# Attention Cultural and Performing Arts Organizations!

## MOCA is requesting proposals for the Mayor's Production Grants Level I, Level II and Operating Grant.

The Level I Grant will assist organizations seeking support to develop new works in the fields of dance, theater, music, short film, literature, cultural festivals, media, and all other creative activity relating to the arts, customs and traditions of ethnic groups of Hawai'i. The Level II Grant provides continued support for on-going works which have previously received MOCA grant awards between Fiscal Years 2010 and 2016.

The Mayor's Level I and Level II Grants award are up to \$10,000.

The Operating Grant was created in response to the needs of those in the cultural and performing arts community seeking operating support in creating or maintaining works of art and projects.

The Mayor's Operating Grant awards are up to \$5,000.

The grants will be awarded to organizations located within the City and County of Honolulu for projects benefiting Oahu residents. To be eligible for the grant, applicants must be a tax-exempt, publicly supported and charitable organization, as determined by the Internal Revenue Service.

The deadline for submitting proposals is Friday, December 2, 2016 at 4 pm Proposals may be submitted to the Division of Purchasing at 530 South King Street, Room 115.

All non-profits who qualify and are interested in applying for the grant program should read the RFP documents carefully. Determine which of the three grant types you may qualify for and submit your proposal, application and required documents as indicated in the instructions.

Only complete RFP application packets will be considered for grant funding.
