LE CINÉMA DE PAPA (1971-France) 97m *** ½ D: Claude Berri (JEAN DE FLORETTE). Yves Robert, Hénia Suchar, Claude Berri, Alain Cohen, Gerard Barry, Philippe de Broca. This biopic is a heartfelt tribute to director Claude Berri's father, a Polish immigrant who worked as a furrier in Paris's Faubourg Poissonnière Jewish quarter. A modest man who lives through the accomplishments of his son, Henri (Robert) finds his own passion toward the end of his life. Yves Robert delivers a virtuoso performance that will warm your heart. For ages 10 and older. *H.E.D. born 12/20/1921*

TRULY HUMAN aka *Etrøgtigt menneske* (2001-Denmark) 90m *** D: Åke Sandgren. Nikolaj Lie Kaas (DEPARTMENT Q Series), Peter Mygind, Susan Olsen, Clara Nepper Winther. The imaginary older brother "P" (Kaas) of 7-year-old Lisa (Winther) comes to life in this highly original Dogma 95 film set in current day Denmark. When Lisa's old house is torn down, P is liberated. Innocent and eager to learn, P tries to get a job and become a member of society, though his decency is misinterpreted by everyone. Kaas is terrific in this unsettling fable which won 9 awards from around the world. For ages 12 and older.

HEART OF A LION aka *Leijonasydän* (2013-Finland/Sweden) 99m *** ½ D: Dome Karukoski (LAPLAND ODYSSEY). Peter Franzen (AMBUSH), Laura Birn, Jasper Pääkkönen, Yusufa Sidibeh. A neo-Nazi skinhead (Franzen) falls head over heels in love with beautiful blonde Sari (Birn). He is forced to seriously reconsider his beliefs when he finds out she has a biracial son (Sidibeh). This provocative film tackles Finland's neo-Nazi issues with humor. Winner of 6 awards. For ages 15 and up.

WALLANDER: THE COURIER aka *Kuriren* (2010-Sweden) 91m *** D: Leif Magnusson. Krister Henriksson, Lena Endre, Mats Bergman, Nina Zanjani, Fredrik Gunnarsson, Dragomir Mrsic. A motorcyclist found dead on a beach turns out to be a drug runner for a vicious gang operating under the cover of the Bloodhounds, a Ystad motorcycle club. Chief inspector Kurt Wallander (Henriksson) is alarmed when two of his officers, Svartman (Gunnarsson) and young trainee Isabelle (Zanjani) are attacked while investigating people involved with the case. This highly suspenseful thriller is for ages 15 and older.

PRIME SUSPECT: INNER CIRCLES (1995-UK/US) 102m *** ½ D: Sarah Pia Anderson. Helen Mirren, James Laurenson, Sophie Stanton, Ralph Arliss, James Laurenson, Jill Baker. Swamped in paperwork she hates, Superintendent Tension (Mirren) is delighted to be called in to investigate a death in an affluent London suburb. What appears to be an open-and-shut case of an accidental death leads to a political scandal that threatens to undermine Tension's leadership in this engrossing episode. For ages 15 and older.

TENDERNESS aka *La tendresse* (2013-Belgium/France/Germany) 79m *** D: Marion Hänsel. Marilyne Canto, Olivier Gourmet, Adrien Jolivet, Sergi López. Belgian divorced couple Lise (Canto) and Frans (Gourmet) take a road trip to the Alps to pick up their adult son Jack (Jolivet) who was injured in a skiing accident in this quiet but highly observed and surprisingly suspenseful story of a family. Each is moving his or her separate way, but the deep connections and affection remain. For ages 12 and older.

INSPECTOR GEORGE GENTLY: GENTLY IN THE NIGHT (2009-UK/Ireland) 89m *** ½ D: Daniel O'Hara. Martin Shaw, Lee Ingleby, Brendan Coyle. In 1964, young woman's dead body is found laying on a church altar. According to her parents, Audrey, the deceased, was a nurse. Detective John Bacchus (Ingleby), however, had seen Audrey serve drinks at the Playboy-style nightclub owned by brash American Patrick Donovan (Coyle). Evidence casts suspicion on a local group of anti-abortionists picketing the nightclub. For ages 15 and older.

LE JOUR ET L'HEURE aka *The Day and the Hour* (1963-France/Italy) 109m *** D: René Clément (LES FÉLINS). Simone Signoret, Stuart Whitman, Geneviève Page, Michel Piccoli, Billy Kearns. It is the spring of 1944 in Nazi-occupied France and Thérèse (Signoret) is in a hurry to get back to Paris with suitcases of food. When she catches a ride from an acquaintance driving a truckload of goats, she discovers, hiding among the goats, are three Allied pilot refugees. When the safe house has no room for hunky American Air Force captain Allan (Whitman), Thérèse becomes a reluctant heroine for the Resistance in this wartime romance. For ages 10 and older. *Original French language version.*

A TOUCH OF LARCENY (1960-UK/US) 88m *** D: Guy Hamilton (AN INSPECTOR CALLS). James Mason, George Sanders, Vera Miles. Former British submarine commander Max Easton (Mason) now pushes a pencil for pennies in the Admiralty. When he is introduced to wealthy acquaintance Sir Charles Holland's (Sanders) American fiancée Virginia (Miles), he is immediately besotted. Max hatches an outlandish scheme to steal Virginia from pompous Charles in this classic comedy. Nominated for 1 award. For ages 10 and older.

