## MAKE A DIFFERENCE - GIFT PLEDGES

Waikiki Community Center welcomes your gift through a pledge — a formal statement of intention to make a gift to the Center. With a pledge, you may complete your gift by making regular payments over time, allowing you to give more generously than you originally may have considered. What's more, each payment on your pledge is eligible for an income-tax charitable deduction. Easy ways to make a gift pledge include:

Aloha United Way (AUW)- If you contribute to the AUW campaign each year, did you know that you can direct where your contribution goes? Waikiki Community Center is an AUW partner agency and each year we receive critical funds from donors who select us as their charity of choice. All you need to do is request an AUW Donor Option Choice Form from your on-site AUW coordinator and designate Waikiki Community Center as the recipient of your AUW contribution. The minimum donation allowed by AUW is \$48 the payment can be made via check, credit card or payroll deduction for as little as \$4/month. Help us spread the word!

Our AUW Campaign Designation number is 96540.

Combined Federal Campaign (CFC)- If you are a Federal civilian, postal or military employee, you are eligible to participate in the annual CFC Campaign. When you make your contribution, you are encouraged and empowered to direct where you would like your funds designation goes. Help us spread the word!

Monthly Giving - Provide support throughout the year by pledging a specific monthly contribution. Your repeated gifts will provide sustainability for much-needed services and programs -- and you only have to sign up once for our Makana Fund monthly giving club!

#### BATTLE OF MIDWAY w/Alan Lloyd

Mr. Alan Lloyd returns to WCC to provide a presentation on the Battle of Midway, widely regarded as the most important naval battle of the Pacific Campaign of World War II. Between June 4 and 7, 1942; only six months after Japan's attack on Pearl Harbor, and one month after the Battle of the Coral Sea, the United States Navy decisively defeated an Imperial Japanese Navy (IJN) attack against Midway Atoll, inflicting irreparable damage on the Japanese fleet.
