GLORIA! (2024-Italy/Switzerland) 106m *** D: Margherita Vicario (directorial debut). Galathea Bellugi (THE TASTE OF THINGS), Carlotta Gamba, Veronica Lucchesi, Sara Mafodda, Paolo Rossi. It is 1800 at Sant'Ignazio music institute for orphaned girls in Venezia. The institute's corrupt conductor Perlina (Rossi) has been commissioned to compose a work to perform for the newly elected Pope Pius VII, but he hasn't written even a note. Everyone overlooks Perlina's mute maid Teresa (Bellugi), but when she discovers a hidden pianoforte, she finds her voice in this joyous tale of empowerment. Winner of 12 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE FIRST DAY OF THE REST OF YOUR LIFE aka *Le premier jour du reste de ta vie* (2008-France) 114m *** ½ D: Rémi Bezançon. Jacques Gamblin, Zabou Breitman, Déborah François, Marc-André Grondin, Pio Marmai. Five events over the course of 12 years in the life of a French family form the focus of this superior drama. Taxi driver Robert (Gamblin) and his wife Marie-Jeanne (Breitman) are parents of spitfire Fleur (François), hopeless romantic Raphael (Grondin) and eldest son Albert (Marmat), who's trying to leave the nest. This funny and uplifting film won 4 awards. For ages 13 and older.

RADICAL (2023-US/Mexico) 121m *** ½ D: Christopher Zalla. Eugenio Derbez, Daniel Hadad, Jennifer Trejo, Danilo Guadalupe. Based on a true story, this movie concerns schoolteacher Sergio (Derbez) who arrives at a derelict school in Matamoros, Mexico, known as a "place of punishment", without a clue as to how he will educate the desperately impoverished students. With no money or resources, Sergio develops a radical plan to ignite his students' innate genius in this crowd pleaser. Winner of 18 awards. Rated PG-13.

GONDOLA (2023-Germany/Georgia) 78m *** D: Veit Helmer. Mathilde Irrmann, Nino Soselia, Zuka Papuashvili, Niara Chichinadze, Vachagan Papovian. In this charming romance without dialogue, two female cable car operators (Irrmann and Soselia) fall in love while passing each other in their gondolas. Their mid-air flirtation is musical, humorous and ingenious, and it absolutely infuriates their sleazy skinflint boss (Papuashvili). Winner of 1 award. For ages 15 and older.

THE ORIGIN OF EVIL aka *L'origine du mal* (2022-France/Canada) 118m *** D: Sébastien Marnier. Laure Calamy, Doria Tillier, Dominique Blanc, Jacques Weber, Suzanne Clément. A woman (Calamy) who works at a fish-packing facility claims to be the long-lost daughter of fabulously wealthy restaurateur Serge Dumontet (Weber) in this twisty (and twisted!) thriller. Old and ailing Serge is sick of his known family, whose greedy members all hope he drops dead. This deliciously nasty tale won 1 award. Rated R.

FOYLE'S WAR: HIGH CASTLE (2015-UK) 89m **** D: Stuart Orme. Michael Kitchen, Honeysuckle Weeks, Daniel Weyman, Nigel Lindsay. A university professor is found murdered in a London park, with the local address of American oil CEO Clayton Del Mar (Lindsay) in his pocket. At MI5, Foyle's (Kitchen) bosses are keen to protect Del Mar, and want Foyle to investigate his connection to the murder. Meanwhile, Sam (Weeks), reluctant to tell Foyle she's pregnant, risks her health by going undercover to solve the mystery in this thrilling episode. For ages 14 and older.

THE PRINCESS BRIDE (1987-US) 99m **** D: Rob Reiner (WHEN HARRY MET SALLY). Cary Elwes, Robin Wright, Mandy Patinkin, Chris Sarandon, Peter Falk, Fred Savage, Billy Crystal, Carol Kane, Andre the Giant, Wallace Shawn, Christopher Guest. This beloved, endlessly quotable movie concerns a grandfather (Falk) who reads a fairy tale to his grandson (Savage), who's sure he won't like it as it involves kissing. In the kingdom of Florin, innocent farmgirl Buttercup (Wright) is chosen as the bride for absurdly supercilious Prince Humperdinck (Sarandon), who has murderous intentions. Will true love triumph? This timeless classic won 7 awards. Recommended for everyone of all ages.

REMBRANDT (1999-France/Germany/Netherlands) 99m *** D: Charles Matton. Klaus Maria Brandauer (MEPHISTO), Romane Bohringer, Jean Rochefort, Johanna ter Steege. The works of pre-eminent 17th century Dutch painter Rembrandt van Rijn (Brandauer) are presented within their rich cultural and historic context in this fascinating biopic by multidisciplinary artist Charles Matton. Filmed with a painterly eye toward composition, lighting and texture, this cinematic depiction of Rembrandt's world brings insight into the making of his masterpieces. Winner of a César for Best Production Design. For ages 15 and older.

THE YOUNG MONTALBANO: THE MAN WHO FOLLOWS FUNERALS aka *L'uomo che andava appresso ai funerali* (2015-Italy) 111m *** ½ D: Gianluca Maria Taverelli. Michele Riondino, Alessio Vassallo, Sarah Felberbaum, Beniamino Marcone, Fabrizio Pizzuto. Detective Montalbano (Riondino) is distracted at work, his mind clouded by suspicion that his beloved Livia (Felberbaum) is seeing another man. Meanwhile, he and his team are stumped by a senseless murder: an eccentric who attended every funeral in Vigata was shot in the face. He was well loved by everyone. What happened? For ages 14 and older.

