-13.

BLACKBIRD (2019-US/UK) 97m *** D: Roger Michell (NOTTING HILL). Susan Sarandon, Kate Winslet, Mia Wasikowska, Sam Neill, Rainn Wilson. This moving remake of the 2014 Danish film STILLE HJERTE concerns terminally ill Lily (Sarandon), who gathers her family together one last time before her euthanasia. Lily's daughters, judgmental control freak Jennifer (Winslet) and screwup Anna (Wasikowska), struggle to overcome their differences as they honor their mother's wishes. Winner of 1 award. Rated R.

ALL ABOUT AH-LONG (1989-Hong Kong) 99m *** ½ D: Johnnie To (PTU: POLICE TACTICAL UNIT). Yun-Fat Chow, Sylvia Chang, Kun-Hsuan Huang. Ex-con single dad Ah Long (Chow) works hard at a quarry to support his 10-year-old son Porky (Huang). When Porky is invited to audition for a TV ad, father and son are thrilled with the chance to make some much-needed money. At the audition, Ah Long is astonished to see the ad's producer is his ex-girlfriend Por Por (Chang). Hoping to reunite, Ah Long must acknowledge his past mistakes in this moving drama. Chow won Best Actor at the Hong Kong Film Awards for this film. For ages 12 and older.

100 YEN LOVE aka *Hyakuen no koi* (2014-Japan) 114m *** ½ D: Masaharu Take. Sakura Andō, Hirofumi Arai. Slacker Ichiko (Andō) is living off her parents when she gets in a fight with her sister and leaves home in a huff. Thirty two-years-old and without any employable skills, Ichiko scrapes by working at a 100 yen store. One day, she passes by a boxing gym and sees Yuji (Arai) training. Inspired, her ringside bell clangs and Ichiko's rematch with life begins! Winner of 9 awards. For ages 12 and older.

HAPPY TOGETHER: ALL ABOUT MY DOG aka *Inu to anata no monogatari: Inu no eiga* (2011-Japan) 88m *** D: Hisashi Eto, Soichi Ishii, Jun Kawanishi, Yutaka Mizuochi, Shunichi Nagasaki, Naoto Nakanishi, Nao Ohmori, Nanako Matsushima, Mana Ashida, Akira Nakao. From LOL comedy to moving drama, six heartstring-tugging stories illustrate the Japanese (and worldwide) bond between people and their canine companions. For ages 10 and older.

A HIDDEN LIFE (2019-US/UK/Germany) 174m *** ½ D: Terrence Malick (DAYS OF HEAVEN). August Diehl, Valerie Pachner, Matthias Schoenaerts, Bruno Ganz, Michael Nyqvist. Austrian farmer Franz Jägerstätter (Diehl) refuses to fight for the Nazis in this sweeping World War II drama. When he is called to duty in 1943, Franz's conscientious objection lands him in prison, and his loyal wife Franziska (Pachner), an outcast because of Franz's beliefs, must eke out a living alone. This true story of morale courage won 7 awards, including one at Cannes. Rated PG-13.

MR. LONG aka *Ryu san* (2017-Japan/Hong Kong/Taiwan) 124m *** ½ D: SABU (BUNNY DROP). Chen Chang, Shō Aoyagi, Yi Ti Yao, Run-yin Bai, Masashi Arifuku, Tarō Suwa. Elite Taiwanese hit man Long (Chang) is badly injured in Roppongi, Tokyo while trying to kill his mark. He manages to climb into the back of a truck and escape to a deserted town in the boonocks. He is rescued and adopted by eccentric but big-hearted villagers who help him rebuild his life in this heart-warming(l) story of a killer. Chang (who won an award) plays a character so cool he doesn't talk or smile—whose eyes express deep feelings. For ages 15 and older.

