



May 26, 11:00 am - 1:00 pm (or until the flowers run out), Honolulu Hale, 530 S King St




Honolulu Hale during this time. Lei need to be at least 22" - 24" in length.




Poster Contest Exhibit May 1 - 31, Honolulu Hale, 3rd Flr Gallery M - F, 8 am - 4:30 pm
