


Board of Water Supply's Water Conservation Week Poster and Poetry Contest Exhibit

The Mayor's Office of Culture and the Arts presents FACE Hawai'i *Hawai'i Needs A Home*. In collaboration with the Office of Housing and its Executive Director, Jun Yang; FACE will bring an 8'x20' container unit that has been converted to a 2 bedroom housing unit to the Frank F. Fasi Civic Grounds. It is a demonstration model for alternative dwelling units (ADU) and a representative of FACE Hawai'i will be present to show the ADU and answer any questions.

The Honolulu Zoo needs your kokua!

The Mayor's Office of Culture and the Arts and the Honolulu Zoo are asking for donations of lā'ī (ti leaf) to help repair the hale lā'ī. Once used for cultural and community events at the Honolulu Zoo, the thatched roof of the hale lā'ī has fallen into a state of disrepair over the years due to nature's elements. The Zoo wishes to bring this structure back to its original state so it can once again be used to benefit the community.

Hundreds of leaves will be needed to complete this repair, so please donate as many lā'ī as possible!

Green, Yellow or Brown ti leaves, *with the stems*, may be dropped off in plastic bags at the Honolulu Zoo entrance.