INSPECTOR GEORGE GENTLY: GENTLY THROUGH THE MILL (2009-UK/Ireland) 89m *** ½ D: Ciarán Donnelly. Martin Shaw, Lee Ingleby, Tom Goodman-Hill, Nicholas Jones, Tim McInnerny. In County Durham, where local elections are heating up, the manager for a financially strapped grain mill is found hanged in what appears to be a suicide. But as detectives Gently (Shaw) and Bacchus (Ingleby) follow the trail of clues, a much more complex story emerges in this well-crafted mystery. For ages 12 and older.

WHAT A WONDERFUL FAMILY 3: MY WIFE, MY LIFE (2018-Japan) 124m *** D: Yôji Yamada. Yui Natsukawa, Masahiko Nishimura, Isao Hashizume. In the Hirata family, oldest son and breadwinner Kônosuke (Nishimura) has become a grumpy old cuss much like his father Shûzo (Hashizume). Constantly worried over family finances, Kônosuke is furious to find out that his wife Fumie (Natsukawa) has been saving a secret stash of cash. In the ensuing quarrel, Fumie leaves home in a huff and the house descends into chaos without her. This heartwarming comedy was nominated for 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

UNDER THE OPEN SKY aka *Subarashiki sekai* (2020-Japan) 127m *** ½ D: Miwa Nishikawa (DEAR DOCTOR). Kôji Yakusho, Isao Hashizume, Masami Nagasawa, Taiga Nakano, Hakuryû. The great Kôji Yakusho delivers a powerhouse performance in this riveting portrait of a former Yakuza trying to go straight. Recently released from prison where he spent a total of 28 years, Mikami (Yakusho) struggles to navigate the outside world. Determined to never return to prison, he finds allies to help him in this funny and poignant drama. Winner of 2 awards. For ages 15 and older.

INSPECTOR GEORGE GENTLY: GENTLY IN THE BLOOD (2009-UK/Ireland) 90m *** ½ D: Ciarán Donnelly. Martin Shaw, Lee Ingleby, Andrew Lee Potts, Tariq Jordan. The next day after detectives Gently (Shaw) and Bacchus (Ingleby) acquire a suitcase full of stolen passports dropped by petty criminal Jimmy Cochran (Potts), a white woman who worked in the office where the passports were issued is found dead with her mixed-race baby nearby. In this engrossing mystery, Gently and Bacchus must look past easy answers to find the real culprit. For ages 12 and older.

MARTHA (1967-Denmark/Greece) 94m *** ½ D: Erik Balling. Poul Reichhardt, Poul Bundgaard, Morten Grunwald, Ove Sprogøe, Karl Stegger, Helge Kjøerulf-Schmidt. The crew of S/S Martha is a happy-go-lucky lot, as their ancient rusty freighter has been entirely forgotten by the shipping company's HQ in Copenhagen. One day, company owner O.P. Andersen (Kjøerulf-Schmidt) boards the Martha and is so outraged he threatens to turn her into scrap, spurring Martha's slovenly crew to save their beloved ship. This delightful comedy is a cult favorite with merchant marines everywhere. For ages 10 and older.

LES FÉLINS aka *Joy House* (1964-France) 94m *** D: René Clément (PURPLE NOON). Alain Delon, Jane Fonda, Lola Albright. Petty criminal Marc (Delon) is in trouble—he seduced a gangster's wife. While laying low in a French flophouse, he is hired by eccentric millionairess Barbara (Albright) as a chauffeur at her chateau in the Riviera. With beautiful Barbara and her sexy cousin Melinda (Fonda) as company, Marc has it pretty good, until some strange things start to happen in the vast, spooky castle. This stylish thriller, lensed in black and white by the great Henri Decaë, is screened in the vastly superior original French version. For ages 12 and older.

NERO WOLFE CHRISTMAS SPECIAL (2001-US) 102m *** D: Holly Dale. Timothy Hutton, Maury Chaykin, James Tolkan, Marian Seldes, Kari Matchett, Francie Swift, M.J. Kang. Notoriously reclusive armchair sleuth Nero Wolfe (Chaykin) leaves his beloved Manhattan brownstone to venture as far as Westchester (gasp!) in these two delightful yuletide mysteries. What could possibly cause this crotchety genius-homebody to go out in winter weather? Find out with these two tales filled with charmingly eccentric characters. For ages 12 and older.