RAINBOW KIDS aka *Dai yūkai* (1991-Japan) 120m *** ½ D: Kihachi Okamoto. Yae Kitabayashi, Tôru Kazama, Hiroshi Nishikawa, Katsuyasu Uchida, Ken Ogata. When an 82-year-old granny (Kitabayashi) is kidnapped by a trio of bumbling petty criminals (Kazama, Nishikawa and Uchida), she turns the table on them by managing her own kidnapping. To Mrs. Yanagawa, the ransom her kidnappers demand is insultingly small—she must maintain her image, after all. She sweetly (but firmly) takes matters into her own hands, bewildering her family and the chief of police (Ogata). This delightful comedy won 7 awards and was a huge hit in Japan. For ages 12 and older.

CHINAS (2023-Spain) 113m *** D: Arantxa Echevarría. Shiman Yang, Xinyi Ye, Ella Qiu, Leonora Watling, Yeju Ji, Valeria Fernández. It is nine-year-old Xiang's (Qiu) first day at her new school, and it is assumed she will become good friends with ebullient, friendly classmate Lucia (Yang) because they're both of Chinese extraction. But nothing brings the girls together in this thoughtful tale of culture and identity set in Madrid. Winner of 6 awards. For ages 15 and older.

VERMIGLIO (2024-Italy/France/Belgium) 120m *** D: Maura Delpero. Tommaso Ragno, Martina Scrinzi, Giuseppe De Domenico, Santiago Fondevila. In a remote Italian alpine village in 1944, schoolteacher Cesare's (Ragno) nephew Attilio (Fondevila) brings home Pietro (De Domenico), a Sicilian soldier who saved his life. Deserting his unit, Pietro shelters at Cesare's crowded home. His love for Lucia (Scrinzi), Cesare's oldest daughter, changes the lives of everyone in this stunning winner of 19 awards. For ages 15 and older.

ENDEAVOUR: ROCKET (2013-UK) 94m **** D: Craig Viveiros. Shaun Evans, Roger Allam, Martin Jarvis, Jenny Seagrove, Maimie McCoy, Anton Lesser. Police Chief Superintendent Bright (Lesser) is almost gleeful—he has been assigned security duty for a royal visit to the Broom family's munitions factory. Much to Bright's disappointment, the corpse of an unpopular employee is discovered at the factory immediately after the event. Now, not only must DC Morse (Evans) sift through the motives of various employees, but the Brooms' contentious family history as well. For ages 12 and older.

LOST IN THE STARS aka *Xiao shi de ta* (2022-China) 122m *** D: Rui Cui, Xiang Liu, Yilong Zhu, Ni Ni (The Rise of Phoenixes), Janice Man, Kay Huang. With only 5 days left on his visa, He Fei (Zhu) desperately searches for his new bride Li Muzi (Huang) who disappears on their honeymoon in Southeast Asia. He wakes up one morning to find a strange woman (Man) beside him who claims to be his wife. The police and the hotel staff don't believe him when he says she's an impostor. At wit's end, he tries to interest badass international lawyer Chen Mai (Ni Ni) to take on his case in this intricate mystery filmed on Hainan Island. Winner of 25 awards. For ages 12 and older.

A CERTAIN KILLER aka *Aru koroshiya* (1967-Japan) 82m *** ½ D: Kazuo Mori. Raizô Ichikawa, Mikio Narita, Yumiko Nogawa. Normally unflappable hitman Shiozawa (Ichikawa) is in a bind. He's being punished repeatedly for one good deed: he paid for a bowl of ramen so a floozy named Keiko (Nogawa) wouldn't have to sell her body. Ever since then she's stuck to him like glue—and she's all kinds of trouble. Now she's working for him on a job along with wannabe goodfella Maeda (Narita). Will they pull it off? This whip smart film noir, co-written by Yasuzô Masumura, won a Kinema Junpo award for Raizô Ichikawa's ultracool performance. For ages 12 and older.

HIGH GROUND (2020-Australia) 105m *** D: Stephen Johnson (YOLNGU BOY). Guruwuk Mununggurr, Jacob Junior Nayinggul, Simon Baker, Magnolia Maymuru, Callan Mulvey, Jack Thompson, Caren Pistorius. In 1919 Arnhem Land, a visit by a Christian missionary to an aboriginal community goes terribly wrong, ending in a massacre. The policeman accompanying the group, Travis (Baker), disgusted by the shocking violence, rescues young Gutjuk (Mununggurr) and brings him to live at the mission outpost. Twelve years later, the consequences of this act bear bitter fruit in this drama of divided loyalties. Winner of 8 awards. For ages 15 and older.

BOILING POINT (2021-UK/Australia/US) 95m *** ½ D: Philip Barantini. Stephen Graham (SNATCH), Vinette Robinson, Hannah Walters, Jason Fleming. On the surface, head chef Andy Jones (Graham) seems to have it all. His chic London bistro that bears his name attracts a celebrity clientele. But he's a mess. He's a recently separated dad, he's hugely in debt, and leans too much on sous chef Carly (Robinson), who has had it up to here carrying the bistro on her own. This wild ride, shot in one amazing take, chronicles one night at the restaurant during the Christmas rush. Winner of 9 awards. Rated R.

THE HUNDRED-FOOT JOURNEY (2014-India/United Arab Emirates/US) 122m *** ½ D: Lasse Hallström (HACHI: A DOG'S TALE). Helen Mirren, Om Puri, Manish Dayal, Charlotte Le Bon, Michel Blanc. Escaping political violence and personal loss in Mumbai, widowed Papa Kadam (Puri) and his children arrive in France, scouting for a place to open a restaurant. Fate lands the Kadam family directly across the street from the culinary temple of Madam Mallory (Mirren). A fierce rivalry develops between the two restaurants until sparks of romance begin to form a bridge. This charmer features delightful battles between acting greats Mirren and Puri. Rated PG.