THE CRACK: INCEPTION aka *El crack cero* (2019-Spain) 120m *** D: José Luis Garci (CRADLE SONG). Carlos Santos, Miguel Ángel Muñoz, Luisa Gavasa, Macarena Gómez. Director José Luis Garci revisits his EL CRACK film series with this prequel set in 1975 Madrid, the last year of the Franco regime. Newly minted private detective Germán Areta (Santos) investigates the death of a big-spending, bon vivant tailor, which the police says is suicide. This love letter to the classic American film noir is filmed in atmospheric black and white by Luis Ángel Pérez. Winner of 4 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE WILD GOOSE LAKE aka *Nan fang che zhan de ju hui* (2019-China/France) 111m *** ½ D: Yi'nan Diao. Ge Hu, Gwei Lun-Mei, Fan Liao, Regina Wan. In Wuhan's dank underbelly, wounded gang boss Zenong (Hu) runs from a rival gang and the police. Beautiful and mysterious hooker Liu Aiai (Lun-Mei) offers to take him to his estranged wife (Wan) at Wild Goose Lake. Cinematography by Jingsong Dong and sound design by Yang Zhang create an environment so immersive the narrative needs few words. This stylish noir won 14 awards. For ages 15 and older.

BANGLA (2019-Italy) 83m *** D: Phaim Bhuiyan (feature debut). Phaim Bhuiyan, Carlotta Antonelli, Simone Liberati, Pietro Sermonti. Phaim (Bhuiyan) thinks of himself as a typical Italian 20-something who just happens to have Bangladeshi parents. He lives in the hipster neighborhood of Torpignattara in Rome, but his Muslim family is conservative: they'd like nothing better than for Phaim to find a nice Bangladeshi girl. But when Phaim starts seeing free-spirited Italian girl Asia (Antonelli), that idea just sounds impossible. This charming and funny cross-cultural romance won 3 awards. For ages 12 and older.

OUR LOVERS aka *Nuestros amantes* (2016-Spain) 88m *** D: Miguel Ángel Lamata. Eduardo Noriega, Michelle Jenner, Amaia Salamanca, Gabino Diego. As soon as Carlos (Noriega) sits at a table in a book shop café, he notices a pretty girl (Jenner) staring at him. She joins him at his table and asks him to play a game. "Don't tell me your name," she begins, "I want to call you something no one else does." She tells him the rules: they are to get to know each other with no Googling, no emails, no telephones...and no falling in love. This witty (romantic?) comedy set in the picturesque Aragon region of Spain was nominated for 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

UNHINGED (2020-US) 90m *** D: Derrick Borte. Russell Crowe (GLADIATOR), Caren Pistorius, Gabriel Bateman. Single mom Rachel (Pistorius) is having a bad day. She's late dropping off her son (Bateman) to school, she's on the verge of being fired from her job and her mom's just been put in a care home. It's understandable when she blasts her horn and overtakes a dawdling pickup truck. Unfortunately, the man (Crowe) driving the truck is...unhinged. According to *Variety*, this blackly humorous car chase thriller is powered by an "enormous, hell-for-leather-and-then-some performance" by Crowe. Rated R.

BALLOON (2018-Germany/France/US) 125m *** ½ D: Michael Herbig. Friedrich Mücke, Karoline Schuch, David Kross, Alicia von Rittberg, Thomas Kretschmann, Jonas Hadenrieder. In the summer of 1979 in Pöbneck, East Germany, two families are preparing to execute a crazy plan: escaping to the West in a hot air balloon. This almost unbearably suspenseful true story is depicted with an awe-inspiring physical replica of the 100-foot tall airship. Winner of 3 awards. Rated PG-13.

SECRET PEOPLE (1952-UK) 91m *** D: Thorold Dickinson. Valentina Cortese, Audrey Hepburn, Serge Reggiani, Charles Goldner, Megs Jenkins. In 1930, Italian sisters Maria (Cortese) and Nora Brentano flee murderous dictator Galbani to the safety of London. Seven years later, even though Maria and Nora (Hepburn) are eager to be model British citizens, they are ensnared in an assassination plot against Galbani. This tale of intrigue features a strong performance by Cortese and lovely footage of Hepburn dancing classical ballet. For ages 12 and older.

A RAINY DAY IN NEW YORK (2019-US) 92m *** D: Woody Allen (MANHATTAN). Timothée Chalamet, Elle Fanning, Liev Schreiber, Selena Gomez, Jude Law, Diego Luna. New York is never so beautiful as when Woody Allen sees it through his lens. Even in the rain, the museums and restaurants glimmer with a golden light, and the charmingly neurotic people inside them effortlessly drop bons mots. If such a romantic comedy tickles your fancy, you've come to the right place. Winner of 3 awards, one of them for Vittorio Storaro's lush cinematography. Rated PG-13.