SINK OR SWIM aka *Le grand bain* (2018-Belgium/France) 122m *** D: Gilles Lellouche (TELL NO ONE). Mathieu Amalric, Guillaume Canet, Benoît Poelvoorde, Jean-Hugues Anglade, Philippe Katerine, Virginie Efira. Unemployed for two years, depressed Bertrand (Amalric) spends his days playing Candy Crush on his sofa until he comes upon an ad looking for new members for a all-male(!) synchronized swim team. When he meets his tough-talking but tender-hearted coach Delphine (Efira) and his rowdy middle-aged teammates, Bertrand slowly comes back to life in this droll feel-good comedy. Winner of 5 awards. For ages 12 and older.

MURDERERS AMONG US aka *Die Mörder sind unter uns* (1946-Germany) 81m *** ½ D: Wolfgang Staudte. Hidegard Knef, Wilhelm Borchert, Erna Sellmer. When she returns to the bombed-out ruins of Berlin from a concentration camp after WWII, Susanne (Knef) finds a stranger, Dr. Mertens (Borchert), living in her apartment. Feeling sympathy for Mertens, a drunken wreck of a man, Susanne allows him to share the apartment. But their peace is soon shattered when Mertens discovers that his brutal former commander is alive and well in Berlin. This memorable post-war drama is, believe or not, a terrific Christmas film. Nominated for an award. For ages 10 and older.

MAKTUB (2011-Spain/Argentina) 111m *** D: Paco Arango. Diego Peretti, Andoni Hernández, Aitana Sánchez-Gijón, Goya Toledo, Jorge Garcia, Laura Esquivel. Manolo (Peretti) has a good job, a beautiful wife (Sánchez-Gijón) and two bright, energetic kids. But he's deeply unhappy until, by chance, he meets teenager Antonio (Hernández) and his spunky but highly stressed single mom Mari (Toledo). This heartwarming Christmas story won of 2 awards. For ages 12 and older.

A CHRISTMAS CAROL (1951-UK) 86m **** D: Brian Desmond-Hurst. Alastair Sim, Jack Warner, George Cole, Patrick Macnee, Kathleen Harrison, Mervyn Johns, Michael Hordern. Still the best, this heartfelt and faithful rendition of the Dickens classic features a delightful performance by Sim as Scrooge, a surly old miser who is visited one evening by ghosts who teach him the spirit of Christmas. The perfect holiday movie for all ages.

HER LOVE BOILS BATHWATER aka *Yu wo waka-suhodo no atsu ai* (2016-Japan) 125m *** ½ D: Ryôta Nakano. Rie Miyazawa, Hana Sugisaki, Joe Odagiri, Aoi Itô. Single mom Futaba (Miyazawa) has been struggling ever since her husband Kazuhiro (Odagiri) left her. The family bathroom has shut down, her daughter Azumi (Sugisaki) is miserable at school... and now Futaba has been diagnosed with terminal cancer. Undeterred, Futaba uses the time she has left to reconcile her family in this gently humorous family drama. Winner of 12 awards. For ages 12 and older.

BYE BYE MORONS aka *Adieu les cons* (2020-France) 87m *** D: Albert Dupontel (SEE YOU UP THERE). Virginie Efira, Albert Dupontel, Nicolas Marié, Jackie Berroyer. Diagnosed with a serious disease, 43-year-old hairdresser Suze (Efira) makes a last-ditch effort to search for the child she was forced to give up at age 15 in this poignant and funny comedy-drama. While tangled in red tape, Suze comes across Jean-Baptiste (Dupontel), an IT whiz just made redundant by his clueless boss, and Serge (Marié), a blind archivist shut away deep in a maze-like government building. This candy-colored wonder won 6 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME aka *A casa tutti bene* (2018-Italy) 108m *** D: Gabriele Muccino (BUT FOREVER IN MY MIND). Stefano Accorsi, Carolina Crescentini, Elena Cucci, Pierfrancesco Favino, Claudia Gerini, Massimo Ghini, Giampaolo Morelli, Valeria Solarino, Ivano Marescotti, Stefania Sandrelli. Grandparents Alba (Sandrelli) and Ivano (Marescotti) invite the whole family to their island home near Naples for their 50th wedding anniversary. Everyone looks beautiful, prosperous and happy—until bad weather stops the ferry service and the family is forced to stay together another few days. Featuring an A-list cast, this delightful comedy-drama won 5 awards. For ages 12 and older.

PINCHCLIFFE CHRISTMAS aka *Solan og Ludvig – Jul i Flåklypa* (2013-Norway) 76m *** D: Rasmus A. Sivertsen. The charming fictional Norwegian village of Pinchcliffe (Flåklypa) is having a crisis: it's nearly Christmas, and there's no snow! The town's newspaper editor Frimand implores genius inventor Reodor to solve the problem. Coincidentally, Reodor and his assistants Solan the cocky magpie and Ludvig the timid hedgehog have put together a snow cannon! What can possibly go wrong?! This stop-motion tribute to Ivo Caprino's PINCHCLIFFE GRAND PRIX won Best Children's Film at the Amanda Awards. For ages 8 and older (because of subtitles).
