MOCA encourages all Oʻahu residents to be an active member of your community by filing to run for a seat on your neighborhood board!

Apply online at www2.honolulu.gov/nbe, or complete and submit a candidate registration form, available at the Neighborhood Commission Office (NCO) at Kapālama Hale, 925 Dillingham Blvd, Suite 160; and the Department of Customer Services Public Information Center at the Mission Memorial Building, at 550 South King St.

Candidacy is open to Oʻahu residents who will be at least 18 years of age by February 17, 2017. The deadline to apply as a candidate is February 17, 2017.

Voting begins on April 28, 2017, and ends on May 17, 2017. Elected board members serve a two year term, starting on July 1, 2017. Voters will elect 437 neighborhood board representatives to serve on the 33 neighborhood boards.
